

Transcript – The Plagues of Egypt_the Wilderness_and the End Time

Alrighty, Chag Semeach again! And here we are, day two. The message I have today I wouldn't call it a part 2 of yesterday's message, but I would call it connected, certainly with the message from yesterday. And it's interesting with Greg's message and even some of the other of them, I almost feel it's more like Passover than it is Sukkot; with the wilderness and the messages and whatnot. But Sukkot is also wilderness because that's what we're remembering; the children of Israel in the wilderness at Sukkot when they lived in sukkahs during their forty years in the wilderness because of that. But we'll talk about that in another message. But today's message is called, *The Plagues of Egypt, the Wilderness and the End Time ... The Plagues of Egypt, the Wilderness and the End Time.*

And I mentioned this yesterday that the ten plagues of Egypt ending up with the parting of the Red Sea, is probably the most amazing feat that Yahweh has ever done in the intervention of mankind that we know of. You could look in the Bible and you could see small stories that have happened and miracles that have happened here. You see that when the great General and King Sennacheribs come to Jerusalem and 185,000 people are dead in the morning, right? So there's different things, but **I don't think you could look in the Bible and find anything remotely that equals the Exodus.**

Like I said, Egypt and Pharaoh they're the world leader and they have armies and all this stuff and Yahweh did to show that and then like I said the literal parting of the Red Sea, that **there's no doubt that who was doing it, that it was Yahweh doing it.** In the beginning they might not have known and they even tried to supplement what Moses was doing, with the priests of Egypt doing the same thing, but in the end we know that even Pharaoh admitted it. That **Yahweh He is the only true Elohim.**

Now though **in the end time Yahweh will once again deliver His people from the bondage of Egypt.** And like I was saying yesterday, that's why I gave that message first; comparing Egypt to the world. But Yahweh's going to do it similar in the times we're living in today. And a matter of fact, when you get in the book of Revelation, if you look up the word *cherub, messenger, malak*, however you want to call it, but it's the same thing – angel. What you'll find is that **there is more angelic intervention in the book of Revelation than anywhere else in the entire Bible.**

And a matter of fact, even if you look in the Exodus, there wasn't so much angelic intervention that was there. It was mostly Yahweh using Moses, right? And Moses' staff, that Yahweh was pulling the strings of course, but you didn't see a lot of angelic intervention in the Exodus. Now in the end time, you're going to see a lot of it; you're seeing it all over the place. Because there's a point where satan is literally on the earth; the demons that were chained and locked from **Genesis 6** are allowed out and there's kind of chaos.

Of course the headquarters of it is Babylon, **Revelation 18**, that's the headquarters of satan during this time; and every foul spirit and demon is there at that headquarters. But they'll be all over the earth too; it won't just be in Babylon. They're going to go out from there and maybe come back from there. But they'll come all over the earth. And Yahweh is going to deliver His remnant from Egypt's bond – the bond of the world; and deliver them to the Promised Land through the wilderness. So **the same thing that you read in Exodus is going to happen in our time; it's going to parallel exactly, only we're going to make it this time,** right? Where the children of Israel failed and only two out of two million, twenty years old and older, made it; now in the end time, we're going to accomplish something they didn't.

And like I said, I plan on giving two messages during the feast on the Qumran sect and that's what they believed. That's why **they went to the wilderness because they knew they had to leave the world.** There was no problem with them. **They were convicted of it and even when it didn't happen in their time frame it didn't make a difference.** They weren't going thinking it might happen in the next ten years. **They knew when they left** according to their thinking and when I go into the message I'll show you they thought it was a hundred years later. So everyone who left to the wilderness

knew they'd be dead before it happened! And they still went because they went for their children and their grandchildren. They knew we had to be purified from the world because the Messiah is not going to come to a corrupted people.

So let's start in Matthew 24 ... Matthew 24 because I want us to get the sense, sometimes it's hard because we live in the world and the world doesn't understand this. And sometimes when things happen where Yahweh's doing something, like if you're like a Job or somebody that's set-apart and you're there by yourself; or you're like Elijah ... you know I'm here and I'm left alone, you wonder is it really real? And even though you know it's real because all the people around you don't see it sometimes you keep having to knock yourself. So I want to show you that even in the days of Pharaoh it was the same thing. So Matthew 24 in verse 14 says:

Matthew 24:14-22 *And this good news of the Kingdom **will be published in all the earth** for a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.*

Comment: And I say that this is something that's **collectively** for Yahshua's remnant in the end times; it's not for one man; it's not for one group. It's collectively, but I do believe that the Hebraic Roots Bible and the Congregation of YAHWEH Jerusalem has been a pillar in this. We've had millions and millions of downloads. I can't tell you the exact number at this point, but probably more than twelve million, maybe more than that even, maybe fifteen million – just Bible downloads in the last 'X' amount of years here. But this is what it is; it's the Good News being published in all the earth. We're getting ready to do another publishing of it. We've also printed tens of thousands of Bibles over and over and over. That's not even including when I say the downloads, that's only the download like PDF, that doesn't include phones where most of the stuff now is download onto phones. So who knows how many people when you look at altogether with the androids and phone downloads and all that kind of stuff.

Matthew 24:14-17 *And when you see the sign of uncleanness and desolation that was spoken of by Daniel the prophet, which will stand in the holy place. He that reads let him understand. Then let those in Judea **flee into the mountains** ... So that's where the fleeing's coming, right? We're fleeing into the mountains ... *the one on the roof; don't let him not go down to take anything out of the house* ... right? So this is going to happen really quick. That's why I say, **you need to be planning now because when this event happens you're not going to have a lot of time.***

Matthew 24:18-22 *And the one in the field, let him not turn back to take his garment. But woe to the ones having a child in womb ... and I think, no I'll keep going a couple more verses ... *those nursing in those days! And pray that your flight will not occur in winter or on the Sabbath day* ... and we're starting to understand that, right? The winters are getting worse and severe; and on the Sabbath you can't buy and sell. What if you're going by car and you can't get gas? ... *For there will be great suffering, such as has not happened from the beginning of the world until now, no, nor ever will be. And except those days were shortened, not any flesh would live. But on account of the chosen, those days will be shortened.**

Right? Many are called, few are chosen. So I say, in most of the generations up until now in the White Throne Judgment, some are going to make it; some aren't going to make it. But in the generation we're living in to now, you look at the scriptures 98% of the people on the planet now will not make it. They're not going to make it because we know that the vast majority of people in the world will accept the mark of the beast; and whoever accepts the mark of the beast will go to the lake of fire ... *Then if anyone says to you, here* ... well I think I'm going to stop there for now, verse 22.

So we see that we have the witness of the Kingdom of Yahweh which we've been doing, right, with the Matthew 24 program for probably eight years now. It's amazing how much growth has come from there, just in our Congregation. Never mind I don't know with the other congregations that are also witnessing, preaching, whatever. But I know in our

Congregation, we have hundreds, hundreds of new congregations world-wide just from Matthew 24 program that we've been doing. And then the remnant going to the wilderness like it says if it's not for the remnant's sake.

But **in the days of Moses, most of the people didn't believe ... the same today.** You'd think that this is something different, there's nothing new under the sun, like Solomon says; but in the days of Moses it was the same thing that the vast majority of the people are not going to believe. So let's go to Exodus 5 ... Exodus 5 ... so now, right? We see that in **Exodus 4, in Exodus 3**, that Moses comes to Yahweh for the first time he comes up the mountain and Yahweh tells him His will. He sees that Yahweh is real and Moses, like I said, you don't see it in the Ten Commandment movie when you're looking at Charlton Heston – he's got a real good voice and powerful. But Moses stuttered. Moses couldn't even speak; he had a stuttering problem like that.

So now Yahweh's telling him, *you're going to go down and you're going to go to Pharaoh*, the most powerful guy in the world and you're going to say these things so you can understand why he's a little hesitant to do that, to the point that Yahweh got angry at him. And He said, *well, who gives man voice? And who takes it away? Your brother Aaron is on the way. He'll speak for you.* So he goes through this for two chapters with Yahweh, right? And now, Yahweh Himself ... where else in the Bible do you see someone coming before the face of Yahweh ... Yahweh talking to Him and Yahweh saying, *now go and do this.* Would you have any fear and inhibition if that happened in your life? If Yahweh's right there before you and His fire is there and you're up at Sinai? Of course not. But what happens when he goes down, right? Chapter 5 ...

Exodus 5:1-2 *And afterward Moses and Aaron came in to Pharaoh ... and what does he say? ... So says YAHWEH the Elohim of Israel, **Send away My people, and they shall feast to Me in the wilderness** ... Right? Game over, you don't beat Yahweh. C'mon everybody let's go now ... not that easy ... verse 2... And Pharaoh said, *Who is YAHWEH that I should listen to His voice to send away Israel? I do not know YAHWEH, and I also will not send away Israel.**

Isn't that the way it is today, right? Isn't it the way same today? So we're seeing the same thing. Even though you tell the people - the Bible says this is going to happen, the Bible says earthquakes are going to happen. There's earthquakes everywhere; the Bible says that famine is going to happen. There's famine; the Bible says this and it's going to happen. What do the people keep saying? Like I said, *it's a coincidence.* They're not listening, the same way; but it was the same way with Moses. Go to chapter 6 in verse 5 ... chapter 6 in verse 5 ... now you can understand that people in the world don't believe it, right? But you would think the brethren would believe it. You would think the people that are over there that they would believe it. Wouldn't that be the case? But let's take a look ... Exodus 6, and starting in verse 5, it says:

Exodus 6:5-9 *And I also have heard the groaning of the sons of Israel, whom the Egyptians are enslaving. And I have remembered My covenant. Therefore, say to the sons of Israel, **I am YAHWEH, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of Egypt, and will deliver you from their slavery.** And I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments. And I will take you for Myself for a people, and I will be to you Elohim. And you will know that I am YAHWEH your Elohim, the One bringing you out from under the burdens of Egypt. And I will bring you into the land which I raised My hand to give to Abraham, and to Isaac, and to Jacob. And I will give it to you for a possession. I am YAHWEH!* ... Right? So wow! So now these are the believers, these are the Israelites and Yahweh's telling him this ... just tell them this they're going to listen ... and look at verse 9 ... *And Moses spoke to the sons of Israel. And they did not listen to Moses, from anguish of spirit and from harsh bondage.*

Right? And I'll tell you something, like I said, I've been around for thirty-six years in this walk and I've seen a lot in thirty-six years, and thirty-six years ago, even more than that, even before I was born that the prophecy, even if you go back to World-War II, people were saying Hitler was the beast power. And maybe back then it seemed like Hitler was the beast

power and that the return was coming. I know in Church of God they actually had a booklet years ago, it was called, *1975*; and in that booklet it was that Yahshua was returning in 1975; it never happened.

I remember back in the early 1990's that you'd hear this stuff on short-wave radio; and that the Russians are going to attack America; and they're hiding in the caves over there, there's two million Russians. And then that, like ten years go by and you're asking "no, no, no, they're still there!" And it's, "Well, what are they eating? Do they ever wash their clothes? How do they go to the toilet?" Like c'mon, they're not there ... they're not there.

So we went through a lot of this, right? We went through a lot of the false prophecies but that's part of prophecy; part of the prophecy would there'd be false prophecies. So we just can't fall for the false prophecies, but **we have to look at the things that Yahweh said are going to happen in the end time are happening**; and yet, over here just like in Egypt, they didn't believe it. And why didn't they believe it? From anguish of spirit from the harsh bondage ... anguish of spirit. And I think that's what happened to a lot of believers. Even why a lot of them fell away; because you just get to the point, they lose their focus. And now, the cares of the world, the thorns and the thistles, and they just fall away from everything.

And now no matter what ... no matter what you can show them ... I mean you have the Revelation 12 sign – something that happens once every seven thousand years that man can't manipulate of how these planets are lined up exactly like Yahweh says according to the mazzaroth. And there's some people that it doesn't make any difference in the world and it wouldn't make a difference.

I thought to myself but what if we ... because we plan on going down to Mount Sinai and seeing the original Mount Sinai, and what if we went to the crossing site and what if Yahweh opened the Red Sea again and He might do it. There's some scriptures here that show me that very well could happen. What if it does? And what if we walked through that crossing site, right, and now you go back and share with people and say all these ... do think it would make any difference whatsoever? I can tell you now it would make zero difference. Number one, 90% of the people wouldn't even believe it; and even the ones that do, it would be like, "Oh wow, that's neat! That's neat. Can I have another cup of coffee?"

It's like we're to a point now because people in this stupor that no matter what ... that's why I say, **miracles don't bring people to faith; miracles are an extension of somebody's faith**. Miracles don't bring people to faith because as soon as the miracle is gone, we see with the Israelites, so are the people when the next thing comes. But right here, this a really interesting scripture that even the sons of Israel didn't follow, they didn't believe. Exodus 7 in verse 3 ... Exodus 7 in verse 3, he says:

Exodus 7:3-6 *And I will harden the heart of Pharaoh. And I will multiply My signs and My wonders in the land of Egypt. And Pharaoh will not listen to you. And I will put My hand on Egypt, and will bring My armies, My people, the sons of Israel, from the land of Egypt with great judgments. And the Egyptians shall know that I am YAHWEH when I send forth My hand on Egypt and bring out the sons of Israel from their midst. And Moses and Aaron did as YAHWEH had commanded them, so they did.*

So **we see just like with Egypt's society will not listen and Yahweh has to bring the plagues**. So when you're looking at plagues like we're going through now and more plagues that are coming, this is one of the reasons. And **it's not going to change the people, but it's an outcome of their unbelief**. And it's just like it was in the time of the Exodus. The Exodus and the plagues in Exodus were an outcome because of the disbelief of the people; because if the people believed that Pharaoh believed and he let the Israelites go, you wouldn't have needed the ten plagues. There would have been no reason for it. If the Israelites believed Yahweh, there would have been no reason to part the Red Sea. So **because of**

unbelief, this is why Covid is here. If we go to Deuteronomy 28 in verse 21 ... Deuteronomy 28 in verse 21 ... what is one of the plagues that Yahweh is going to send?

Deuteronomy 28:21-22 *YAHWEH will make the plague **cling to you** until He has consumed you from off the land where you are going, to possess it. YAHWEH will strike you with **lung disease** ... is Covid a lung disease? ... and **with fever** ... which one of the first things you get when you get Covid, you get a fever ... and **with inflammation** ... it's inflammation of the lungs, which Covid is ... and with **extreme burning**, and with the sword, and with blasting and mildew. And they shall pursue you until you perish.*

So I find it very interesting that one of the **first real world plagues** that we're getting here has to do with Covid. It has to do with a world-wide plague like that. So what I want to do is I really want to show you in this message now, because I wanted to start by showing you the parallel, but I want parallel the plagues of Egypt with the plagues in Revelation that we see what's coming next. Covid we should have known about because it says how many times do we see there's going to famine, there's going to be plague, plague, plague; and even the exact plague of Covid is named there if people don't listen.

But actually all of the plagues of Egypt are parallel in Revelation. So let's go over and let's take a look at this. Because like we were saying yesterday, when we look at the plagues of Egypt, we're comparing to Revelation that Egypt is a type of the world in the end and where in Exodus the plagues were on Egypt; in Revelation, they're on the whole world. So let's go to Exodus 7 ... Exodus the 7th chapter, verse 19:

Exodus 7:19-21 *And YAHWEH said to Moses, Say to Aaron, Take your staff, and stretch out your hand over the waters of Egypt, over the rivers, over the canals, over the pools, over every body of their waters, so that they may become blood. And blood shall be in all the land of Egypt, both in wooden and in stone vessels. And Moses and Aaron did so, as YAHWEH had commanded. And he lifted up the staff and struck the water which was in the river before Pharaoh's eyes, and before his servants' eyes. And **all the water in the river turned to blood**. And the fish in the river died, and the river stunk. And the Egyptians were not able to drink water from the Nile. And the blood was in all the land of Egypt.*

Right, so water turning to blood, all the fish dying; this is one first plagues we see there. If we go to Revelation 16 verse 3-7 ... Revelation 16 through 7:

Revelation 16:3-7 *And the second cherub poured out his bowl onto the sea. And it became blood, as of a dead one, and every soul of life died in the sea. And the third cherub poured out his bowl onto the rivers, and onto the springs of the water; and it became blood. And I heard the cherub of the waters saying, You are righteous, O holy one who is, and who was, and who will be, because You judged these things, since they poured out the blood of the saints and the prophets; and You gave blood to them to drink, for they were deserving. And I heard another out of the altar saying, Yes, YAHWEH Elohim Almighty, Your judgments are true and righteous.*

So here it is; like I said, in the Exodus these plagues only happened in Egypt; and Egypt is a type of the world. Then we get to Revelation and now it's world-wide ... now it's world-wide. Exodus 8:1-6:

Exodus 8:1-6 *And YAHWEH said to Moses, Go to Pharaoh, and say to him, So says YAHWEH, Send away My people that they may serve Me. And if you refuse to send them away, behold, I am about to smite all your territory with frogs. And the river will swarm with frogs. And they will go up and enter into their house, and into their bedrooms, and their couch, and into your servants' house, and into your people, and the ovens and into the kneading troughs. And the frogs will come up on you, and on your people, and on all your servants. And YAHWEH said to Moses, Say to Aaron, Stretch out*

your hand with your staff over the rivers, over the canals, and over the pools. And bring up frogs on the land of Egypt. And Aaron stretched out his hand over the waters of Egypt, and the frogs came up and covered the land of Egypt.

If we go to Revelation 16 in verse 13:

Revelation 16:13-15 *And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs come out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet. For they are spirits of demons doing great signs, which go forth to the kings of the earth, even of the whole inhabitable world to assemble them to the war of that day, the great day of El Shaddai. Behold, I am coming as a thief. **Blessed is the one watching and keeping the garments, that he does not walk naked, that they may see his shame.***

So remember, in Egypt right, **the plagues came on the Egyptians but they didn't come on the Israelites.** And now like I said, **Covid is like the starting point.** This is the first world-wide plague that's here. Praise Yahweh, I haven't heard of even one brethren that has died from Covid yet, but one thing is certain, as brethren who are going to be unbelieving, they will suffer the plagues as we see it.

You know that the plagues are coming, why ... because of unbelief. We looked at Pharaoh and the Egyptians, they didn't believe so more plagues had to come. And in Revelation, it's not only the world that's not believing, sometimes it's the brethren that are not believing. So **depending on what plagues are going to hit who and where is totally dependent on your faith and your belief.** Exodus 9 and verse 8 ... Exodus 9 and verse 8:

Exodus 9:8-12 *And YAHWEH said to Moses and to Aaron, Take for yourselves the fullness of your hand of soot from the furnace, and let Moses sprinkle it toward the heavens before Pharaoh's eyes. And let it become dust on all the land of Egypt, and let it become **boils breaking out into sores on man and on livestock in all the land of Egypt.** And they took soot of the furnace and stood before Pharaoh. And Moses sprinkled it toward the heavens, and it became a boil breaking out into the sores and man and on livestock. And the priests were not able to stand before Moses, because of the boils. For the boils were on the priests and on all the Egyptians. And YAHWEH made heavy Pharaoh's heart, but he did not listen to them, as YAHWEH said that He would do.*

So again here it is; because of their refusal to follow Yahweh, their refusal to unbelief, the boils come. If we go Revelation 16 ... Revelation 16 in 1 and 2:

Revelation 16:1-2 *And I heard a great voice out of the sanctuary saying to the seven cherubs: Go and pour out the bowls of the anger of YAHWEH onto the earth. And the first went away and poured out his bowl onto the earth. And it came to be a **bad and malignant ... boil a ... sore onto the men, the ones having the mark of the beast, and the ones worshipping its image.***

So we can speculate because now that we know what the mark is, we know it's some form of a chip. Now they're tattoo, nano-tattoo that's in you. You don't know what is inside that. I know some of these things have mercury, they have different things. We know that it's going to be extreme heat. It might 130/140 degrees, but whatever is going to happen, this chip is going to malfunction in the people and they're going to get sores and boils – the ones who take it ... so another reason to think because at the time, it's going to seem like you're crazy if you don't take it. Everybody wants it, right? If it's connected to a plague, then really everybody's going to want it. And then if it's connected to you can't leave your house, you can't get on a plane, you can't even buy in a supermarket without it, then of course everyone's going to want it. And if you're one of those few people that they're going to say, "You're so dumb that you didn't take this." But **then later, it's going to see that all the people that took it are getting these boils and these sores; and some of them dying from it; but the people of Yahweh won't.**

So again we see the parallel from Egypt to today; **boils on those who took the mark, not on the remnant of Yahshua.**
Exodus 11:6 and 7 ... Exodus 11:6 and 7:

Exodus 11:6-7 *And a great cry shall be in all the land of Egypt, such as never has been, and nothing shall be like it shall be again. And a dog shall not sharpen his tongue against all the sons of Israel, toward man and toward livestock, **so that they may know that YAHWEH distinguishes between Egypt and Israel.***

So again, pestilence on the world, but not on Yahweh's people. Let's go to Revelation 12:11 and 12 ... Revelation 12 ... or rather 10 ... 10 and 11:

Revelation 12:10-11 *And I heard a great voice in heaven, which said: Now is come the salvation, and the power and the kingdom of our Elohim, and the dominion of his Messiah: because the Accuser of our brethren is cast out, **the one who accuses them** before Elohim night and day. And **they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb, and because of the Word of their testimony.** And they did not love their soul even until death.*

So this is what saves Yahweh's people in the end from getting the plague; **what stops them from it is that the blood of the Lamb has covered them; they're protected by it.** And like we read here in Exodus here, right? It's coming on the sons of the world, but it didn't come on the people of Yahweh, why, because **Yahweh distinguishes between Egypt and Israel; between the world and His covenant people.**

So this is where real faith comes in, right? Because **like it says in the New Testament, if something is already given to you, where's the faith?** There's no faith if you're already had your prayer. **Faith is knowing Yahweh can do something, not that it's already done.** And like I said, **Yahweh is going to test us** because He's going to test us whether it's the vaccine or it's something else, all these things; because at the time all the people are going to do it; and all the people are going to be pressuring you. Whoever takes it is going to pay the consequences later.

And you're going to have the faith to say, "No, I'm not doing it! I believe in the scripture. I'm not doing it!" And then later on you'll see it's the same thing. You reap what you sow. And unfortunately, for the people in the world and people we know they're going to suffer if they follow these things. And if they're not following Yahweh ... because Yahweh distinguishes between Egypt and Israel. Yahweh distinguishes between the world and His people.

And like I say, you got a real bad plague that's going on and killing many, many people and world-wide. We have brethren all over the world and yet not one brother or sister has died yet. It doesn't mean they won't, but it hasn't happened ... it hasn't happened. And you know what's interesting? If you look on the *Worldometer* of all the countries with Covid, actually ... because we're not a very big Congregation, but we're most of our brethren are in where there's no Covid. If you look at the countries, look at the countries in Africa where there's virtually no cases that's where most of our brethren are. And they're actually some of the poorest countries that you'd think would be the worst hot spots, and yet that's where there is; because Yahweh distinguishes between Egypt and Israel. Revelation 9 in verse 20 ... Revelation 9 in verse 20:

Revelation 9:20-21 *And the rest of men, those not killed by these plagues, **did not repent of the works of their hands, that they will not worship demons, and "golden idols, and silver, and bronze, and stone, and wooden idols, which neither are able to see, nor to hear, nor to walk."** And they did not repent of their murders, nor of their witchcraft, nor of their fornications, nor of their thefts.*

So that's why I'm saying, don't be surprised if the world don't see this. Don't be surprised as we go further and it gets worse if people in the world just make excuses because they're not going to see it, even when they're being cursed.

Instead of changing and saying, "You know you're right." You know what they're going to do? They're going to start cursing Yahweh. That's what's going to happen at that point.

So this isn't for the world, it's for us. It's for us as His people to understand, right? **The people will still not repent even when the plagues come.** Here's Covid, right? Do you see a lot of people repenting out there? Do you see anybody, even in religious circles, questioning if this could be a plague from Yahweh; because of the sin that's in the world, none of them! I haven't heard anybody talk about anything like that ... just another coincidence, right ... just happened to happen. You know right at this time it just happened to happen. If we go back to Exodus ... Exodus 9 in verse 13 ... Exodus 9 in verse 13:

Exodus 9:13 *And YAHWEH said to Moses, Get up early in the morning and stand before Pharaoh, and say to him, So says YAHWEH the Elohim of the Hebrews, Send away My people that they may serve Me.*

So why are the plagues coming? Because **Yahweh wants His people to leave Egypt, to leave the world; and go to the wilderness to be sanctified.** And as both the people aren't listening, and the leaders, the world leaders aren't listening; because face it, are the world leaders listening in the world today? Not at all. Has anybody heard of *any world leader anywhere in the world that has talked about we need to change how we're doing things: Wow, with this plague here. We really need to believe. This could be from Elohim. We need to change our behavior. We need to ...* Not at all ... not one world leader had some out and said that. So now it gets more intensified because as they refuse to listen to Yahweh and as the people refuse to go in the wilderness, the plagues have to come more. So continuing here in verse 14:

Exodus 9:14-20 *For at that time I am going to send **all My plagues** to your heart, and on your servants, and on your people, **so that you may know that none is like Me in all the land.** For now I have sent forth My hand and have stricken you and your people with pestilence, and you have been destroyed from the earth. And for this reason I have made you stand, in order **to cause you to see My power** ... Yahweh speaking ... **and in order to declare My name in all the land.** You still are exalting yourself against My people, so as not to send them away. Behold! I will rain very **heavy hail** about this time tomorrow, such as has **never been in Egypt** from the day of its foundation until now. And now send out, bring your livestock to safety, and all belonging to you in the field. All men and livestock found in the field, and not brought to the house, and hail will come on them, or they will die. Of the servants of Pharaoh, the one who feared the Word of YAHWEH made his slaves and his livestock flee to the houses ... drop down to verse 23 ...*

Exodus 9:23-26 *And Moses stretched out his staff to the heaven. And YAHWEH gave sounds and hail. And **fire came to the earth, and YAHWEH rained hail on the land of Egypt.** And there was hail, and fire flashing in the midst of the hail, **very heavy**, which never had been in all the land of Egypt since it became a nation. And the hail struck in all the land of Egypt, all that was in the field, from men and livestock. And the hail struck every plant of the field, and it broke in pieces every tree of the field. **Only in the land of Goshen, where the sons of Israel lived, there was no hail.***

So again, does Yahweh protect His people? You better believe it, right? Now there's been hail like this before, right? And up to this sign there's probably never been hail like that again, but when are we going to get that hail again? Let's go to Revelation ... Revelation 16 ... Revelation 16 in verse 17:

Revelation 16:17, 18, 21 *And the seventh cherub poured out his bowl into the air, and a great voice came from the throne from the sanctuary of Heaven, saying, It has happened! And voices and thunders and lightnings occurred. And **a great earthquake occurred**, such as did not occur since man came into being on the earth, such a huge earthquake, so great! ... wow! And we've already seen in this world up to 9.5. You can only imagine what this could be. My guess is it's going to be above a 10. And who knows what damage. And then go to verse 21 ... **And a great hail, as the size of a***

talent ... a hundred pounds. Can you imagine 100 pound hailstones flying down ... *came down out of the heaven upon men. And men blasphemed Elohim from the plague of the hail, because its plague is exceedingly great.*

Right, so they're not crying out, they're not asking for help, they're not repenting. The pride is coming out and they're only getting more and more angrier and we see that in the world today, right? As these plagues come, are people having vigils in churches? No, they're going out and rioting. They're going out and breaking stuff. They're going out and looting. They're going out and doing all of these different things; and we're only just beginning ... just beginning. Go back to Exodus 10 now, 3 and 4:

Exodus 10:3-4 *And Moses and Aaron went in to Pharaoh and said to him, So says YAHWEH Elohim of the Hebrews, Until when will you refuse to humble yourself before Me? **Send away My people so that they may serve Me.** For if you refuse to send away My people, behold, I am going to bring **locusts** into your territory tomorrow ... drop down to verse 12.*

Exodus 10:12-15 *And YAHWEH said to Moses, Stretch out your hand for the locusts over the land of Egypt, so that they may go up on the land of Egypt and may eat every plant of the land, all that the hail left. And Moses stretched out his staff over the land of Egypt. And YAHWEH brought an east wind on the land all that day and all that night. And at morning the east wind lifted up the locusts. And the locusts went up over the land of Egypt, and rested on all the territory of Egypt, exceedingly many. Never were there locusts like them before, and afterward none will be like them again. And they covered the eye of the earth, and the land became dark. And they ate every plant of the land, and all the fruit of the trees that the hail had left. And no greenness was left in the trees and in the plants of the field in the land of Egypt.*

Isn't it interesting, just this year we had again, coming from Africa and then going over to the Middle East and even toward Asia; but **in Africa it literally ate every single thing in its path**. And like I said, many people didn't even plant ... *what's the point of planting? We're going to plant and then it's just going to be eaten away.* But our brethren planted in faith. **Our brethren prayed and they planted in faith** and what happened? The swarm of locusts came. They ate the neighbor's property; they ate all the properties around them; but when they came to the brethren, **like a canopy above them, they just kept going ... didn't touch anything**. And the plants there, the corn, the maize, it's higher than they've ever seen in their life.

We're harvesting now; it's the harvesting time over there that they're doing. And **we had to build bigger barns because we couldn't fit all the stuff that Yahweh blessed us with** because it's for all the different people in Kenya and other countries. Does Yahweh make a distinction between Egypt and His Covenant people? You better believe it. And again is it another coincidence? Is it another coincidence because I don't believe in coincidences. **There's no coincidences with Yahweh and He's shown us so much proof and so many miracles**, then shame on somebody that doesn't believe ... shame on anybody that doesn't believe. We've seen it firsthand, first hand with our people, right? **You're talking about, not an area; you're talking about a country that was decimated that nothing was left.** Look at the pictures, look at the videos on the internet ... **a hundred percent of it wiped out; and one little oasis in the middle that Yahweh blessed tremendously and nothing happened to it.** Praise Yahweh for that! Revelation 9 ... Revelation 9 in verse 3 ... Revelation 9 in verse 3 ... speaking again about locusts:

Revelation 9:3-4 *And out of the smoke locusts came forth to the earth. And authority was given to them, as the scorpions of the earth have authority. And it was said to them that **they should not harm the grass in the field, or every green thing, or every tree, except only the men who do not have the seal of YAHWEH on their foreheads.***

Comment: So like I said, get ready, if you don't take that mark, you are going to be pressured, ostracized. You won't be able to buy and sell. But later on, is where you're going to benefit because the ones who take the mark, this is what's going to happen. They're tormenting the ones who do not have the mark of Yahweh but have the mark of the beast.

Revelation 9:5-10 *And it was given to them that they should not kill them, but that they be tormented five months. And their torment is as the torment of a scorpion when it stings a man. And in those days men will seek death, and they will not find it. And they will long to die, yet death will flee from them. And the likenesses of the locusts were like horses having been prepared for war; and they had crowns on their heads like gold; and their faces were like faces of men. And their hair was like the hair of women; and their teeth like those of lions. And they had breastplates like iron breastplates; and the sound of their wings was like the sound of chariots with many horses running to war. And they have tails like scorpions, and their stings were in their tails; and **their authority is to harm men five months.***

It's interesting that's exactly how long those locusts were in Africa for when they went across there and basically decimated absolutely everything. So we see the African plague and then we see over here the locust plague, but Yahweh protects His people. Let's go back to Exodus 10 ... or rather, yeah Exodus 10 in verse 21:

Exodus 10:21-23 *And YAHWEH said to Moses, Stretch out your hand to the heavens so that **darkness** may be on the land of Egypt, and one may feel darkness. And Moses stretched out his hand to the heavens, and **darkness of gloom was in all the land of Egypt three days.** And they did not see each one his brother, and they did not rise up, each one from his place for three days. **Yet to all the sons of Israel there was light in their dwellings.***

Wow, so how does that happen? They don't live that far from each other, a couple of miles. And in one place it's so dark you can't see the hand in front of your face and the other place it's completely light; Yahweh's miracle. Like I said, **as long as we don't doubt, if He parted the Red Sea before and you honestly believe it, then what would make you doubt all these?** Because every single plague and every single blessing that came in Exodus is coming in our day. **The plague is coming for those who don't believe and the blessing is coming for those who do;** it's just a matter which side do you want to stand on, right? So there's darkness over all the earth. Revelation 16:10 and 11:

Revelation 16:10-11 *And the fifth cherub poured out his bowl onto the throne of the beast. And **its kingdom became darkened; and they gnawed their tongues from the pain.** And they blasphemed the Elohim of Heaven, from their pains and from their sores. And they did not repent of their works.*

So again just like in Egypt where the people didn't change, they didn't repent; we're going to see the same thing in the end time. And then the last plague, Exodus 11 ... Exodus 11 in verse 1:

Exodus 11:1-6 *And YAHWEH said to Moses, I will bring yet one more plague on Pharaoh and on Egypt. Afterward he will send you from here. When he sends you away completely, surely He will drive you out from here. Now speak into the ears of the people, and let them ask, each man from his neighbor, articles of silver and articles of gold. And **YAHWEH gave favor in the eyes of the Egyptians toward the people.** And the man Moses was very great in the land of Egypt, in the eyes of the servants of Pharaoh, and in the eyes of the people. And Moses said, So says YAHWEH, About the middle of the night I will go out in the midst of Egypt. And **every first-born in the land of Egypt will die,** from the first-born of Pharaoh, the one sitting on the throne, to the first-born of the slave-girl who is behind the mill; and every first born of animals. And a great cry shall be in all the land of Egypt, such as never has been, and nothing like it shall be again.*

So we see the last plague is the death of the first born. And then we go to Revelation 6, and this is a plague that will be on Yahweh's people - martyrism; but it's not because of punishment; it's because of honor. Revelation 6 in verse 9:

Revelation 6:9-11 *And when He opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those having been slain for the Word of YAHWEH, and for the witness which they had. And **they cried with a great voice, saying, Until when, holy and true Master, do You not judge and take vengeance for our blood,** from all those dwelling on the earth? And there was*

*given to each one a white robe. And it was said to them that they should rest for a little while, until might be fulfilled also the number of their **fellow-servants and their brethren**, those being about to be killed, even as they were.*

Revelation 13 in verse 7 also:

Revelation 13:7 *And it was given to the beast "to make war with the saints, to overcome them." And authority was given over every tribe and kindred and tongue and nation.*

So here we have it, all the plagues come on the earth but Yahweh protects His people because the plagues are not for the people of Yahweh. The plagues are for the earth. But then Yahweh allows satan to try the saints and satan is going to have a great martyrism; and although Yahweh is going to allow it, it's going to anger Him so much that that's where the Day of Yahweh comes where He'll wipe out the earth. He'll wipe out everybody that is not of the Truth, everybody who's not of Him; and that's why I said; in the end you see where there'll be very, very few men left like it talks about in **Psalm 24**.

So the purpose of the plagues, Exodus 8 in verse 25, the purpose of the plagues is because Yahweh keeps saying, "Send My people to the wilderness so they can worship Me." **We have to leave the world. We have to separate ourself because you cannot worship Yahweh properly if you're in Egypt.** Exodus 8 in verse 25:

Exodus 8:25-27 *And Pharaoh called for Moses and for Aaron, and said, Go! Sacrifice to your Elohim in the land ... the land of Egypt ... And Moses said, It is not right to do so, for we sacrifice the abomination of the Egyptians to YAHWEH our Elohim. Behold! If we sacrifice the abomination of the Egyptians before their eyes, will they not stone us? We will go into the wilderness, a journey of three days, and sacrifice to YAHWEH our Elohim, as He may say to us.*

So here it is like we said yesterday, **you cannot worship Yahweh properly if you're in Egypt.** And that's why the plagues are coming to take His people out to the wilderness. And Yahweh protects His people and makes a distinction between the Covenant people and Egypt the world, but then at the same rate, we understand that there will be a death of the first-born. There will be a martyrism that is actually an honor.

You know the Apostle Peter and all the apostles were martyred. Some believe the Apostle John wasn't ... I believe he was from some of the things I read; and also from what Yahshua said in **Matthew 20**. But the Apostle Peter, what happened was that he was in Rome and he knew they were coming and the brethren were trying to get him out of there and they actually snuck him away and took him out of the city; and when he got to the gate, he saw Yahshua before him. And he said, "Master, what do you want?" And He told him the words that He told him in **John 20**, if you remember when it said; it showed how he will glorify Me. And that's when Peter realized this is the time, he went back and he said the way he was crucified, he said, "I don't deserve the honor to be crucified like my Master. Please crucify me upside down." And they crucified him upside down.

So martyrism, like I said, in the twinkling of an eye, it's like you're alive and then death and then you're in the Kingdom. So there's no time in-between; it's actually a blessing and the greatest honor. And that's why I say that **the greatest physical honor now is being a Philadelphian – to be protected and blessed and go into the Kingdom; but the greatest eternal honor is the Smyrnian.** The one who is giving his life for Yahshua and will eternally be blessed for that.

But the purpose of the plagues is to get the people out of Egypt, out of the world. We cannot worship Elohim in satan's society. We have to come out and go to the wilderness. Back to Exodus 12 ... a few more scriptures here and we'll be finished, back to Exodus 12 in verse 30 because after that plague, what happened? Pharaoh let the Israelites go. Exodus 12 in verse 30:

Exodus 12:30-37 *And Pharaoh arose by night, he and all his servants, and all the Egyptians. And there was a **great cry in Egypt**, for there was **not a house where there was not a one who had died**. And he sent a proclamation to Moses and Aaron by night, and it read, *Arise, go out from the midst of my people, both you and the sons of Israel. And go serve YAHWEH according to the word. Take both your flocks and your herds, as you said, and go. And bless me also. And the Egyptians were strong on the people, to hasten them to send them away from the land. For they said, All of us will be dead. And the people took up their dough before it was leavened, their kneading troughs being bound up in their clothing on their shoulders. And the sons of Israel did according to the word of Moses. And they asked from the Egyptians articles of silver and articles of gold, and clothing. And YAHWEH gave favor to the people in the eyes of the Egyptians. And they granted their requests. And they plundered Egypt. And the sons of Israel traveled from Rameses to Succoth, the men being about six hundred thousand on foot, apart from the little ones ...* Drop down to verse 41 ...*

Exodus 12:41-42 *And it happened, from the end of four hundred and thirty years, it happened on this day, all the armies of YAHWEH went out of the land of Egypt. **It is a night of celebration to YAHWEH**, for bringing them out from the land of Egypt. This night is a celebration for all the sons of Israel to their generations.*

So Passover isn't a night of celebration; Passover is a sober night of death, the following night is. So the same way that Yahweh took, finally after all these plagues, and He took the Israelites where? Out of Egypt because they couldn't serve Him properly there; and He took them where? To the wilderness! We see the same parallel here Revelation 12 ... Revelation 12:13 and 14 ... Revelation 12 in verse 13:

Revelation 12:13-14, 17 *And when the dragon saw that he was cast onto the earth, he pursued the woman who bore the male child. And two wings of a great eagle were given to the woman, that she might fly into the wilderness, to her place, where she is nourished there for a time, and times, and half a time, away from the serpent's face ... and verse 17 ... And the dragon was enraged over the woman, and went to make war with the rest of her seed, those keeping the commandments of YAHWEH, and having the testimony of Yahshua.*

So again, the Philadelphians are taken to this place of safety. They're taken out of Egypt the same way the Israelites were taken out of Egypt, but **the Laodiceans who were not preparing now ... the Laodiceans who were the ones who were denying that this is happening, unfortunately they got left behind; and most of them are going to be the martyrs**. Most of them are going to be the ones that ... because I say that, how does Yahweh know? Yahweh's got to test us. I always say, life is a test. Well, how on earth can He know when you're talking about eternity? You know I look and it boggles my mind that people can't stay faithful for just ten or twenty or thirty years! You're talking about eternity, trillions and zillions and zillions of years; and someone can't stay faithful for just that!

We have people that baptized a year later they're falling away. Not even a year you could stay faithful! So **Yahweh's got to test us. He's not just going to make a million more, a billion more, satan the devils. He's got to see if you really mean it**. So how does He test us? **He tests us by faith**. That's the test! So now **while things are good** and now they're getting worse but I'm saying when things are good – **that's the time that He wants to see ... everything's perfect, no one's forcing this person. Is he doing the right thing? Are they following what I say? Are they taking it serious while there's no problem, there's no plague, while there's no trouble**.

Because you know what, like I say, every single crook that comes before the judge is repentant? Every single one when they're caught, right? They're reading that little thing, "I am so ... what's that word?" "Sorry ... sorry." "I am so sorry for what I did." They're not sorry. They're sorry they got caught. **If they were sorry for what they did, they would stop doing it! They would change, they would repent!** And Yahweh knows there's a lot of Laodiceans out there that simply will not change now.

So for the people that are taking it serious, for the people that are changing, for the people that are living this every day, He doesn't have to test them. They're the ones He takes to protection to get away from it; but to the Laodiceans He still loves them and the tribulation is their last chance; but they're going to have to give their life for it; because they're not showing Him now. And that will be the thing, they're going to have to stand up there and they're going to have to give their life and they're going to have to die, many of them, for as it says it here.

The bride leaves for the wilderness. The Laodicean is left behind. We need to learn the lessons that the Israelites did not learn; only one place to learn those lessons is in the wilderness. Ezekiel 20 in verse 34, as much as Covid and vaccines and mark of the beast are realities in our time today, this has got to be our reality also. The fact that it hasn't happened yet, doesn't mean the Word of Yahweh is going to be broken. Ezekiel 20 in verse 34:

Ezekiel 20:34-36 *And I will bring you out from the people and gather you from the lands in which you are scattered among them with a mighty hand and with an outstretched arm, and with fury poured out. And I will bring you into the wilderness of the people, and I will be judging with you there face to face. Just as I was judging your fathers in the wilderness of the land of Egypt, so I will be judging you, declares Adonai YAHWEH.*

Comment: So here it is, can you imagine we're looking, every single thing that happened in Egypt is every single thing that happens in Revelation. And now what does He say, **just as your fathers were in the wilderness, just as you'll be in the wilderness**, same exact parallel.

Ezekiel 20:37-38 *And I will cause you to pass under the rod ... showing ownership ... and I will bring you into the bond of the covenant. And I will purge from among you the rebels and the transgressors against Me ... the non-believers, right. The ones who have no faith ... I will bring them out of the land where they reside, but they will not enter into the land of Israel. And you shall know that I am YAHWEH.*

So you know when really when everything breaks down and the chaos is here, some of these Laodiceans then will be trying to run and hide to save their own skin; but they won't be doing it because of Yahweh, and He says, "But they're not going to enter the land of Israel." Because in the end of it, where does that bride end up? 144,000 ... Mount Zion ...

Revelation 14. But the rebels will not be there. **We need to learn the lessons that the Israelites did not learn. Only one place to learn them is the wilderness.** Last scripture, 1st Corinthians 10 ... it's like half of my scriptures have 1st Corinthians 10 in there, maybe more. Because that's the only scripture there that says **all this is written just for us ... 1st Corinthians 10:**

1st Corinthians 10:1-11 *And I do not want you to be ignorant, brothers that our fathers were all under the cloud, and all passed through the Sea. And all were baptized to Moses in the cloud, and in the Sea, and all ate the same **spiritual food**. And drank the same spiritual drink; for they drank of the spiritual rock following, and that Rock was Messiah. **Yet Elohim was not pleased with most of them, "For they were scattered in the deserted place."** But these things became **examples for us**, so that we may not be lusting after evil, as those indeed lusted. Neither be idolaters, even as some of them were, as it has been written, "The people sat down to eat and drink, and rose up to play." Nor should we commit fornication, as some of them fornicated, and twenty three thousand fell in one day. Neither let us tempt the Messiah, as some of them did, and were destroyed by serpents. Neither should you murmur, as also some of them murmured, and perished by the hand of the destroyer. **All these things happened to those as examples, and it was written for our warning**, on whom the ends of the world have come ... and last year I did a sermon on each of these breaking it down.*

All the things that happened to the Israelites were for our example today in the last generation. We must prepare, we must realize how weakened we have become living in the façade of the Babylonian system of satan. You will not get to the Promised Land if you stay in Egypt, the world. The only road to the Promised Land is through the wilderness.

The same plagues that Yahweh brought on Egypt are coming on the world today in our time. We're not strong enough to overcome on our own. We must enter the wilderness of Yahweh and allow His Spirit to guide and lead us and surrender to Yahweh in all things. Let Him fight our battles and overcome our false paradigms. So the next verse ... verse 12 says:

1st Corinthians 10:12 *So he who thinks he stand; let him be careful that he not fall.*

So right? As we're looking at all these things and the examples we need to learn; **it's only trusting Yahweh that's going to get us through.** It's not going to be whatever those foods are called, the MP, those military foods. It's not going to be being a prepper; it's not going to be storing thirty years of food. It's not going to be having solar suits for radiation ... *he who thinks he stand; take heed lest he fall.* It's only going to be **total trust in Yahweh** because Yahweh is the One. Like I said, the Israelites they did nothing. They stood back and saw the salvation of Yahweh; and Yahweh made that distinction between the world and His people and here we are today ... here we are today, right?

It's thirty-five hundred years later, but **now it's the second wilderness; and now the plagues have already started;** and now these things are happening. And we're already seeing it. We're already seeing whether it's the Covid that's very, very sad that so many have died in the world, but it hasn't affected Yahweh's people; whether it's the plague of the locusts. We see it. Every single thing was destroyed around it, not with the people of Yahweh. But we have to believe these things are real. The way out of tribulation is through the wilderness. We must seek it now. We must separate from the world as it corrupts us every day of our life. **The Israelites were only protected in the camp of Yah.** If someone stayed behind in Egypt or left the wilderness to go back to Egypt, they were on their own. They had no protection. Let us embrace this great road before us, knowing that Yahweh and His cherubs will go before us every step of the way.
