

Transcript - The Fear of Yah

Shabba Shalom again and Shabbat Shalom to all that will hear this message later. Today, I want to talk about a message that is vitally important. It is something that is completely missing out of Christianity but even in the body of Messiah, we don't always have it. It's called 'The Fear of Yahweh'. And I hope to show you by this message that not only is it important, it's absolutely vital. It's the key to everything. You're going to see all the different things that we are going to go here that without the fear of Yahweh, you will not be able to do.

Like I said, in Christianity there is absolutely no fear of Yahweh. One of the worst things that the false grace has brought people is ... it's dangerous and I say **Christianity is much more dangerous than Islam**. Islam, you know your enemy and you know who you are dealing with. And as horrific as it is to strap dynamite on yourself and blow up 20 people in a mall or wherever, it is a horrible thing; Christianity every week, pastors are strapping on spiritual dynamite and destroying congregations every week because they are teaching their congregations, you can live a **lawless life**, you can live a sinful life and that the Father is happy with that. And I see **very little fear of Yahweh in Christianity**.

They say you can tell all about religion by going to the Wailing Wall, the difference, the dichotomy of Christians and Jews, because you see the Christians there that they walk up to the wall, they touch it and they do all these things and there is no fear. Sometimes there is relationship, you know with true believers. I do think there is. But then there is the Jewish people, they go up to the wall and they walk backwards and they do all these things and they bow. And there is a certain amount of a **reverence** there but with the Jewish people, you see **no relationship**. So what we want to do is we want to put that right type of reverence with relationship and be the complete believer. But it's vitally important to our spiritual life to have the **right fear of Yahweh**.

If you look that word up for 'fear', it's Strong's #3372, and it's actually a dual meaning to it. It means 'to reverence' and 'to frighten', both. So when it comes to Yahweh, when I say to having the fear of Yahweh, in one sense I'm saying having the right respect of Yahweh. We need to **respect Him as the Creator of the universe** but in another sense, we as I am going to show you, we had **better fear him too**.

I heard a minister one time, talking and referring to Yahweh as 'Big Guy', 'the Big Guy' and I said, "Wow, This 'Guy', this Being is the Creator of the universe, of everything, that with a cough we could all be out of here. You don't refer to Him as 'Big Guy'." And you hear even a lot worse than that sometimes but the word, in the Hebrew, shows you have to reverence but you also have to be afraid of, both and it's not a concept in Christianity because why? Christianity is mostly filled with emotion.

And what is one of the first things with judgement? You deal with emotion and you'll never make proper judgement. That's what Satan does, he hooks people in by emotion, very emotional settings. Do you remember when we were having our meeting, one of the first meetings we were having and we were waiting for that group to come out of there? And what happened, they opened the door, everybody was hugging and crying and kissing and everything, and then that

afternoon, what happened? They all left the guide and were running back to America, they couldn't take it.

Emotional immaturity is a big problem; it's a message I am going to do soon on that. **It's a major problem** and why is it a problem? Because Satan is dealing with people's emotions and if you are not emotionally mature, if you can't control your emotion, you're in big trouble. Because the Holy Spirit is a Spirit of what? It's a Spirit that you should have **self-control**.

And people need to have the right fear but in Christianity, people don't fear Yahweh. They just want to look at Him as a loving Father and that's the ... they will say, "That's the God of the Old Testament that was judgement and this but my baby Jesus now is in my arms and He just loves me and just loves me the way I am" and it's false. It's absolutely false that these teachers are preaching people the law of Yahweh, His Torah, is nailed to a cross and you have no accountability to anything and just playing on people's emotions and calling it the Holy Spirit and it's really messed up. That is why I say Christianity is a much more dangerous religion than Islam. And in the long run, Christianity is taking a lot more lives than Islam is taking. We have to realize how dangerous it is, very very dangerous. Let's start in Psalm 96. Let's first start showing the reverence of Yahweh, the awesomeness and the reverence.

***Psa 96:1-4** O sing to YAHWEH a new song; sing to YAHWEH, all the earth. Sing to YAHWEH; **bless His name**, bear news of His salvation day by day ...Every day we should be bearing news of Yahshua, His Salvation ... Tell of **His glory** among the nations, **His wonders** among all people. For YAHWEH is great and greatly to be praised; He is to be **feared** above all elohims.*

***Psa 96:6-10** Honor and majesty are before Him; strength and beauty are in His sanctuary. Give to YAHWEH, O families of the people; give to YAHWEH glory and might. Give to YAHWEH the **glory due His name**; bring an offering and come into His courts. Oh worship YAHWEH in the beauty of holiness; tremble before Him, all the earth. Say among the nations, **YAHWEH reigns**; and, The world shall be established, it shall not be moved; **He shall judge** the peoples in uprightness.*

***Psa 96:13** before YAHWEH; for He comes; for He comes to judge the earth; He shall judge the world with righteousness, and the people with His faithfulness ...* And most in Christianity today, they don't believe there is a judgement day. They don't believe there will be any accountability for what their actions are whatsoever. And that's why you have a higher divorce rate within Christianity than you even do in the world, believe it or not because people see no accountability.

But do we feel this way? Do we feel the glory and wonders that Yahweh is doing? The other day we were going over in class some of our things and showing the promises of Yahweh, and Page was telling me yesterday that he was studying that and he almost lost his breath when he was looking at these blessings that Yahweh is promising and realizing how much we have been missing by not calling on these things. And do we do that? Do we understand, especially on the Sabbath day, the **awesomeness of His creative power**? Because what do we say again with a root of bitterness, if we are always just looking to the negatively, if we are seeing things negatively, the worst part about that is we are not praising Yahweh. Because ultimately, when we are complaining about something, we are not complaining about a person, we are not complaining about our husband or wife or children or boss or the guy down the street, when we are complaining who are we complaining against? Yahweh, because in **any situation** where you are living, **He put you there**. And if you have got a bad neighbor, what does that say? Like

Meha said ... the people were coming up to Yahweh and said He was a respecter of persons and say, "Why, look at the Jewish people. You are giving them all these things and you're giving them all these promises and you're giving them all these gifts. Why do you give them so much? You're giving them way more than the other people." And He said, "Na, na, na. Don't worry. I'm not giving them too much, wait till you see their neighbors!" So there is always the balance there, right? But if we are not praising Yahweh then it's going to bring a spirit that could be unappreciative. If we go to Psalm 33.

Psa 33:6-9 *Through the Word of YAHWEH the heavens were made; and all their host were made by the breath of His mouth. The waters of the sea were gathered like a heap, setting the depths in storehouses. Let all the earth **fear YAHWEH**; let all those living in the world stand in **awe of Him**. For **He spoke**, and it came into being; **He commanded**, and it stood fast*

And do we realize that? Like I said, none of us are our creator. There are certain words in Hebrew that are only for deity, only for Elohim and one of them is for 'to create', 'bara'. If you see that word, you will never see that with a human, it is always with just with deity because **only Yahweh is a Creator**. We could take tree and we could make it into a table but we could but we can't create something out of nothing. Can you imagine the awesomeness of Him that there is nothing, there is just blackness and just by thinking all this comes here? You know when you look at the human body, and you look at ... you have a hundred, million cells and every cell has hundred thousand configurations to it. If it wasn't exactly perfect, if one little thing of one cell was off, nothing in your body would work; your liver, your kidney, your heart, nothing and that the Father just somehow by the way of thought, put all this together. You know the **awesomeness of His creation**.

I try to, at least every Sabbath day ... I try to do it during the week too, but especially on the Sabbath day, I try to think about that, the awesomeness of Him as Creator of the universe, that what **He has done nobody can do** and that this Being ... that here we are. We are so incapacitated in our thoughts and we are so, even as humans we are only using 3% of our brain. And that this Eternal Being ... whenever somebody comes in and they're talking really smart. They have all those little letters at the end of their names; their PhD and CDF and FDD and all these other things and they are really smart. What happens? Whoa, how does he know all that stuff? And here is the Creator of the universe that would make these guys look like kindergarteners. He knows things about physics and black holes and things that we can't even concept.

And here it is, He loves us and He wants relationship with us. He wants to hear our opinion. He wants to hear what we have to say to Him. He wants to be involved in the littlest things in our life. How awesome, how **awesome as the Creator** that He is and do we show Him this reverence.

Isa 41:20-24 *so that they may see, and know, and set up, and understand together, that the hand of YAHWEH has done this; and the **Holy One of Israel has created it**. Bring your cause, says YAHWEH; let your strong reasons come near, says the King of Jacob. Let them draw near and tell us what shall happen; the former things, let them reveal what they are, that we may set our heart and know their end; or declare to us the coming things. Reveal the near things hereafter, so that we may know that you are Elohim ... He is actually mocking these false deities. He's saying, "C'mon, if you are such a false deity, tell us what's going to happen." ... Yea, do*

good, or do evil, that we may gaze and see together. Behold, you are of nothing; and your work of nothing; he who chooses you is an abomination.

Isa 41:26 *Who has declared from the beginning, that we may know; and before, that we may say, He is right? Yea, no one declares; yea, no one proclaims; yea, there is no one who hears your words.*

That's what we have said. Sometimes I think people give Satan too much credit. People all worried about the New World Order and worry about the government and Yahweh's laughing up there. **You have His Spirit dwelling in you** and the power in you is greater than the power in the world. So we don't want to give more credit. I've told the story before when we first came to Israel we met a man who claimed to be Elijah the prophet and when we realized he wasn't Elijah the prophet and he was an older guy, one sharp tooth sticking out of his mouth and real a yellor/screamer. And he started yelling at me one day and saying he's going to curse me and he's going to do this and that and I knew he had no power. I said, "Go ahead, you're Elijah the prophet, let's do it right now. Just like the real Elijah, call fire from heaven. Call fire from heaven, curse me right now. See if your cursing as a false prophet is greater than Yahweh's Spirit in me." And he couldn't say nothing. Don't fall for fear of the New World Order, don't fall for fear of false prophets, don't fear any man. Fear the one who can take your body and soul and destroy it in Gehenna. He's the only One we give reverence to ... is Yahweh. We don't have to fear man. But like He is saying here, He is taunting these false people absolutely taunting them.

Isa 40:12-17 *who has measured in His hand the waters and the heavens by a span meted out; and enclosed in the measure the dust of the earth, and weighed in the balance the mountains, and the hills in the scales ... This is at creation, almost like putting together a recipe for a cake and He's over here doing all these things and measuring the mountains to each other. Can you imagine how He is doing this? ... who has meted out the Spirit of YAHWEH, or a man His counsel taught Him? With whom did He take counsel, and who trained Him and taught Him in the path of justice; and taught Him knowledge, and made known to Him the way of discernment? Lo, **nations are as a drop** from a bucket, and are reckoned as dust of the scales. Lo, He takes up coasts as a little thing. And Lebanon is not enough to burn, nor are its beasts enough for a burnt offering. **All the nations are as nothing** before Him; to Him they are reckoned less than nothing and emptiness ... Wow, everything together, all nations, all people together are as one spit, one drop in a bucket. When you are putting equality together; eye for eye, tooth for tooth, life for life; every single thing, **every single person is a drop in the bucket to the greatness of Yahweh.***

Isa 40:18, 22 *And to whom will you liken El? Or what likeness will you array to Him? He who sits on the circle of the earth, even those living in it are like grasshoppers ... He's up there looking down and we are just like these little grasshoppers, here today, gone tomorrow ... He who stretches the heavens like a curtain, and spreads them like a tent to live in;*

Isa 40:26 *Lift up your eyes on high and look: Who has created these? Who brings out their host by number? By greatness of vigor, and might of power, **He calls them all by names**; not one is lacking ... **The amazingness of putting the universe**, I mean you are not talking about just a city or a nation or even planet. You are talking about the universe and they are finding out about billions and billions of stars and each one has it's own sun and billions and billions of this and this*

goes on and on and on. Your mind cannot even concept it. And to Yahweh it's just another day in paradise. He created all of it, everything. The **awesomeness of His creation**, it's unbelievable.

Again, sometimes people will ... I heard someone sometime say to me, "You know, I had one of my moments today and I yelled at Yahweh" and they chuckled, kind of. And I'm like, "Wow, you yelled at Yahweh? Do you know what you are doing? What do you mean, you yelled at Yahweh?" Sometime we have to realize, He's not like a person next to you. He's **the Almighty Creator of the universe. We don't yell at Yahweh**, no matter what the situation we are in. We show reverence to Him. Like I say, in my life I have made many mistakes, paid a lot of penalty for some of them but I always knew it wasn't Yahweh who caused my mistakes. It was my own stupidity, my own bad choices. Message I am going to give hopefully before the end of the school is over on choices. You know, you reap what you sow and if we are reaping seeds that were sowing bad results, we are going to yell to Yahweh?

Rom 9:15-16 *For He said to Moses, "I will have mercy on whomever I will have mercy, and I will pity whomever I will pity." So then, it is not within reach of the one willing, nor within reach of him running, but of the one showing the mercy of Yahweh.*

And you know at times, we sit here and we almost feel like to non-believers and to atheists that we have to justify Yahweh and it's like who are these people that they don't believe in Him which is about the stupidest thing in the world because even science proves there has to be a creator. And even Dr. Carl Baugh who is one of the best I have ever seen. He's got the evidence, The Creation Evidence Museum, and just unbelievable. He's a scientist being able to prove creation. He says, "I **never** try to prove to an atheist that Yahweh exists. **His honor and His glory** is far above that. It would be **beneath Him** for me to try to explain to someone that He exists to prove it to somebody." You know that what he is doing by showing all these things of creation is showing all the glory of Yahweh as the Creator of the universe. **It's beneath Him for us to try to convince a human**, a human that's born that's going to die; that we have to convince them that Yahweh is alive! C'mon, we're putting the cart before the horse. If people are that stupid ... what is it, Psalm 51 *the fool has said in his heart ...* or 54 ... *there is no Elohim? The fool has said in his heart there is no Elohim.* That's the **stupidest** thing a person can say especially in this day when we have DNA and all these other things that **scientifically** now, it's 120% that **something had to create all this**, that it is impossible that it came from nowhere.

So we want to make sure we are giving Him the reverence and realize **He owes us nothing**. We are justifying as if He owes us something. **He created us**. We are reaping our own results of what we are sowing and in His mercy instead of giving us what we all deserve, death, **in His mercy He's granting us forgiveness of sins**, giving us **eternal life**, even making us **co-heirs of the universe**. And at times we feel like He owes us something, huh? Unbelievable but we really need to keep this in perspective, that Yahweh owes us nothing. **We have to give Him the reverence and the respect for what He is giving us.**

Rev 15:4 *Who will not fear You, O YAHWEH, and glorify Your name? For You only are holy. For all the nations will come and will worship before You, because Your righteousness has been revealed.*

And one of the greatest things I look forward to when the kingdom comes ... I say go out here, where ever it is you live in your town, or if you are over here in Tiberius next week or wherever you are going to be; go around the town and see if you can **find one person** who is a covenant

person. **Find one person where you are that believes in Yahweh and lives to Yahweh every day of his life.** Find one person that **worships Yahweh every day** and **gives Him reverence as Creator** of the universe. It's hard; it's hard to even find one. And that's the thing I look forward to, when His kingdom comes like it says here, that **all nations will give Him glory.** No longer will a man have to tell his neighbor, "*Know Yahweh, they will all know Me, from the least to the greatest.*" That anywhere you go, that anyone you talk to, the conversation is going to be about how great Yahweh is. What a time that is going to be when His kingdom comes! What an awesome time that **every single thing that gives breath will give glory to Yahweh.** This is what He tells us from the Torah.

Deu 10:12,17 *And now, Israel, what has YAHWEH your Elohim asked of you, except to **fear YAHWEH your Elohim** ... to give Him proper respect ... to walk in all His ways, and to love Him, and to serve YAHWEH your Elohim with all your heart, and with all your soul; For YAHWEH your Elohim, He is the Elohim of Elohim, and the Master of Masters; the great, the mighty, the fearful Elohim who does not lift up faces, nor take a bribe.*

So what does He expect of us but to fear Him, to give Him the respect. Why is that? I have said that before. It's not that Yahweh is on an ego trip, He doesn't need our praise, He doesn't need us to feel good about Himself. So the key is, if we are not praising Him the right way, we are not going to be humble enough to keep things in perspective. I said this other day in class, what is pride? **Pride is only a lie; pride is a lie that is giving you a worth that's not really there.** So the reason why we want to **give Him the proper honor** is, it **puts us in perspective** of where we are and it keeps us from being prideful because pride is a lie. If you are living your life prideful, what are you going to do? You're going to live a lie. You are going to **think there is more of a worth to you that what is really there.** And what do we say, the only worth we have is the worth we have in Him. **As humans we have no worth beside Him.** None of us is a Creator. None of us have eternal life inherent in us beside ourself; we have **eternal life through His free gift** but we can't give ourself eternal life. And we want to make sure we are **giving Him the right reverence** so that we can keep things in perspective.

Now let's go to the second point, to frighten. So we are going over here, the part about giving proper reverence. Now, the part of this word 'to fear' literally means 'to frighten'. We **should be afraid of Yahweh** because of the power and the awesomeness. Has anybody ever lived through a really bad storm? Have you lived either through an earthquake, a hurricane, a tornado and were you frightened during that time? You might not think it if you have never been through it but you go through a storm, hurricane, tornado or something and you see the **power** of wind and the **power** of lightning and the **power** of thunder and I'll tell you, if it doesn't put a ... make the hair on the back stand, I don't know what will. And what is that? That's a hiccup to Yahweh. He created all that stuff ... They don't believe it but He does, He knows it and we have to think about that. **Are we frightened when we think of the power that He has?** That at the blink of His eye this whole earth can be gone.

Php 2:12 *So then, my beloved, even as you always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much rather in my absence, work out your salvation with fear and trembling ... **work out your salvation with fear and trembling** ... because it keeps you honest. **Fear is a good thing,** it keeps us humble. Fear is a motivating factor, in a good sense. We don't want to fear man. We don't want to fear ... what do we say, the acronym; **false evidence appearing real.** We don't want to fear false things; we don't want to live in a state of fear but **having the right fear of***

Yahweh is essential to salvation. You have to have the right fear of Yahweh, it's essential to your salvation.

Psa 119:120 *My flesh has **shivered because of Your fear**; and I have feared Your judgments.*

Mat 10:26-28 *Therefore, you should not fear them, for nothing is covered which will not be uncovered; and hidden, which will not be made known ... Like I said, we don't have to fear the New World Order. We don't have to fear the government or this or that, don't fear them ... *What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light. And what you hear in the ear, proclaim on the housetops* ... And many people are afraid. They are afraid to preach the truth because they are afraid they are going to get in trouble or they are get this. And he says ... *And you should not fear the ones killing the body, but not being able to kill the soul. But rather **fear Him ... the Father** ... being able to destroy both soul and body in Gehenna.**

Is the gift, the wages of sin, is it eternal life in hell? No, He says right here **fear the One who can destroy** ... and that means to completely destroy ... *the body and soul in Gehenna.* And because people preach that you can sin and the wages of sin is eternal life, people aren't fearing Yahweh. And what does it say when He returns? *There will be **weeping and gnashing of teeth.*** There are going to be **screams and howls** like you never heard before. If you think there were howls when the death angel was passing over in Egypt, this is going to be nothing compared to that. You are going to hear all throughout the earth, **people screaming and howling because the fear of Yahweh will be in that day.** The will have the fear of Yahweh in that day.

Psa 90:11 *Who knows the power of Your anger? And **as Your fear is, so is Your fury***

And I'll tell you something, Yahweh is all merciful and all loving. He's all kind but **you don't want to be in His way when He's angry.** It is going to be real when the Day of Yahweh comes and what happens? In the 6,000 years of man we have **never seen the His wrath.** You think Sodom and Gomorrah was His wrath? That wasn't His wrath, part of it, but not like you are going to see. You look and do a study on the wrath of Yahweh and you look when the Day of Yahweh comes, how He says "This is **the day of My anger.** I have had it up to here with this sin, with this false religion, with all these things." And when that day comes, it's going to be a **horrific time on the earth.** Says the **worst time** man has ever known and ever will be and the reason why the world is going to go through it is **because they are not fearing Yahweh** today. If they had the fear of Him today, they wouldn't have to go through that thing.

Let's go to Deut 13 and let's look in the Torah when some of the things Yahweh said were judgements, why He said it.

Deu 13:6-11 *If your brother, your mother's son, or your son, or your daughter, or the wife of your bosom, or your friend ... So these aren't people far away. These are the **closest people in your life** ... who is as your own soul, shall **entice you** secretly, saying, *Let us go and serve other elohim, which you have not known, you and your fathers, of the Elohim of the people around you, those near you or far off from you, from one end of the earth even to the other end of the earth, you shall **not consent** to him, **nor listen** to him, nor shall your eye have pity on him, nor shall you spare nor hide him. But you shall surely **kill him**; your hand shall be first upon him to cause him to die ... own relatives ... and the hand of all the people last. And you shall **stone him** with stones, and **he shall die**, for he has sought to drive you out from YAHWEH your**

*Elohim, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slaves. And **all Israel shall hear and fear**, and shall not again do any such wicked thing as this among you.*

We are missing it. We are missing it in the world but we are missing it even in Yahweh's congregation. **You're not seeing the fear of Yahweh.** You're not seeing people fear to disobey Him. And I see it and I'm telling you, even in the sense of somebody leaving their spouse ... and I am not talking about for adultery reasons. Two people can't get along, a husband and a wife, and one will leave the other one. They will go and remarry somebody even though the Bible clearly says it's adultery and no adulterer will be in the kingdom and they don't care. They don't care, there is no fear of Yahweh. People will lie to your face. I've have people swear before Yahweh before me and lie. And I'll say, "Now, this is before Yahweh. I'm taking you at your words" and they will lie to my face and swear before Yahweh. There is no fear of Yahweh, you don't see it and that is why there are so many problems today. Romans 3, look at what it says in the end-time about this, exactly what we are seeing today.

Rom 3:10-18 *According as it has been written, "There is **none righteous**, not even one! There is not one understanding; there is **not one seeking YAHWEH. All turned away**, they became worthless together, not one is doing goodness, not so much as one! Their throat is a tomb being opened; they used **deceit with their tongues**; the poison of asps is under their lips; whose mouth is full of **cursing and bitterness**. Their feet are swift to shed blood; ruin and misery are in their way; and they did **not know a way of peace**; there is **no fear of YAHWEH** before their eyes."*

And I will tell you something that is rampant in the congregation is gossip. People, exactly like it is saying here, **using their tongues as poison and gossiping**, sometimes right while someone is there and then, "Shhh, he's coming." Anything you have to say behind somebodies back, you should be able to say to their face. Gossip, rampant in the congregations at times and why? Because there is no fear of Yahweh in their eyes. When you look and gossip and you look at what Yahweh says about gossip. Look at Proverbs 6:17-20, **six things that Yahweh hates; most of them are dealing with gossip.** And people do it because they have **no fear of Yahweh.** They have no fear of Yahweh and what is the reason?

Ecc 8:11 *When sentence on an evil work is not executed speedily, on account of this the heart of the sons of men is fully set in them to do evil ...* Why is there no fear of Yahweh? Because it's not like it was. Back in the book of Exodus when we caught the man carrying sticks, "What do we do Yahweh?" "**Stone him to death that they may learn to fear Me.**" Immediate judgement for a bad act and **it is a deterrent**, believe me, it is. But today, what happens?

Pastors are not preaching righteousness. **Pastors are not even preaching what sin is.** You just having people come together, do whatever they want to do and there is **absolutely no accountability for actions** but it shouldn't be that way in the congregation of Yahweh. Scripture tells us we need to know how to act when we ask for His presence on our meetings. There needs to be some kind of structure, some kind of format. You can't just have everyone doing whatever is right in their own eyes. **There needs to be a standard each one of us has to each other.** If I'm out here in a bar 5 nights a week, what am I doing by coming into the congregation on Shabbat? I'm defiling every single person I meet. There needs to be a standard in each and every one of our lives that we are standing to when we come among each other. And the reason why people do it, the reason why people will go out and live lives of unholiness, lives

of ungodly tv, ungodly jobs, all kinds of evil during the week; is again there is no fear of Yahweh. **They have no fear in their life, no fear of the judgement that's coming, no fear of any of it.**

And it's because there hasn't been any kind of judicial order in the congregations. **People are getting away with it**, they are allowed to get away with it. There're people sometimes, they catch them for a crime after 20 years. They will do a crime, they will murder someone, do something and again, the fact that they weren't caught does that mean they weren't guilty? Of course not, but **sooner or later the judgement is going to come and on every one of us**, II Cor 5:10, each one of us will stand before the judgement seat of Messiah and give account of the deeds done in the flesh, good or evil. We want on that day for Him to say, "Come in My kingdom, good and faithful servant." We don't want Him to look at us and say, "I don't know you. I don't know you. Depart from Me you who work wickedness." So important that we have the fear of Yahweh and it should be a deterrent in our life to sin. We shouldn't not want to sin so people don't catch us, **we should not want to sin because Yahweh hates sin and it is something that will lead to death**. And we have to see even things like gossip, maligning, all these things are terrible sins before His sight and we want to make sure we are not getting involved in some of these things.

Exodus 20:18-20 And this is on Mount Sinai when the commandments are given and look at what He says ... *And all the people saw the **thunders**, and the **lightnings**, and the **sound** of the ram's horn, and the **smoking** mountain ...* What a sight that must have been when Yahweh's Presence was coming down. What a sight ... *And the people looked, and they **trembled**, and they stood from a distance ...* I know it would have made me tremble ... *And they said to Moses, You speak with us, and we will hear. And **let us not speak with Elohim that we not die** ...* Wow, why did Yahweh say, "You can't look on Me and live"? Because He is here and we are down here, we have to understand that ... *And Moses said to the people, Do not be afraid, for Elohim has come in order to **test** you, and so that **His fear may be on your faces, that you may not sin**.*

He came to test you that His fear may be on your faces that you don't sin and that's the key. It's there to get us having lives of holiness and **we should fear when we are doing things**, when we are having a root of bitterness, when we have spirits of anger, when we are saying something that's not true or we're lying; there should be a fear in us and **the fear is going to cause you to repent**. None of us are perfect, we make mistakes but without the fear of Yahweh, what happens? We usually won't repent. You'll go on and on and you won't repent. And look what He says about these people. Go to **Proverbs 1 about the people that are not getting the fear of Yahweh**. Look what He says will happen when the Day of Yahweh comes and His judgement is coming.

Pro 1:24-31 *Because I called, and **you refused**; I extended a hand, and none inclines, and you have **ignored all my counsel**, and you did **not desire my warning**. I also will laugh in your calamity, I will mock when your dread comes; when your dread comes like a storm; and your calamity arrives like a tempest, when distress and anguish come on you. Then they shall call on me, and I will not answer; they shall seek me early, but they shall not find me. Instead they **hated knowledge and chose not the fear of YAHWEH**. They did not desire my counsel; they **despised all my reproof**, and they shall eat of the fruit of their own way and be filled with their own lusts.*

When somebody comes up to us in a humble way and is sharing something that we are doing wrong, we should thank them, we should hug them as a brother or sister and **thank them that we are being corrected by Yahweh** for something that maybe wrong in our life and that we are able to get something set. But what does he say? What do we say in our class? That it's the wise that seeks instruction; it's the fool that doesn't want it. If we are unapproachable, if we won't take any kind of correction from anybody, what's going to happen? That's what we are reading here. In that day when his calamity comes, what does He say? "I'll laugh" ... the last thing I'll ever want ... have Yahweh laugh when this calamity is coming down because they didn't want to take His advice and why? Because they did not chose the fear of Yahweh. **It is so vital to our lives, to our spiritual lives, to have the right fear of Yahweh, absolutely vital.** Heb 10:26 talks about after we learn the truth, if we continue to sin and this is **one of the main scriptures** I go to when people say the Law is nailed to the cross and all these other kinds of things. Very very clear.

Heb 10:26-30 *For if we are willfully sinning after receiving the full knowledge of the truth, there remains no more sacrifice concerning sins ... How hard is that to understand? Once we learn the truth, if we continue in a lifestyle of sin, there is no more sacrifice for sins ... but he is ready for the fearful judgment and zealous fire being about to consume the adversaries. For if he, who transgressed the law of Moses, died without mercies, at the mouth of two or three witnesses; how much worse punishment do you think will be thought worthy to receive, the one trampling the Son of YAHWEH, and having counted the blood of the covenant as common in which he was sanctified, and having insulted the Spirit of grace? For we know Him who has said, "Vengeance belongs to Me; I will repay," says YAHWEH. And again, "YAHWEH will judge His people."...* So again, His grace in our life is for what? To forgive the sins that we as human beings all wind up doing but it **doesn't give us a license to continue living in sin.** It doesn't and if we do it's very clear, if we are living a lifestyle of sin His judgement is going to come.

Luke 21:26 Talking about the end-times ... **men fainting from fear, and expectation of the things coming on the earth. For the powers of the heavens will be shaken**

It's getting pretty bad out there now and financially things are starting to come to a peak. We are seeing weather conditions like we haven't seen in the history of mankind; earthquake, floods, all kinds of things. But really we haven't seen nothing yet. You haven't seen nothing yet. When you start getting earthquakes that are getting 14 on the Richter Scale, maybe 20 of the Richter Scale; things we couldn't even imagine. It's going to **split the earth in half**, all these different things. When you start having **hurricanes that just wipe a nation out**, famines like man has never seen since man has been here; we can't even imagine the horrific situation that's going to during the Day of Yahweh, during His wrath.

It's bad enough when the trumpets come, 1/3rd of the grass is burned up but during the wrath of Yahweh, **all of it**, all the green grass on earth, **all the water** is bitter, food supplies ... it gets to the point where **99% of the people on the earth today will not survive it.** They'll die. And it's not that He chooses this, **it's the people are choosing is for themselves because they don't have the fear of Yahweh.** And there will not be one person in His kingdom waving their fists in His face saying, "I'm going to do it my way." Not one. Not one person. And **now it's up to us to decide**, do we want to put on a cloak of humility and do we want to be part of the solution or do we want to be part of the problem? **Without the proper reverence to Yahweh, there is**

nowhere for us to go from there. It's not because He is full of vanity; it's to keep us in proper perspective. You have to be in proper perspective with a cloak of humility or we are basically useless to Yahweh. The early church knew about this. You look in Acts 9:31

Act 9:31 *Then, indeed, the assemblies throughout all Judea, and Galilee, and Samaria, had peace, having been built up and having gone on in the **fear of the Yahweh**. And they were increased in the comfort of the Holy Spirit ...* So by getting the foundation of the fear of Yahweh in our life, what does it do? It makes us accountable to each other. It makes us accountable to each other **by first it makes us accountable to Yahweh and by that fear it's making us accountable to each other.** And what did it do? It increased the comfort of the Holy Spirit by having that fear of Yahweh. Hebrews 12, another scripture that talks about this judgement.

Heb 12:25-26 *Watch that you do not refuse the One speaking; for if these did not escape, who refused Him who **divinely warned them on earth**, how much more shall we not, **if we refuse to hear him** who speaks with us from heaven? whose voice shook the earth then, but now He has promised, saying, "Yet once, I will shake not only the earth, but also the heavens." ...* Stars and planets coming out, 1/3rd of the moon getting knocked out, a 1/3rd of the sun; this is like Battle Star Galactica. We are going to see things like you have never seen before.

Heb 12:27-29 *Now the words "Yet once" make clear the removal of the things being shaken, as having been made, so that the **things not being shaken may remain**. For this reason, receiving an **unshakable kingdom**, let us have grace, by which **we may serve YAHWEH pleasingly, with reverence and awe**; for also, "Our Elohim is a consuming fire."... The **power and the might** that He has is enough that we should be giving Him this awe and this reverence every day of our lives. What does He say in the New Covenant?*

Jer 32:39-40 *And I will give them one heart and one way, that they may **fear Me** all the days, **for good** to them and to their sons after them. And I will cut an **everlasting covenant** with them, that I will not turn away from them, to do good to them. But I will put **My fear in their heart, that they shall not depart from Me** ...* See, the fear of Yahweh in our heart is what keeps us serving Him every day and as we are going to see here in the rest of the message, it leads to absolutely everything. **Absolutely everything starts with the fear of Yahweh.** If we don't fear Him, if you have no fear of the only Being in the universe that can take your soul and burn it in Gehenna then you don't have much hope. **We must fear Yahweh properly.** I want to show now what this fear leads to.

First thing this fear of Yahweh leads to is knowledge. You want to know your Bible better, you want to have more spiritual knowledge, have the fear of Yahweh; can't have it without it.

Pro 1:7 *The fear of YAHWEH is the beginning of knowledge ... pretty simple ... **fools despise wisdom and instruction** ...* Sorry to say, many people who have taken up positions of leadership, I don't know if a lot of these guys got their ordination papers at the back of a magazine somewhere but a lot of these guys are not approachable. They are absolutely not approachable. The fear of Yahweh is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction.

Psa 25:12-14 *What man is he who fears YAHWEH? He teaches him the way he should choose. His soul shall abide in good, and his seed shall inherit the earth. **The secret of YAHWEH is with those who fear Him; and He will make them know His covenant.***

Every one of us has come from somewhere but when you think in your own life or you talk to people who have come to the truth, where does it usually start? The fear of Yahweh. You know with people you are trying to share the truth and they have no desire, what usually stops them? They have no fear. They are only focused on physical things, whatever, but what He says here, *the secret of YAHWEH is with those who fear Him; and He will make them know His covenant.* Usually and I said this before, that unless somebody understands they are a sinner and they understand this isn't just an analogy ... **'I have done things that deserve the death penalty, and I will pay that death penalty that there is a real Elohim in heaven, there is a real judgement day, and I am going to the lake of fire.'** Until you realize that, there is no salvation and if that doesn't put a little fear in your pants, I don't know what will. But once you get to that point, that you have this fear because of that, that's where you can come to Yahweh in humility and **He can take it away.** That's where His Son's blood can cover your sins but **if you don't have any fear of Yahweh, you won't even start to understand.**

You can talk to people until you are blue in the face about the Sabbath and these other things and what happens, they don't understand it. Talk to someone about the name of Yahweh and listen to what they say. "It doesn't matter. He answers to everything." Does that sound like fear? But I will tell you, anybody who has the fear of Yahweh will reverence His name, anybody. **How on earth can we fear Him and say His name doesn't matter?** When you can go into over 5,000 scriptures that talk about reverencing His name; there isn't a person on earth, **the fear of Yahweh will lead to giving reverence to His name** because you don't want to call Him the wrong name. You don't want to do something that is disrespectful to Him. But the fear of Yahweh leads to knowledge.

Second point, the fear of Yahweh leads to obedience.

*Deu 8:5-6 And you have known with your heart that as a man disciplines his son, YAHWEH your Elohim disciplines you. And **you shall keep the commandments of YAHWEH your Elohim, to walk in His ways, and to fear Him.***

If we go to Psalm 111, one of my favorite Psalms, awesome Psalm.

*Psa 111:1-10 Praise Yahweh! **I will thank YAHWEH with all my heart;** in the council of the upright, and of the assembly. The works of YAHWEH are great, sought out by all those desiring them. His work is honorable and glorious; and His righteousness is standing forever. He has made a memorial for His wonders; YAHWEH is gracious and full of pity. **He has given food to those who fear Him; He will always remember His covenant.** He has shown to His people the power of His works, to give to them the inheritance of the nations. The works of His hands are truth and judgment all His commandments are true, standing firm forever and ever; they are done in truth and uprightness. He sent redemption to His people; He has commanded His covenant forever; **holy and awesome is His name.** The **fear of YAHWEH is the beginning of wisdom; a good understanding to all those who are practicing them;** His praise is standing forever! ...The fear of Yahweh leads to wisdom and obedience.*

*Deu 6:24 And YAHWEH commanded us to **do** all these statutes, to **fear YAHWEH our Elohim for our good forever, to keep us alive,** as today ... It's a matter of life and death. **The fear of Yahweh is a matter of life and death.***

Next point, the fear of Yahweh leads to submission.

Eph 5:21 *Having been **subject to one another in the fear of Yahweh** ...* And what's the reason why we submit to one another? Because we fear Yahweh and His Spirit is in each one of us. And like I said, as a leader it scares me to death if I was to abuse one of Yahweh's children. You're His children; you're His chosen kings and priests. If I abuse that, I'm abusing a child of the King. And I do, I have fear of that. I have fear because I know they are Yahweh's children.

So the fear of Yahweh leads to submission, same in family situations, judicial order; the man is over the woman as Messiah is over the congregation. And **a woman should be subject to her husband for the fear of Yahweh** because it is Yahweh's judicial order He put there. And a lot of times you don't see it, you don't see fear. I look at certain scriptures that are so clear ... same, a woman sitting in the seat of Moses and there is women that will come and sit in that seat boldly and tell you this and that and you can't have the fear of Yahweh. Something so clear from scripture that a woman is not to sit in the seat of authority of a man **and to take that seat, when scripture is clearly against it, you can't have the fear of Yahweh** because it's not Don who said this or Bill or this one. It's Yahweh, it's His Word. **We should fear to disobey that word.** And whatever that word says, as hard as it is in our life ... and like I said we have all come from somewhere. I was brought up with none of Yahweh's ways. I had to change every single thing in my life but as soon as I found something out, it was okay, He says it, that's fine. I don't want to have a penalty hanging over me. We want to make sure the fear of Yahweh leads to submission. **We follow judicial order out of fear and respect for Yahweh.**

The fear of Yahweh leads to humility.

Deu 17:18-20 *And it shall be, when he sits on the throne of his kingdom, he shall write for himself a copy of this Torah in a book, from before the priests, the Levites. And it shall be with him, and he shall read in it all the days of his life, that he may **learn to fear YAHWEH your Elohim, to keep all the Words of this Torah and these statutes, to do them** ...* Now this is even the king had to learn the fear of Yahweh ... *so that his heart may not be lifted up above his brothers, and that he may not turn aside from the commandment, to the right or to the left; so that he may prolong his days over his kingdom, he and his sons in the midst of Israel ...* So the fear of Yahweh leads to humility even to the point of a king.

Pro 8:13 *The fear of YAHWEH is to hate evil; I hate pride and loftiness, and the evil way, and the perverse mouth ...* What we said in our class, Yahweh resists the proud and gives grace to the humble. **Without humility we are not even under grace.** Our sins are still hanging over us. **Humility is a major requirement for being in His kingdom.**

Pro 15:31-33 *The ear that hears the reproof of life shall remain among the wise. He who ignores correction despises his own soul, but he who hears reproof gets a sound heart. **The fear of YAHWEH is instruction in wisdom, and before honor is humility** ...* One of the reasons it says not to lay hands on no man quickly, lest he get puffed up because before honor comes is humility. Somebody has to learn humility before he can get honored. In the world it is the total opposite. You see a lot of people who have never ever worked a job and because they come from a rich family or whatever, they are put in these positions and they don't know how to deal with people. One of the worst things in the world is a life-time politician, that's the last person you want to be around, that's going to get up there and he's a good actor so he knows how to tell you how he feels bad for you. Think, how can he know how bad I feel? This guy that has two houses, one over here and one over there; he's getting hundreds of thousands of dollars a year

and every kind of perk in the world; he's never felt want or need for anything; he's rubbing shoulders with all the big-wigs and he knows how this little widow feels that electric has gone up 14% in the last year when she doesn't have the money to pay for it. They don't know; they have no idea. So humility has to come first. The fear of Yahweh leads to humility.

Next one is the fear of Yahweh leads to grace.

Psa 103:6-13 *YAHWEH works righteous deeds and judgments for all the oppressed. **He made known His ways to Moses**, His acts to the sons of Israel. **YAHWEH is merciful and gracious**, slow to anger, and of abundant mercy. He will not always strive, nor will He keep His anger forever. He has not done to us according to our sins, nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. For as the heavens are above the earth, so is **His mercy mighty over those who fear Him**. As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us. As the **pity** of a father over his sons, **so YAHWEH pities those who fear Him** ..The fear of Yahweh leads to grace. Without the fear of Yahweh, there is no grace.*

The fear of Yahweh leads to faith. The fear of Yahweh leads us to have total reliance on Him. Like we said, fear no man, what man can do to you but fear the one who can take your soul and destroy it in Gehenna.

Deu 20:1-4 *When you go out to battle against your enemies, and see horses and chariots, a people more than you, you shall not be afraid of them. For YAHWEH your Elohim is with you, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt. And it shall be, when you draw near to battle, the priest shall come and speak to the people, and say to them. Hear, Israel, you are drawing near today to battle against your enemies. Do not let your heart be faint; do not fear nor tremble, nor be terrified before their faces **for YAHWEH your Elohim is He who is going before you, to fight for you against your enemies, to save you** ...The fear of Yahweh will lead to what? It will lead to total reliance on Him.*

Psa 27:1-9 *YAHWEH is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? **YAHWEH is the strength of my life**; of whom shall I be afraid? When the evildoers, my enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat my flesh, they stumbled and fell. If an army should camp against me, my heart shall not fear. Though war rises against me, in this I am trusting. One thing I have asked from YAHWEH, it I will seek: my dwelling in the house of YAHWEH all the days of my life, to behold the delight of YAHWEH, and to inquire in His sanctuary. **For in the day of evil He shall hide me in His shelter**; in the secrecy of His tabernacle He shall hide me; He shall lift me up on a rock. And now my head shall be lifted up above my enemies, my encirclers, and **I will offer sacrifices of joy in His tabernacle**; I will sing, yea, I will sing praises to YAHWEH. Hear, O YAHWEH, my voice when I call, and favor me, and answer me. My heart said to You, Seek my face; Your face, O YAHWEH, I will seek. Do not hide Your face from me; Do not turn away Your servant in anger; You have been my help, do not leave me nor forsake me, O Elohim of my salvation.*

So if Yahweh is for us, who can be against us? People will ask us, a lot of times they will say, "If war breaks out, what are you going to do? Are you going to leave Israel?" Who's going to war? This is Yahweh's dwelling place. You think He is afraid of these armies of the earth? We already know what happens at Armageddon. It's not Yahweh who fails; blood-bridle-high, 7 months to clear the bones. You don't want to get on the wrong side of the Eternal Creator of the universe. You think we need to fear, His people that He has a remnant in the land? I fear for the people that are coming for us. Don't have to fear man, no way; fear Yahweh. And I'll tell you, it sure

makes you sleep better at night. It sure makes you feel better at night when you have the fear of Yahweh. I think sometimes when it talks about Yahshua was on the earth, how He used to sleep outside near the Mount of Olives and there were a lot of wild animals, there were a lot of bandits coming by. Do you think He feared those things? I'll bet those animals were probably running and getting food and bringing it to Him and serving Him. That's the fear of Yahweh, **we don't have to fear the elements of the world when we're in relationship with Yahweh.**

Psa 33:18-22 Behold the eye of YAHWEH is to those who **fear Him**, on those **who hope in His mercy**; to deliver their soul from death, and to keep them alive in famine. Our soul waits for YAHWEH; He is our help and shield. For our heart rejoices in Him because **we trust in His holy name**. Let Your mercy be upon us, O YAHWEH, even as we trust for You ... Fear of Yahweh leads to what? Total faith and reliance on Him

Next one, fear of Yahweh leads to love.

Deu 6:1-5 Now this is the commandment, the statute and the judgments which YAHWEH your Elohim commanded to teach you, **to do them in the land** to which you are crossing over, to possess it, **that you might fear YAHWEH your Elohim**, to keep all His statutes and His commandments which I command you; you, and your son, and your son's son, **all the days of your life**; and that your days may be prolonged. Hear, then, O Israel, and take heed to do it, that it may be well with you, that you may increase greatly, as YAHWEH the Elohim of your fathers has promised you, in the land flowing with milk and honey. Hear, O Israel, YAHWEH our Elohim is YAHWEH echad. And you **shall love YAHWEH your Elohim with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might.**

It's just like our earthly fathers, you grow up and as kids you don't always understand our father but you have this respect ... at least you did in the olden days, you would respect your father and you would never think of talking back to your father or doing something against him. But what happens as you get older and your father gets older, that respect and that fear you had as a kid because you didn't want to get the back side of a slap, it turns really into love. And it happens as your father gets older, **you have so much respect for him bringing you up and caring for you** and all those things; that as your father is older, **you give him even more reverence and respect that you did when you were a child.** And it's not that you are fearing him that you are fearing he is going to hit you or anything like that, **it's the love that built through that respect.** And it's so important; it's the same with Yahweh. What is it? **The fear of Yahweh is the beginning of knowledge and obedience and submission and humility but that fear should be turning into love.** Really it should be turning into a deep love that we should have for Him because of all He is doing for us.

Next point, the fear of Yahweh leads to praise.

Psa 22:22-26 I will declare Your name to My brothers; I will **praise You** in the midst of the assembly. **You who fear YAHWEH, praise Him**; all the seed of Jacob, glorify Him; and all the seed of Israel, fear Him. For He has not despised nor hated the affliction of the afflicted; and He has not hidden His face from Him, but when He cried to Him, He heard. My praise shall be of You in the great assembly; I will pay My vows before those fearing Him. The meek shall eat and be satisfied; **those who seek YAHWEH shall praise Him**; your heart shall live forever.

Exo 15:10-14 This is when they were crossing the Red Sea ... *You blew with Your wind, the sea covered them; they sank like lead in mighty waters. Who is like You among the Elohim, O YAHWEH? Who is like You, **glorified in holiness, fearful in praises**, O Worker of wonders? You stretched Your right hand; the earth swallowed them. **In Your mercy You led the people whom You redeemed**; You guided in Your strength to Your holy dwelling. Peoples heard; they tremble; trembling seized the dwellers of Philistia ...* Wow, what an awesome thing, huh? The Red Sea crossing and how the Father protected them. Talk about the fear of Yahweh, they learned it in that day.

Rev 14:7 *saying in a great voice, **Fear YAHWEH, and give glory to Him**, because the hour of His judgment has come; also, **Worship Him** who has made the heaven, and the earth, and the sea, and the springs of waters.*

It's really interesting because you have two types of people in the end-time, right? It's a real dichotomy, it's like light and darkness. You have the people who take the mark of the beast; you have people who take the mark of Yahweh. You see the opposite of it. And then what happens? You have these plagues that are coming and what happens? The ones who take the mark of the beast, do they fear Yahweh? No, **they curse Yahweh for the plagues that are coming**. And the people who know Yahweh who are covenant people, what do they do? **The ones who fear Him, bless Him because He is purifying the earth**. That's in the end-time; it's cut and dry, you are either fearing Him and praising Him, or you're cursing Him. It's one or the other.

The next point, the fear of Yahweh leads to mercy.

Psa 147:11 *YAHWEH takes pleasure in those who **fear Him**, those who **hope in His mercy**.*

The next one, the fear of Yahweh leads to holiness.

2Co 7:1 *Then having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh and of spirit, perfecting **holiness in the fear of Yahweh**.*

Heb 12:14 *Eagerly pursue peace and **holiness** with all, without which no one will see YAHWEH ...* Without holiness, you will not see Yahweh and the fear of Yahweh leads to holiness.

Rev 19:5 *And a voice came out from the throne, saying, **Praise our Elohim, all His servants, and the ones fearing Him, the small and the great***

So what do we see here? We see that the fear of Yahweh is two-fold; we need one, to be in awe of Him, to reverence Him but literally we need to be afraid of the power that He has. And we see that the fear of Yahweh leads to knowledge, obedience, wisdom, submission, humility, grace, faith, reliance, love, praise, mercy, holiness; just about everything, **all the fruits of the Holy Spirit**. So the fear of Yahweh is the key now.

Look in Christianity. Christianity has no fear of Yahweh because there is no judgement and yet **Christianity is using a counterfeit gifts of the Spirit that's actually demonic and it's the total opposite of what Yahweh is**. We are seeing the **fear of Yahweh leads to the true gifts of the Holy Spirit**, all the things; love, mercy, holiness, praise, faith, grace. And yet they are using a counterfeit that's bringing what? Demonic presence and the more they get into the demonic presence, what happens. They even have less and less fear.

And for you to tell somebody where their sins are going to lead to, if you told someone the wages of sin is death, oh, they would say you are evil and you are wicked. They don't serve a God that is judgeful, they only serve a God that loves. That's the kind of things you hear. So it's a scary scary thing but the last scripture we are going to go over Eccl 12. Now here it is; Solomon the wisest man, from a physical standpoint, whoever lived and at the end of his life when **he did everything** and there was absolutely nothing left to him that he didn't do. Look what he says.

Ecc 12:13-14 *Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter ...* So this is the end of it. Perfect Rabbinical midrash, give you this side, give you that side, let's hear the conclusion now ... **Fear Yahweh, and keep His commandments; for this applies to every man ...** And literally, in the Hebrew, what it says is 'what makes man complete' ... **that without fearing Yahweh and keeping His commandments, man is not complete ...** *For Yahweh shall bring every work into judgment, with all that is hidden, whether it is good, or whether it is evil*

Oh, there's a judgement day coming. It's everywhere in scripture; Old Covenant, New Covenant, in between the Covenants, over the Covenants, under the Covenants. It's everywhere. There's a judgement day coming. The key is, where will we stand on that judgement day? Because it's not the Father ... He doesn't take pleasure that **one** soul shall perish, but we have free will. Every one of us has free will when we are making choices and the choices we are making and the decisions we are making is going to depend on where we are going to be for eternity ... whether we are going to go the lake of fire and burn to death or whether we are going to be in His kingdom.

It's so so important. In Christianity, it's nowhere, absolutely nowhere. There is something now. It's one of the biggest tv stations, Christian tv station, probably the biggest in the world; something called Trinity Broadcast. Probably a lot of you have heard from it. And they have started other satellite networks and they have a network called JCTV. We know our Savior's name isn't Jesus Christ, it's Yahshua Ha Maschia. But even so, they believe it's Jesus Christ and to make a network and call it JCTV where they play rock music about 18 hours a day and just blaspheme His name over and over again. Is that showing respect? **There is absolutely not respect or judgement out there in the world.** Sad to say, there is a lot of the fear of Yahweh that is missing among us.

Because it shouldn't be from a person, you don't need your elder or overseer trying to instill the fear of Yahweh. I'm not saying they should become Baptist congregations. **The fear of Yahweh should be in every single one of us and we should bring that to each other when we come here.** You know that the Spirit testifies against itself that we are the children of Yahweh. The same Spirit that is in me is in you, and in you, and in you. And **by reading this Book, all of us should be giving that reverence to Yahweh.** All of us should be giving that respect to Him that should be bringing a spiritual atmosphere in our congregations that people in the world will not even be able to understand. It should bring a higher element to our learning, to everything of our life. Because if we all had the proper fear of Yahweh, we would have more knowledge, obedience, submission, humility, wisdom, grace, faith, love, mercy, praise, all of it.

And that is the key, the key is that **each one of us** has got to start looking in this Book and looking at this subject and start getting that each one of us, no matter what it is in our life, that **we fear Yahweh and we love Him.** That that fear of literal frightening is **turning more into awe and respect** and, man, **I love Him so much I would never want to do anything that**

goes against His Word. I don't care what it is, I love Him too much I don't want to do anything against His Word. And **when we get that collectively,** that's when you are going to see the roof raised. That's what it's about, that's where you will **see more spiritual gifts,** that's where you will **see the body working more together.** But without the fear of Yahweh, there is nowhere to go from there, there's nowhere to go. In the false gospel, the fear of Yahweh is missing; no fear to sin, no fear to disobedience, no fear to change scripture. And what does Proverbs 16:25 tell us?

Pro 16:25 There is a way that seems right to a man, but the end of it is the ways of death.

We need to both fear Yahweh ... it's the beginning of our relationship and every gift of the Spirit. And without the fear of Yahweh, there is no life.
