

Transcript – Elder Juancho Sukkot 2025

Hey Shalom and Chag Semeach. Again is thanks to Yahweh for this advantage again to speak to the world here in the wilderness. And I'm going to deliver a message today that I think is also timely and precise. As we also now are seeing the fulfillment of what has been prophesied from the Scriptures in this end time. As we see the rumors of wars, the nations against nations, kingdoms against kingdoms. And also the tragedy that is now happening in just recently today, earthquake is happening there in Asia, particularly in our country, the Philippines.

Because the Bible is really saying what is to be done or what will happen in the end of days. And as we all know also that the Bible is - one third of it is the prophecy now. And 80% and 90% of this is for the end time. So we should be thinking of this and realizing these things. All of these prophecies from the Scripture is now fulfilling, even in our own eyes.

And but something is ... there are supposed to be Bible believing people in the world did not understand these things. They are not really focusing on what would be happening in this end time. It's because probably because of these messages that we are not discussing. So this message is called, *Why Rapture is False*.

So why rapture is false? So maybe because the people don't want to risk their lives or even, I mean, undergo this kind of ... they don't want to undergo these trials, these tests and even persecutions because they believe that they will be raptured during this time. So is this really true? Is this really what the Bible is saying?

So this rapture theory believes that the Bible believing or the saints in this end time will be raptured before any end time tribulation begins. So that is what they believe. And also, allegedly Yahshua will come twice. One is on the rapture and the second is, would be on the second coming. They are together with the saints to fight against the enemies in Armageddon. So that is what they believe.

And another thing is they also believe that in this end time during the rapture, many would come into the faith and eventually there will be a great revival as they claim would be in this end time. So this is what they believe. And we will go into the scripture to find out what it would be or what would be, it says about this claim.

But before we go over to that, let us first know - who is the one who started this false belief of rapture theory. So this was started with the 1830's and this was started with a man, a Scottish preacher, a charismatic Scottish preacher named Edward Irving. And eventually it was developed and spread out by a man, John Nelson Darby in the 19th century. And eventually and unfortunately until now, this is the famous teachings of the Christendom.

And the last ones we did also before. Until I discovered it from the Scripture. Now the teachers and the believers of this pre-tribulation rapture believe that although the word rapture would not be found in the Scripture, but allegedly **the thought of it** is in there. So is it really correct?

So now what also their basis on this, believing this theory and teaching the people to believe in this because they find out some of the passages that they are using to support their beliefs. One of those is in 1st Thessalonians 1 verse 10. 1st Thessalonians 1 ... chapter 1 verse 10. It says:

1st Thessalonians 1:10 *and to await His Son from Heaven, even Yahshua, whom He raised from the dead, for it is He who will deliver us from the coming wrath.*

So this is what they believe. That when this came and this tragedy came or persecutions or persecutions came, they will be waiting for the Messiah Yahshua whom the Father raised from the dead to deliver them from this wrath. So they believe that this wrath is that what they're will be delivering from.

If we do research from the Scriptures, this word wrath will be bringing into this world by Yahshua Himself when He returns as a punishment for the wicked. And also for those who rejected the truth. So there is no any related whatsoever to the pre-tribulation rapture.

Another one is on Revelation chapter 4. If you open a Bible in the book of Revelation chapter 4, it says ... so what does the Bible say?

Revelation 4:1 *After these things I saw. And behold, a door being opened in Heaven! And I heard the first voice as a trumpet speaking with me, saying, Come up here, and I will show you what needs to happen after these things.*

So these rapture believing teachers and those who believe in it, believes that the Revelation 3 of 2 and 3, the chapter 2 and 3 of the book of Revelation, that we already know that this is about the seven congregations in Asia. Now, it says about them and in chapter 4 as we are now reading, this is the one that the church has been invited to come up into heaven. So that is what they believe. So is this really what the verse interpreted for? No!

So as we know that this verse has been inviting or taking John, the beloved, to come up into the spirit to see visions. There is nothing related to the church to be brought into heaven and so the rapture happens. So this is not. So another verse that they are claiming to support their belief is that in the Book of Luke chapter 17, beginning verse 26.

Luke 17:26-28 *And as it was in the days of Noah, so also it will be in the days of the Son of Man. They were eating, drinking, marrying, giving in marriage, until the day Noah went into the ark. And the flood came and destroyed all. And likewise, as it was in the days of Lot, they were eating, drinking, buying, selling, planting, building;*

Luke 17:29-30 *but on the day Lot went out from Sodom, YAHWEH rained down fire and brimstone from the heaven and destroyed all of them. According to those things, it will be in the day the Son of Man is revealed.*

So, it is also noted as they claim that before Yahweh punished the world during Noah's time and during Lot's time, the righteous has been rescued. So this is their claim. So it is also that during the time of calamity and punishment, Yahweh or Yahshua will rescue also the saints. So this is what they claim. So it is really the right interpretations of the Scripture?

So it is only being noted by all of us that in some point, the righteous will be rescued by Yahweh in some point for some purpose and reason. But of these passages, Yahshua only tells us that when the days of the Son of Man comes, **the people are doing the same things on the days of Noah and on the days of Lot.** So this is not

any ... there is no such relation whatsoever on the claim of the rapture. And then another one is in ... if you continue reading the same chapter in verse 34 ... verse 34:

Luke 17:34-36 *I say to you, In that night two will be on one bed; the one will be taken and the other will be left. Two will be grinding together; one will be taken and the other will be left. Two will be in the field, the one will be taken and the other will be left.*

So this is for my understanding before ... are the closest passages to support the rapture theory. Because one will be taken, that is what they believe and the other left. And that is the actual rapture is happening. That's why you can see in the movies, even the pilot is up and gone from the airplane and there are scales happening there. So that is what they believe. So it's not really what this Bible is all about. If we continue reading on verse 37, we really know and understand what these passages are all about. Now verse 37 says:

Luke 17:37 *And answering, they said to Him, To Where our Master? And He said to them, **Where the carcass is, there the eagles will be gathered together.***

So wondering why these things has been said by Yahshua, the disciple asks Him, "To where Master?" The story about where this has been taken, being brought?" And then Yahshua answered, "Where the carcass is, there the eagles will be gathered together. So as we understand where the carcass is and where the eagles also gathering is on the war. This is during the war.

So if we understand these things and realize these things that those who will be taken will be brought into the place where the carcass is. So meaning **those will be taken, will be destroyed**. So this is the real interpretation of this, but they believe the total opposites. And another one is in 1st Thessalonians chapter 4. 1st Thessalonians chapter 4, beginning verse 13, and says:

1st Thessalonians 4:13-15 *But I want you to know, my brethren, concerning those who sleep, that you should not grieve, as the rest do who have not hope. For if we believe that Yahshua died and rose again, even so Yahshua will also bring with Him all those who have fallen asleep. For we say this to you in the Word of Elohim, that we the living who remain to the coming of our Master will not at all go before those who have fallen asleep.*

1st Thessalonians 4:16-17 *Because the Master Himself shall come down from Heaven with a commanding shout of an archangel's voice, and with the trumpet of YAHWEH. And the dead in Messiah will rise again first. Then we who remain alive will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet with our Master in the air. And so we will always be with our Master.*

So again, this is one of the closest claims of the Scriptures that support their claims, but it is really, during this time rapture is happening, that is what they believe on the last trumpet. Then they will be raptured, and they will be caught up together and taken into heaven. So if we clearly analyze and understand these passages, we can see that the passage talks about the trumpet of Yahweh.

Now where in the book of Revelation chapter 11, it says that the 7th trumpet, and specifically mentioned in **1st Corinthians chapter 15:51 and 52**, the last trumpet. So the last trumpet must be blown out, and then Yahshua comes, and this is about the reservations and not the rapture. So this claim is really far beyond the

truth from the scripture, is because it is a product of the misinterpretation of the Scriptures. This is also the reason why there are a lot of groups of religious people in the world because of this interpretation from the Scripture.

Now for us, these doctrines, or false doctrines of pre-tribulation rapture, actually gives people a false hope, because these doctrines believing that the believers will not necessarily undergo any kind of hardship, persecution or afflictions or tribulations, because they will be raptured. So this is the teaching of a core teachers of supposed teachers of the Scriptures, that they don't want to undergo such kind of hardship in this time, because if this really happening, just think of this. If this happens that the brethren in this end time will be raptured, it is totally unfair with the brethren before, the first disciples, the first apostles, when they became martyred, even killed by those oppressors. And then we, it is ultimately being that we do not undergo these things, it is unfair.

So anybody who will follow Yahshua's footsteps will actually undergo these kinds of trials, and the Bible says, Yahshua says, in **Mark 24:13** that **those who will endure to the end will be saved**. Then what do we, or what those things that we need to endure and to overcome, if we are not there, if we are not undergoing these kinds of prosecutions.

Now the Bible tells us a different thing. In John chapter 16, if you open that, if there is still time left here, in the book of John, in chapter 16, verse 33 that it says:

John 16:33 *I have spoken these things to you that in Me you may have peace. In the world there will be affliction to you, but take courage, I have conquered the world.*

So if we are with Yahshua, as the Bible says, even though this thing is happening, this hardship, persecutions, and anything in this world, we don't need to worry about it, because Yahshua is with us. He will protect us, He will deliver us from, or even if we, if ever, will be brought into authorities, we don't worry what we'll say, what to speak, because Yahweh will put the words in our mouth, that's what the Bible says.

And the most important thing is Yahshua said, **I conquered the world** ... I conquered the world. So there is no need to worry, because Yahshua conquered the world, and if we believe for these words, we also overcome bad things.

If we also read in the book of **Revelation chapter 7**, I will not be going there, Revelation verse 7, and **Revelation 12:14 and 17**, it only says that the anti-messiah, the beast power will make war against the saints, and they overcame them.

Okay, so this is the clear message from the scripture, that we, the followers of Yahshua, will be undergoing these things, no, but not up to the point that we will overcome right here, because there is some kind of ... Yahweh will be providing a safe, a safety, or in a temporary place for His people for safety in this end time. But those who will ... who will undergo these things, the so-called Laodicean people that either resist to believe, nor to become martyred, because they really ... if they want to be saved and to be in the kingdom, they need to, even be willing to lose their life. As Yahshua said, those who will lose their lives, for My sake, they shall have it.

And also Yahshua mentions in the book of **Revelation 2 and 3**, that those overcoming, He says to the seven congregations, those who will be overcoming, will be given, they'll be given a time, or to get the tree of life in the garden, and also ... He also said that those who will overcome will not at all, hurt by the second death, and another one also will be given to eat the hidden manna, and also will be given authority over the nations, and to be clothed with white garments, and to become pillars in the sanctuary of Yahweh. So this is the rewards that will be given for those who overcome.

So overall, if we look at these teachings, so there is nothing true on all of this, because **the truth is we need to overcome**. And then last verse that we've been reading here, allow me to read it with you before I close here in chapter 21 of the book of Revelation, verse 6:

Revelation 21:6-7 And He said to me, It is done! I am the Aleph and the Tav, the Beginning and the Ending. To the one thirsting, I will freely give of the fountain of the Water of Life. The one overcoming will inherit all things, and I will be Elohim to him, and he will be the son to Me.

So it is very clear that all of us, the followers of Yahshua need to overcome everything that comes in our life, and we must make sure that you should overcome this for us to receive all of these rewards that Yahshua promised to His people.
