

Transcript – Elder Beigon Sukkot 2025

Chag Semeach. Thank you. My name is Jackson Beigon. As we are here at the end of the age and the coming of our Master Yahshua Messiah, this is the end time. We ought to know and we are to learn and learn and understand because out there there's so many false prophets. I would like to share with you one scripture before I go to the main message. We want to learn today about our inheritance.

If you go asking to find and want to find about where will we go after this life? What are we after? In all our beliefs accepting Yahshua, what is the purpose? What are we to gain by believing? I did know that the answer - we are going to Heaven. That is the main answer you can get from outside there. But when we go to the Scriptures we find quite opposite.

Let's go 1st John chapter 4 verse 1. First letter of John there is a little message there to learn warning us about the false prophet and what we ought to do. So as not to believe evil spirits and the evil messages that come to us. This book of John, you know this was John who was always with our Master. He was near Him. And He would reveal Him all the secrets. This John was one of the called people. He was the inside disciple, one of the inside disciples of Messiah. And He could tell him many things. And this was the beloved apostle. He appeared many days to John. So we are going to read verse. And we know, we can see what was the real message warning us today of the last days. The book of John, he is warning the beloved there. It says:

1st John 4:1a *Beloved, do not believe every spirit, ...*

Because many spirits come so that they ... why are we not believing this spirit? Because there are very many. And we ought to know and understand right away these spirits. There are very many from the Devil. In that book of John it would read I think to John, that the very message as you're going through this book. That's the one I want to start our main message today about our inheritance. What are we going to inherit?

Well, let us now see and we want to go to the book of Galatians chapter 3 verse ... I may mention the scriptures so you can be quick writing it down. I may not be reading because of time. So I want you to know and because of your ability to write them you may forget. So, this Galatians chapter 3 verse 39, and let us see this Galatians. And don't forget I said what we inherit. I'm going slowly because I see there the translation somewhere so that they can understand. And I go quickly and you may miss many things in the book of Galatians. Galatians chapter 3, we are going to read this one, chapter 3 verse 29. This book it says, it is the end of the Galatians.

Galatians 3:29 *If you are of Messiah, then you are seeds of Abraham, even heirs according to the promise.*

Well, Galatians says, *If we are of Messiah*, it does mean if we have accepted Messiah, we have received, we have been made the covenant by baptism and we have become one of Abraham's seeds. If we want to know what we can inherit, we must first of all know what Abraham was promised. And we go and find out, we want to find out what was promised to Abraham so that was in our inheritance also. Because we have come to believe in Messiah, being immersed in water, having made covenant with Him and we have become heirs to Abraham. We are Abraham's children. We are no longer Gentiles. We are no longer nations, but we are Israelites of Yahweh.

Now, we want to find now what was given to Abraham, what was promised to Abraham by Yahweh. We want to see first, I'm not going to read many scriptures but we want to have some few scriptures so that you can grab them and study, and don't know a lot of scriptures, there's so many, many, many about Abraham.

He was promised, he was told to come out from his father's land and go out and there were so many trials until Yahweh sees that Abraham was the right person to trust. And that is if you trust in Yahweh and do His Commandments and statutes, you will become a friend of Yahweh. And Yahweh will respect you and Yahweh will call a friend. He was a friend of Moses. He used Moshe to bring the children of Israel from captivity from Egypt to the Promised Land. So let us find out what was Abraham given in the book of Genesis. First, let us go quickly in the book of Deuteronomy ... the book of Deuteronomy chapter 34 verse 4.

Deuteronomy 34:4 *And YAHWEH said to him, This is the land which I have sworn to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, saying, I will give it to your seed. I have caused you to see with your eyes, but you shall not cross over there.*

This is Moses being given his instruction. And because he could not cross over to that land, he was given opportunity to see the Land. All because of this Mount Nebo, it is a mountain which he could stand and see everywhere. In verse 1 here, come to verse 1 in this chapter 34, we see the beginning of all this matter:

Deuteronomy 34:1-3 *And Moshe went up from the plains of Moab to Mount Nebo, the top of Pisgah, which is opposite Jericho. And YAHWEH caused him to see all the land; Gilead to Dan; and all Naphtali, and the land of Ephraim, and Manasseh, and all the land of Judah to the sea beyond; and the Negev, and the plain of the valley of Jericho, the city of palm trees, to Zoar.*

Now you see, that was Moses seeing the Land which was promised to Abraham a long time ago. And you can see in the book of **Genesis 17** there are so many promises there. One day he was called to come out and see and he was told face north, face south, east and west, this Land I'll give it to you. And now we are finding what Abraham was promised and that is our promise. He was promised the Land. He was not promised Heaven.

And now as I say that you cannot see any promise to Heaven. And the people now if we go out, we are here and outside there, they'll say "Believe in Jesus and you'll be saved. Repent and be saved so that you can go to Heaven." That is their message which isn't in the Scripture. It is not in the Scriptures.

Now, if we go right now and see what was happening, what does scripture say? What did he have to say about Heaven? Chapter 14 of John ... John chapter 14. I want you to pay particularly to verse 3 but we'll begin with verse 1 in the book of John, the apostle. But really, I want to read in 3 verse 13:

John 3:13a *And no one has gone up into Heaven, except He having come down ... John 3 verse 13.*

John chapter 14, the place He went to prepare, John 14 verse 1:

John 14:1-3 *Do not let your heart be troubled; believe in YAHWEH, and believe in Me. There are many rooms in my Father's house, and if not I would have told you so. For I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I am coming again and will receive you to Myself, that where I am you may be also.*

That means He is to prepare a place for us and He will come after preparing these places. So, what will happen to this person who has to prepare when you come to die? First, we want to pay attention to verse 3 it says, *I will come again and receive you unto Myself.* He never said I will come and take you to Heaven. There is no Heaven mentioned there in the book of John 14.

We will re-visit John. I want you now to move from that book. We'll reading from that book, would have to read a few scriptures from there. Now, He went to prepare a place for us and when we read the book of 1st Thessalonians which says that we would meet Messiah in this book of 1st Thessalonians chapter 4 verse 17:

1st Thessalonians 4:17 *Then we who remain alive will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet with our Master in the air. And so we will always be with our Master.*

When we are resurrected there are two resurrections, first resurrection and second resurrection, and this is the first resurrection when He comes down with a shout, with an amount of the archangels and a trumpet of Yahweh. And it says those who are asleep in Yahshua will be resurrected. And those who are still alive they will be changed. And I think this time you are to be given immortality. Immortality in the body, we can call it a death-proof body. You are given that and this one will enable you to meet Him in the air.

He never says that after meeting there in the air you are being taken to Heaven. No! He never says that. While we there in the air, we can see what will happen. We can console the prophets, what in the book of Torah says. What are the prophets saying about the coming of our Master. We can see in the book of Zechariah chapter 14 verse 4. Let us see the prophet Zechariah.

Zechariah 14:4 *And His feet shall stand in that day on the Mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east; and the Mount of Olives shall divide from its middle, from the east even to the west, a very great valley. And half of the mountain shall move toward the north, and half of it toward the south.*

The feet of our Master who will step on the Mount of Olives. We are seeing that after meeting Him as He was coming down. So we come down together. He is now Yahshua coming the second time. He is coming as the King. He is coming to reign. He is coming to rule.

Some of the people say and we are going there to Heaven, maybe some time seven and a half, seven years, and others have said say one thousand years. But here we'll see His feet is stepping on Mount of Olives. Mount of Olives is in Jerusalem. Some of us have gone there to the Feast there. And while you are up there you can see many things. Down there you can see in the valley and see a lot of graves.

And why those graves are there? Because of the Jews, they understand about their Torah. They know what will happen. So, when they grow old they say *okay*, they come to Jerusalem and if they die here, *bury me near the valley*. Maybe they are thinking that instead the first time you'll be the first person to resurrect. And that was not a bad idea because they were longing and they were waiting and they know He'll come and step on that Mountain.

And we see another prophet. This prophet is the prophet Isaiah, chapter 35 verse 10. There's a piece of scripture here that is good which also it will start another exodus of Israelites coming to Jerusalem. It says:

Isaiah 35:10 *And the ransomed of YAHWEH shall return and enter Zion, with singing and everlasting joy on their head; gladness and joy shall reach them; and sorrow and sighing shall flee.*

This also is written in the book **of Revelation chapter 21 verse 4** and also the book of the same prophet **Isaiah 51 and verse 11**. This is also there, another exodus. I only know that the reign will be here on the earth. And when Yahweh created the first man Adam the aim and the plan of Yahweh was this man to live there and He put him in the Garden of Eden. I think this kingdom was to go to extend to the world out.

The main and the thinking of Yahweh, the mind of Yahweh, was to this Adam, this human being that was made was to live here. This act would be conformed to become a home for the saints. But the evil one came and spoiled everything and the plan was postponed until somebody, a Man, who was called the second Adam, who was the Messiah; being impaled on the tree and then He was resurrected of the dead. And He is now a Savior for mankind.

Now that is where and what we're going to be helped, the act after being cleansed, after Yahshua comes down and reigns for one thousand years. And after one thousand years, He offered His Kingdom to His Father. And then after that there will be no ... we cannot be caught in time or whatever, it will be forever and ever and ever and ever. And we are looking for that.

So now we are going to hear what our Messiah says about Heaven because people want Heaven and later on we want to come and see who's the origin of this Heaven. Let us read John, the Apostle. John chapter 3 verse 13:

John 3:13 *And no one has gone up into Heaven, except He having come down out of Heaven, The Son of Man is He who is in Heaven.*

He denied completely that no one has gone into Heaven. People are saying that Elijah, they are now in Heaven. Others are saying if you die, you are mortal soul and you go to Heaven. Nothing like that. The resurrection has not yet happened. We will resurrect after the sound of the angel, or the sound of the trumpet. We're going to come alive.

So, I have said you can dwell on this, the book of John for some minutes. Let's go now to another book John chapter 7 verse 33.

John 7:33-34 *Then Yahshua said to them, Yet a little while I am with you, and I go to Him who sent Me. You will seek Me, and will not find Me; and where I am, you are not able to come.*

So there's a second scripture Yahshua denying going to Heaven. He never says you will go to Heaven ... completely denying, He says, no! Another scripture in this book of John chapter 8 verse 21:

John 8:21 *Then Yahshua said to them again, I go, and you will seek Me. And you will die in your sin. Where I go, you are not able to come.*

Where He was going no one was able to go. So the promise is not Heaven. Yahshua came from Heaven and He says nobody's there, not Elijah, not Moshe, not anyone. Even David was not there in Heaven. It does say in the book of **Acts chapter 2 verse 34** his grave is with us today. He never ascended to Heaven ... David.

So, let's go to another scripture. John chapter 13 verse 33. Some people read this scripture from John and they say, "No Yahshua was telling the Jews. But we who have accepted Yahshua we will go to Heaven!" So let's us read this book of John 13, who was He telling?

John 13:33 *My Sons, yet a little while I am with you. You will seek Me; and, as I said to the Jews, Where I go, you are not able to come; I also say to you now.*

So, Jews plus apostles, because He said My Sons. So, we're all human, nobody could ascend to Heaven and go there. We are going now ... who's visiting the mansion He went to prepare ... because they will arise in the resurrection. What about the mansion He was going to prepare? Can we not go there in Heaven or live there? What will happen? He was preparing for what? Let us go to the book of Revelation chapter 21 verse 2, we will see two scriptures there for confirmation. We will read verse 2 and verse 10.

Revelation 21:2 *And I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of Heaven from YAHWEH, having been prepared as a bride, having been adorned for her Husband.*

This is what He was going to prepare, those are the mansions He went to prepare. They were adorned and these mansions are coming down. John was showing what will happen, these mansions to come down. Verse 10:

Revelation 21:10 *And he carried me in spirit onto a great and high mountain, and showed me the great city, holy Jerusalem, coming down out of Heaven from YAHWEH,*

You see he repeated it twice. Two witnesses can establish the truth. And we have found now what He went to prepare is coming down. So we cannot say we are going to inherit, that's a very wrong scripture notion or thing. And who was the invention of this origin or this Heaven, going to Heaven? Who told the people that we go to Heaven? This is none other than the Devil.

Let us go to the book of Isaiah, we'll see in the Tanach. We'll read in the book of Isaiah, the prophet Isaiah, chapter 14 verse 12. We are now going to find the invention, or the beginning, who created all these things. And I want you to pay special attention to what happened. Let's begin with verse 12:

Isaiah 14:12 *Oh Lucifer, son of the morning, how you have fallen from the heavens! You weakening the nations, you are cut down to the ground.*

Comment: Verse 13, I want you now to pay attention and try to count something here. I want you to count something here. You count now five things. And the words *I will*. He said it five times.

Isaiah 14:13-14 *For you have said In your heart, I will ... that's one ... I will go up to the heavens; I will raise my throne above the stars of El, and I will ... another I will ... sit in the mountain of appointment, in the sides of the north ... Are you counting? We are in the 3 I will's. Another one, verse 14 ... I will rise over the heights of the clouds; I will be compared to Elyone.*

You see, five I will's. He wanted what here? So this is the invention. This is the **originator** for going to Heaven. And this alone that this "I will" to the preachers. Where he wanted to go he was thrown out. He was thrown after a very great fight ensued in Heaven, the angels of Yah and fought against the angels of the Devil and the Devil and he was thrown. He was no longer. He could not have access going there in Heaven.

And went again, he entered and met some other people again. If we go back to read the book of Genesis chapter 11 verse 1. What made these people to build a long tower headed to Heaven? What made them?

Genesis 11:1-4 *And the whole earth was of one lip and of one speech. And it happened, as they traveled from the east, they found a level valley in the land of Shinar. And they lived there ... verse 3 ... And each one said to his neighbor, Come, let us make brick, and burn them thoroughly. And they had brick for stone, and they had asphalt for mortar. And they said, Come, let us build a city and a tower with its top the heavens, and make a name for ourselves, that we not be scattered on the face of all the earth.*

Who made them to do that? If we continue reading, we see that Yahweh said, Let us go and see what children of men are doing. Since they are made to stop. It was stopped because they could have understood and be able to speak some other languages and they left the building, just as everybody left that one. And I think this was the children of Israel, or the Hebrews were not there. They were not part of the project.

If we read in the book chapter 10 here, the children of Abraham were living in the land. Let us see verse 30 so as for us to understand. Just go in one quickly ...

Genesis 10:24 *And Arpachshad fathered Cainan and Cainan fathered Salah; and Salah fathered Eber.*

This is the name "Hebrew" came from. And we jump to verse 30:

Genesis 10:30 *And their dwelling was from Mesha, as you go to Sephar, an eastern mountain.*

So this was the place where the Hebrew were living in the hills, the valleys where this project was going on. And there were other people. They were confused because their language never changed. It went on like that because they wanted to see a language from Heaven. And even they are talking to Paul they heard a voice from Heaven talking with him in Hebrew language. He sent an angel in **Luke 1 verse 31**. He sent an angel and he told Mary you will bear a Son and He will be King. The language, the communication of that language was Hebrew.

So, now as I'm coming to an end, we have learned that. We see the book of Ephesians now because this will be the last book I am reading. Because there are so many scriptures we can find about where we will be going. We were Gentiles. We were not Israelite. We were Gentiles and Israelites are different ... Gentiles or nations. Let us read in this book. The last book I'm going to read this lesson today. We see in the book of Ephesians chapter 2 starting verse 11 and 12:

Ephesians 2:11-12 *Because of this, remember that you, the nations, were then in the flesh from the beginning and you were called Uncircumcision, differing from those called Circumcision, which is the work of the hands in the flesh; that at that time you were without Messiah, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers of the covenants of promise, having no hope and without Elohim in the world.*

So I say that we, those who have accepted Yahshua Messiah, we are no longer the nations. We are different people. We are Israelites. So you cannot call yourselves again that you are a Gentile. No, you've made a covenant with Yahweh. You have been immersed in water and you have become a new creature, an Israelite believing what Israelites were believing. In this Bible are Israelites. They are the ones who wrote the Scriptures according to Paul when he was saying.
