Transcript - How to Get to the Other Side

Alrighty, Shabbat Shalom and Shabbat Shalom to all that are with us today. Glad to have you. A couple months back I did a message called, *The Other Side* and I got a *tremendous* amount of positive feedback on that; more than almost any message I think I've ever given—or at least close. So with some of the questions that came up I thought I would do a part two on that message called, *How* to *Get* to the *Other Side*. Or let's say, a little more in depth on how to get to the other side.

So, you repent of sin but you don't repent of doubt and pain and fear. And let me just say before I start, for those that may have not heard part one. You could listen to part two and it's not really a continuation, but I think if you haven't heard the first part you'll get much more out of *this* if you listen to the first part first—getting into what the whole meaning is on getting to the other side and the difference of light and darkness. And like I always say, there's no such thing as darkness. There's only the absence of light. So if you haven't, you could. But if not, then that's fine. Maybe afterward you could listen to it and see.

But again, you repent from sin but you **don't** repent from doubt and pain and fear. But you go **through them** to get to the other side. And where the problem comes in though, **the problem comes in is that doubt and pain and fear become normal.** That people stay in them—the normalcy bias—that they're so used to living in this that they just think that the doubt and the fear and the pain is the normal part, and they never get to the other side. And they **start to expect them as a way of life.**

And I say this with pre-suppositions sometimes that maybe there's somebody in the Congregation or somebody you meet ... it doesn't have to be in the Congregation—at work, whatever ... and you're talking to them and they cough [coughing]. And you're like, "Oh yeah, now I'm going to get sick!" And you literally then, you have set your destiny. You said, "Now I will get sick." Right? So our words really do mean a lot, and our words can make our destiny.

So when people live so long *in* doubt, *in* pain, and in fear, they start to expect it. And there's something called self-sabotage, that people actually ... even when things are going good ... they will sabotage the situation because in their nervous system and in their mind, they're thinking, "This can't continue this way." They're so un-used to having it go in the right way, that they sabotage it because their nervous system and their memory in their mind is just used to having it go in a bad way. So they expect it as a way of life, never realizing that doubt, pain and fear are only there to *teach* us how to get to the other side of them, as we'll see today.

So let's take them one by one and let's see how to go from doubt to faith; and how to go from pain to strength; and how to go from fear to love. Let's start in Matthew 28:16 and 17, right? We'll start with *doubt*. And it says:

Matthew 28:16-17 But the eleven disciples went into Galilee, to the mount where Yahshua appointed them. And seeing Him, they worshiped Him. But **some doubted**.

Okay, so they weren't doubting that He's there. They're doubting why isn't the Kingdom here? If Yahshua's here and He's resurrected, then where is the Kingdom? And this is the problem sometimes, why we doubt, because we have all these preconceived ideas, right? How things should be. And many times your preconceived ideas are not based reality. So the doubt is coming simply because you're not ... maybe it's your pride, or maybe it's just like I said, it's instilled in your nervous system. But you're not allowing that preconceived wrong idea to go out the window.

And it happens with a lot of things. It happens with doctrine. I've noticed people that get into some of these things like rotating Sabbath, or whatever, that they get **so sold** into a wrong doctrine that no matter what you tell they're not going to change. No matter what proof you show them. They're not even listening because it's become such a false reality to them that they don't want to get to the other side.

So like I say, people have doubt because they focus on what they can see in Satan's society and not what is the reality of the Kingdom of Yahweh. So every day you open up your door and you leave your house you got to realize you're going in an alternative universe. You've entered the twilight zone. You're literally going into, and you're eyes are seeing, something that isn't real. Everything in Satan's society is fake. Everything is Satan's society is going to cease to exist very soon. So you have to make sure ... and this is the hard part ... that you have to train your mind to be living in the mentality of the Kingdom of Yahweh. You have to eat, sleep and breathe the Kingdom of Yahweh. And even though you can't see the Kingdom of Yahweh in Satan's society, you have to visually see it in your mind. And it's just what we have to do.

1st Corinthians 7 in verse 29 says:

1st Corinthians 7:29-30 But I say this, brethren, that the time has been cut short. Let the ones who have wives be as though they have none; and those weeping as not weeping, and those rejoicing as not rejoicing, and those buying as if they did not possess anything.

Comment: Right? So in Satan's world you have to live the *opposite* what everything seems because that's what's happening. It's just like the fake news out there. You know how you can get the truth? Whatever you hear in the news, believe the opposite! It used to be about fifty percent, whatever you hear fifty percent is not true; or fifty percent is slanted. But now it's a hundred percent just about; ninety to a hundred percent. So basically everything you're seeing you have to understand mentally that it's not there.

1st Corinthians 7:31 and those who make use of this world as not abusing it; for the mode of this world is passing away.

Right? So you have to live in this mentality. You have to live in the mentality, the Kingdom of Yahweh, and understand that everything in Satan's society is twisted and it's tainted. You have to change your focus to realize that what you're seeing in society is *false*, it's *manipulated* and it's *temporary*—and it will not be there when the Kingdom comes. So you have to change your perspective. If you don't change your perspective, you're never going to get to the other side because it's a spiritual battle, but it's also a physical battle.

And the Bible says the physical comes before the spiritual, right, when we're talking about the first Adam and the second Adam, that's what Scripture says. So we have to understand it's everything in life. That if you don't get past the physical, you'll never get into the spiritual. And Satan knows this. And that's why ... does he try to harm us in the spiritual? Well, he can't. There's nothing he could do in the spiritual once you get to the other side. He's done because he can't come to the other side. He has to stay on his side. Like we went over the last time, Lazarus and the Rich Man, right? There's a gulf there. So Satan, as long as you get to that other side and stay there, there's nothing Satan can do. But until you get there, he's going to try everything in his power to keep you there. And even when you get in that boat and you're going, he's going to try to sink that boat. He's going to try to put holes in that boat. He's going to try to stop you any way he can from getting to the other side. So you have to change your perspective.

You can't have your reality in the doubt and uncertainty of Satan's world; working in the world, educating yourself in the world; have all the false realities of Facebook and internet and social media, and all these fake websites ... that unfortunately even some brethren go to sometime ... and then your reality will be in the façade of Satan's world. It's just sad to see sometimes people that are really, really smart and zealous and have a good heart, and they get caught up with some of these things like QAnon—the most *fake* conspiracy theories that you can ever imagine. And instead of having their reality on the Kingdom of Yahweh, their reality is on all this fake stuff out there. And that's just as bad as being part of the global government because **anything that's not of the truth is not of Yahweh**.

So we want to make sure that our reality is in the Kingdom of Yahweh. There is no doubt in the Kingdom, only faith. So whenever there's a doubt, the doubt is only coming because you're not living in a Kingdom mentality. If you will get to

the other side, you'll live in a Kingdom mindset and the doubt will go. There just simply is no doubt when you get to the other side. Matthew 21 in verse 21 ... now we'll see exactly how we can do that.

Matthew 21:21-22 And answering, Yahshua said to them, Truly I say to you, **If you have faith and do not doubt**, not only will you do the miracle of the fig tree, but even if you should say to this mountain, Be taken up and thrown into the sea, it will be so. And **all things**, whatever you may ask in prayer, **believing**, **you shall receive**.

Right? **All things**, whatever you ask in prayer, *believing*, you will receive. So the way to get through doubt is **by belief**, right? Because *doubt* is **not real**. In the Kingdom there's no such thing as doubt. Like I say, in Hebrew there's the color black and there's the color white. There is no color grey. It's not there in Hebrew. In ancient Hebrew there is no color grey because everything with Yahweh is black and white. Everything with Yahweh is good or evil. Everything with Yahweh is bad or good.

So there *is* **no doubt in the Kingdom of Yahweh**, there's only belief. So the way to get through doubt is *by belief*, like He says if you *simply believe*—and that's all faith is. You don't have to be a rocket scientist. You don't have to have four degrees. **All you simply have to do** is *believe* **Yahweh**. And that's why He says, unless you enter the Kingdom as a child, you won't enter. Why? Because children will believe, right? And you see that eight year child there, "My Daddy said that he could turn that box into a car, then he can do it!" People ... they believe. Children have that **faith-like attitude**. And that's why Yahshua said unless you enter as a child, you will not enter at all.

So the way to do this is by **proving what is true and what is false**. And that's why, like I said, in the first part I said, there's nothing wrong with having doubts when you first become a believer. You should have doubts because *everything you believed in before* ... I've said many times, I have it in my books I grew up as a Catholic. And I thought for sure Catholicism was the only true religion. So as I started reading my Bible when I was fifteen, sixteen years old, and I started to see, "Whoa, wait a second. There's nothing I read in the Bible that is the same as what I'm being taught in Catholicism." So I had doubts, and that's a **good thing**, or I'd still be a Catholic.

So you have to have doubts when you're coming to faith. But *every single doubt is removed through faith*. Every single doubt is removed through *truth*. And then, once you get to the other side, you can't go back. You can't be going to these false websites. You can't be listening to QAnon. You can't be going and looking at things of the earth is flat. These are things that will *destroy* your faith because they're all fake! And we're still human beings. So we have to make sure that we *guard* our faith. It's not just a matter of *getting* to the other side. You have to guard it. You have to guard your faith. John 8 in 31 and 32 ... John chapter 8 in 31, it says;

John 8:31-32 Then Yahshua said to the Jews who had believed in Him, If you continue in **My Word**, you are truly My disciples. And you will know the truth, and **the truth will set you free**.

It's the Word of Yahweh that sets you free, not these conspiracy websites out there. It's the Word of Yahweh. But the problem is: that there's people out there that the Word of Yahweh isn't good enough for them. And I remember years ago meeting people and when you talk about them, about the Bible, and they're like, "Oh yeah, yeah. I read that before." And it's like, "What do you mean you read it before?" Every time you read the Bible it's new! Every time you read the Bible it comes alive. Every time you read the Bible, because you're growing in the Holy Spirit, you're understanding in a way you never did before! So yeah, I'm reading the Bible for forty-two years, forty-three years and still every morning I wake up and I read the Bible, something new comes. How do I get a new sermon all the time? That's by the Holy Spirit teaching me something new and something different that I didn't understand before—or in a deeper way that I didn't understand before of Yahweh's truth. But the truth never changes. So the truth is the thing that will set you free. But you have to guard it. You have to hold onto to it.

So you have to ask yourself, **you have to prove, what is true and what is false**. So can you prove a hundred percent that Yahweh exists? And that's a pretty easy one. I did a series a couple years ago on the Bible. I think it was called, *The Word*

of Yahweh, or something like that. It's like a four part series. Listen to it if you haven't because I go into biblical proof, historical proof, scientific proof that the Bible is true. And with Yahweh, it's clearly very easy when you look. If there's a creation, like it talks about in **Romans 1**, then there has to be a Creator; or how did all this come here? It didn't come from nothing. And mankind, who's so smart that he can make all of things great inventions in the time we're living in and he can make rockets that can go up to Mars, but he can't even create a blade of grass. So mankind *cannot* create life. Yahweh did not give him the ability to do that.

And that's why, what is Satan doing? He's try to counterfeit through cloning, through artificial intelligence to make a robot look as alive as possible. But the problem is he can't. See, we're the real thing. You don't need artificial intelligence. We really are a new creation! We really are the Spirit of Yahweh that's creating in us. And there's something there that isn't in other human beings. So we're more powerful than any kind of AI robot or whatever. Maybe not in physical knowledge, but it's not physical knowledge that gets you to the Kingdom of Yahweh. So this is why you can prove Yahweh exists because only Yahweh can beget life. And life begets life, right? That's why abortion is so evil because it's a life at conception. It is a life. And human is making it legal to kill life, right?

So you can prove that Yahweh exists by the very creation that He made. Our bodies, right? Our bodies, you have billions of cells. And every single ... billion, that's a number you can't even put your mind around, right? Billions! Not thousands, not even millions but billions ... and every single cell has like a hundred thousand configurations in that cell. So think about that. And if every single one was not perfect, every configuration ... this is where your DNA comes from ... then your body wouldn't work. So you can't have evolution. You can't have a body evolve. You can't have a kidney evolve. You can't have a heart evolve. Either it's all working or it's not working. And Yahweh created it that way. And Yahweh said, "Let there be life." And there was life because He put the life—the breath of life—into human beings.

So **once you prove that He exists, that's all faith is**. It's **just believing** like it says in **Hebrews 11,** that Yahweh is and He's a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him. Because that's what His Word says. And as long as you really believe it ... so this is the problem, you say you believe it and then you walk out there in the twilight zone, out your door every morning, and you're mind is concepting Satan's world. And that's where doubts are coming in because you're saying, "Well, my Bible says this, but in the world it says this." It's like if Covid didn't prove that. You're seeing, wow, look at all these people dying.

Like one guy was talking to somebody who he was believing in the vaccine at first, and he's talking to this lady who had four family members die. And he'd say, "But something must be wrong. There must have been something this. You know you can't ..." And she's like, "But they're dead. They're dead. They took the vaccine and they're dead." And it hit the guy. He's like, "Wow, I must have had this wrong. Yeah, they're dead! And all these other people are dead!" So whatever I'm looking at in the twilight zone must not be right. There's got to be something wrong there, not in the Kingdom of Yahweh. And that's why you have to live in that mentality. Because the kingdom of Satan, when you're out there, if your mind is concepting that that's true ... and you know why? If you really believe it wasn't true, then what are you doing in there? What are you working in society for? What are you educating your kids in society for? What are you shopping in society for? And what are you have all the different things, all the Facebook and social media, and all the things of society? Why are you using smart phones and all these other things? So you're trying to live in a Kingdom mentality and yet, you're going out and every day ninety percent of your life is Satan's false reality.

So if you really want to get to the other side, you got to make decisions in your life. And you got to come out of it. You have to leave those things behind. And you have to not only live mentally in a Kingdom reality, but you have to have what's around you from a Kingdom reality. You can't have your life living on white sugar and think you're living in a Kingdom mentality. You can't be taking all kinds of medical pharmaceuticals that are going to kill you and think you're living in a Kingdom mentality. You can't be educating your children in Satan's society out there and think you're living in a

Kingdom mentality. So this is where if you really want to get to the other side, it's really *not that hard*. But there does have to be some serious changes that come in your life.

Can you prove that Yahweh's Word is a hundred percent accurate? Of course. Proof of the Bible, fulfilled prophecy—like the prophecy about Cyrus. Hundreds of years before this king is born, Yahweh not names what he's going to do, that he's going to go and take over Babylon and he's going to ... even the way, the way he'll do it—open the levee doors. But He actually names him. He *names* him by name hundreds of year before what he did.

So the Bible is a hundred percent accurate. The texts are accurate. You have about forty authors writing the Bible over *fifteen hundred years*, and yet, there's not any one open contradiction. So like I said if the Red Sea really parted and the chariot wheels are still there to prove it in Mount Sinai then you got nothing to worry about. Because **if Yahweh parted** the Red Sea, if He could literally take a nine hundred foot ocean and open it up where the people could walk through, then He could do anything in your life. You just have to believe it. You have to believe it.

If Yahshua was really resurrected, then there's no reason to doubt because you know what that means? If He was resurrected as a physical human being, you'll be resurrected! This is what you have to concept. Not concept things in your life that you may die, but concept if you won't be resurrected. Death isn't the worst thing in the world, because in your next waking moment, you're resurrected into eternal life. The worst thing in the world is if you're not resurrected; or if you're resurrected to death. So if Yahshua was really resurrected then there's no reason to doubt.

Can you prove Yahshua is the Son of Yahweh and the promised Messiah? There's three hundred prophecies in Scripture. We just said you could clearly prove Scripture is true. And just by the prophecies that He fulfilled, right? So He'll be born in Bethlehem. He's a babe. He can't force that, right? And all the other scriptures that talk about what He's going to do—uphold the Torah. But then as He's dying, the Scriptures say that they'll give lots for His clothing as He's dying. How could He force that? That there'll be robbers, thieves, that are crucified with Him; that He'll be buried in a rich man's tomb—all these things that He had no control over because He was either being crucified or dead. And yet, there's three hundred prophecies like that. Not one or two, but three hundred that He fulfilled. Even healing lepers and blind and crippled.

So without a shadow of a doubt, you can prove it. You can prove that Yahshua died, was buried three days and three nights and rose from the dead. We have **four**, not ... the Bible says, *in the mouth of two or three witnesses*, *let everything be confirmed* ... we have **four eye witnesses** to this. Four eye witnesses that didn't corroborate with each other. They didn't have a meeting and get together and say, "Hey should we put this down? Should we put that down?" They lived in different parts of the world. They were out there preaching the good news. And each one wrote their good news message independently without contradiction. Some may have put another part of the story that's not in another. That's okay. If some is focusing on this and some is putting more detail to it, but no contradiction to it.

And the other thing that I look at is, the good news messages **clearly show** that before Yahshua died, before the Holy Spirit came to these people, they were pretty worldly—the twelve apostles, right? They were fighting over each other—who's the best, who's the greatest, who's not. They were scared to death when Yahshua was taken and crucified. They were hiding in the upper room. They were afraid of the authorities. So if that's the case, if they had this fear and they were afraid, how would that go to ... if Yahshua really wasn't resurrected ... how on earth would that go into this faith that they're **willing to give their life for?** Not just a few days after the resurrection, *but for the rest of their life*. For *thirty* years, sometimes in John's case, up to *sixty* years later that **he's still living for this and** *dying* **for this**; and dedicating a hundred percent of his life for this. How could they do that if they knew it wasn't true? So right there, **proves** without a shadow of a doubt, the resurrection was true.

And again, there's nothing that disproves it. A matter of fact, Yahshua's own *enemies*, His Jewish brothers and sisters that didn't believe in Him, when you look in the Talmud and the Mishna, they confirm that He did those miracles. They even confirm He was resurrected. They say it was by magic. But it doesn't matter how they said it happened, they *say it happened*.

So once you can prove this, you made it to the other side. Because where's the doubt then? If Yahweh is real and His Word is real, and Yahshua was really here, and He lived a perfect life and suffered and died and was three days and three nights in a tomb and was resurrected, what on earth is left to doubt?

However, this is where the problem comes, Satan, the adversary—the enemy, doesn't want you to embrace this. Because once you embrace that, you're done! Once you embrace that, you're finished. You're on the other side. There's no way he can get to you when you're embracing what I just went over.

So he puts unsubstantiated doubts into your mind. So people say they believe but then these doubt come, "But what about the end?" I mean face it, they've been saying since the first century they thought the end was in their time. The Apostle Paul, the Apostle Peter were saying they thought it, it wasn't. We're two thousand years later. There's been leaders today saying we're in the end time. I'm saying we're in the end time! But what would happen if fifty years goes by and we're still here. Is it going to bring doubt? No! What it would bring is that we just didn't understand about the end time. But it has nothing to do with the Word of Yahweh. The Word of Yahweh is true. The Word of Yahweh is forever.

So what Satan will do is, he will use ... he will put unsubstantiated doubts in the mind of people about things like, when will the end come? And everything else ... if the earth is flat, the rotating ... all these false things, trying to just get people to have *any* doubt. He doesn't care what your doubt is. Like I say, with the Ten Commandments, He doesn't care if you keep nine Commandments perfectly, as long as you're consistently breaking one because that will take you out of the Kingdom. You break one, you break them all. And it's the same way here with doubt—he doesn't care less *what the doubt is* as long as you consistently have a doubt, he's happy because that is the opposite of faith. Then your faith is done. So, and so on and so on and so on.

And where Yahweh gives clear answers in this life, Satan only gives questions. So you know when I first became an elder twenty-seven, twenty-eight years ago, I used to have this fear that, "Whoa what if somebody has a question I can't answer." And I can tell you twenty-eight years later ... of course, I mean I can have a *physical* question on knowledge that I can't answer, I'm talking about a biblical question though ... I've never, ever had one biblical question I couldn't answer. Not *me*, it's the Holy Spirit. And there's times where someone was asking a question that I actually thought of for like fifteen years. And I'm like, "Wow, I wonder what the answer to this is." And do you know when that person asked the question, the Holy Spirit gave me the answer *at that time*.

So all we have to do is believe. And that's what Scripture says, right? **Don't worry about what you'll say when you're going to be before kings and princes, because the Holy Spirit will give you in that moment what you need**. And He does. I could say it first-hand. I've been before kings and rulers. I've been more than twenty times in the Knesset in Israel. I've been to the beast power in the United Nations in New York City. And I've always had an answer **from the Holy Spirit**, not from myself. And that's why **you have to wait, you have to think,** and let the Holy Spirit put those answers into your mind.

So Yahweh gives answers to questions, Satan only gives doubts. And that's what happens. People that have these doubts, they'll never get an answer because Satan doesn't have answers. He only has doubt. The key to live by faith is to focus on what you know, not on what you don't know. So you know what? I don't understand everything in this universe. I don't understand how a rocket can do this or something else. There's a lot of things I don't understand, but it doesn't make a difference, I'm not going to focus on that. I focus on what I do know. Yahweh exists, His Word is one hundred percent true, Yahshua fulfilled all those three hundred prophecies. He is the promised Messiah. He died for my sins. He was in the tomb three days and three nights. He was resurrected and He's sitting at the right hand of the Father. That's all I need to know. That's the thing that I need to know. If the answer to those questions above ... like I said, Is Yahweh real? Is the Bible real? Did Yahshua do this? Are the answers yes? Then nothing else matters. You are a baptized, believing child of Yahweh that will rule with Yahshua and His Kingdom forever.

What else do I need to know? What more physical knowledge do I need? None! I don't need more physical knowledge. But that's what Satan's world goes for. They're always looking for the new sliced bread. They're always looking for thirty-four ways that water in the Scripture ... they always want these little tidbits. That to be honest, they may be good knowledge to have sometimes of some of these things, but that's not what's going to give you salvation. That's not going to save you. Faith in Yahweh, faith in Yahshua is what's going to save you. That's it. So you have to understand this. You have to be content with what you have because we have what one in five million people have! We already have salvation within us. And that's the key to get rid of doubt. The key to get rid of doubt is focus on what you know, not on what you don't know.

Number two, *pain*. Second one is pain. 1st Peter 4 verse 12 through 19:

1st Peter 4:12-14 Beloved, do not be astonished at the fiery trial happening among you for your testing, as if a surprise were occurring to you; but rejoice, that you participate in the sufferings of the Messiah, so you may rejoice and exult at the revelation of His glory ... So pain is a good thing—pain is allowing you to participate in Yahshua's sufferings ... If you are reviled in the name of Messiah, you're blessed ... so look at it as a blessing when you're going through the baptism of fire ... "The glorious Spirit of Elohim rests upon you." ... Wow!

1st Peter 4:15-17 Do not let any suffer as a murderer, or a thief, or an evildoer ... that's not a good thing ... or as a meddler in the affairs of others. But if one suffers as a Christiana ... as a believer ... do not let him be ashamed, but glorify Elohim in this respect. Because the time has come that judgment must begin with the house of YAHWEH ... that's the time we're living in; we're living in the time of the baptism of fire ... and if it first begins with us, what will be the end of the ones disobeying the good news of Elohim?

1st Peter 4:18-19 And "if the righteous is scarcely saved, where will the wicked and sinner appear?" ... So we don't have to worry about that because **we're not on that side**. We're on the other side. We're on the side of the righteous, the obedient ... Wherefore, let them who suffer according to the will of YAHWEH, commit their souls to Him in well doing, as a faithful Creator.

And here comes faith again. When you're going through that trial, it's not that easy ... when you're going through that. But that's what you have to believe, that's what you have to be convicted of. You have to be convicted that pain is for our benefit. You could never get to strength if you don't go through pain.

So the problem though ... and here's the problem with this one ... the problem is that people get so used to the pain—sometimes they've been living in that pain their whole life—the pain becomes their reality and they accept it and live in a victim mentality. And this is where it is again, like our words, they accept being a victim. And they almost sometimes create their own victimhood. Because even when thing isn't pain, they make it pain. They want make everything pain because that's the mentality they're living in. And they never work on overcoming and getting to the other side. So they stay in that victimhood mentality and that mentality of pain, and it only brings more pain. But they never leave it because it's all they know. The normalcy bias, once again. Revelation 21 in verse 7 says:

Revelation 21:7 The one overcoming will inherit all things, and I will be Elohim to him, and he will be the son to Me.

The one **overcoming all things** ... so this where we have to be overcomers. We have to make sure that we are being overcomers in this world. So let me give you a couple of examples how to do this. How do you go from pain to strength? How do we get our mind, our mentality out of that victimhood mentality, out of the victimhood of pain and into the mentality of strength?

Let's say somebody grew up with an abusive father and they were beaten. And they just had a real, real abuse in their life. Sometimes maybe it was even physical abuse, whatever. So you can grow up in this mentality of victimhood and your whole life, everything that happens from that point, you could blame somebody else. You could blame your father, and

"It was his fault. You didn't go through ... I was beaten when I was younger. I was sexually molested." Whatever it is and you could live in that forever. But you know what? You'll never get to the other side. You'll stay in that victimhood and then you relive it. You relive it over and over again your whole life. So it's like you're giving power over to the evil when you live in victimhood.

So how do you get to the other side? How do you overcome that? **By not being the same way.** That's the way—the greatest way—you could *repay* somebody that treated you evil is not being the same way ... not being the same way again.

So the answer is: you use the example to become a *great* parent. You're never going to be that way to *your* children. You're going to understand how to empower your children from your experience and make sure this will never happen. And then you're actually helping the next generation. You're breaking a generational curse that'll be there and you've gotten to the other side.

You have to change the meaning. You have to change the meaning from pain to strength. So you have to change the meaning of the experience. So before the meaning of that experience to you was just pain. "Oh, what I went through. You don't understand. I was beaten. I got scars. Look at these marks." You have to change the meaning. You have to change the meaning that, "No, no, no since I went through this ... because if you didn't you couldn't understand it ... I will never let this happen again. I'm going to help other people." Maybe you go to places and you speak about helping other children, or other people that were in that situation.

It's like Alcohol Anonymous, right? The greatest thing these people do once they get through the program and they're not addicted to alcohol anymore, is go out and help other people! Help other people that were addicted before. And you have the buddy system, right? And then the person who was an alcoholic and they're having trouble, they have someone they can call. And it's like, "Ah, I'm having a tough time." And it's like, "Okay, I'm coming there right now! You're not going to be able to do this."

So this is what we do. You have to do that. You have to change the *meaning* of it to one from pain, to one of strength. You can't live as a victim. If you live in the victim, you're never going to get to the other side. And like I said, **Satan only has doubts, he doesn't have answers.** So if you live in a victim, you're living in *his mentality.* You're living right where he wants you to be. And you're only going to be more *miserable*. But **you can't get** *comfortable* being miserable. You have to get *uncomfortable* being miserable to make sure it never happens again.

I'll give you another example: you befriend people in the past, you're a friendly person, you befriend people in the past and they lie to you. You lent them money, they never pay you back. And they hurt you, right? So sometimes people will sit there and say, "I'm never going to do it again. I'm never going to be a friend to anybody. I'm never going to lend money to anybody. I'm never going to help anybody." You know what? You know who you're hurting the most? Yourself! Because when you give, it's given back to you ten-fold or a hundred-fold. So not only are you hurting the people you're not giving to, you're hurting yourself more because you're going to get a hundred-fold for it. And that's exactly where Satan wants you.

So how do you overcome it? You change the meaning to it. You have to change the meaning to it. The past does not equal the future. You have to believe that. The past does not equal the future. So you can't say ... because people have hurt me. I've been hurt a lot. I've helped people that have stabbed me in the back, but I'm not going to say, "Oh, I'll never help anybody again." Because you know what? I'm going to hurt those people that really need help and I'm hurting myself. Not only am I hurting myself by keeping blessings from me, I'm going to be living in a mentality of that—a mentality of suspicion and false accusations. And I don't want to live in that mentality because it's the opposite of the Kingdom of Yahweh.

So you have to change the meaning. The past does not equal the future. So just because something happened yesterday, doesn't mean it's going to happen tomorrow, right? You have to change. The past doesn't equal the future. If you use the false concept that all people are liars and can't be trusted ... well, you're a person. You're not an alien. So that means you too! And people have said that to me, "Oh, well, all people, all people are liars, every man." And it's like, well, aren't you a human? That means you too. So you can't say that. Not all people are. Yeah, in the world we're living in a lot of them are ... a lot of people are. And I'll read it in a little bit here. But not everybody is that way. There may be a lot of people that are liars and bad and whatever, but not everybody is that way. So change the meaning of the experience, right?

How do you change the meaning of the experience? Instead of saying, "I'm not going to trust anybody." you say, "I will make people earn my trust." I will make people earn my trust. And now those whom you trust will be assets, not liability. That's the rule I live by. Even though I know in this world ... who knows, seventy, eighty percent of the people out there are bad and can't be trusted. I know there's twenty percent that can be. So you know what I'm going to do. I'm going to limit my relationships and try to get that twenty percent. I'm going to limit my ... I'm going to give everyone a chance, and the ones who are faithful, and the ones who are good people, those are the ones that I'm going to embrace.

And you know how to do it? Because you attract of what you are. So if you're that way and you're outgoing and you're giving and you're helpful, that's what you're going to attract. You attract what you give. So by doing that, you're going to have people come into your life that are going to be good. And now, those whom you trust become assets, not liabilities. So this is the way to go from pain to strength, right? You have to change the meaning, to be best friends to others. You attract what you give. And you made it to the other side.

You had to go through the *pain* though of being hurt, but now you have great relationships as assets, maturing through the pain to get to the other side. It's just a matter of analyzing it and doing these things and living in the Kingdom mentality. And the Bible says *Bad communications ruin good habits*. So it there are people that are untrustworthy and there are people that don't keep their word, and there are people that are going to always lie to you, then those are people you got to put out of your life. So you have to make those choices. But it's pain because by giving someone the chance to hurt you, some *will* hurt you. But **if you're not hurt by those** *few***, you'll never have the embracement of the many.** You'll never have true friends because **you have to go through the pain of the few, to get to the good friendships of the many.** So once you go through the pain of being hurt now you have the great relationships as assets maturing through it. So it's just a matter of, like I said, not living in a victim mentality and going out and being the best friend. And that's the way you change it.

Philippians 3:12-14 says:

Philippians 3:12-14 Not that I already received or already have been perfected, but I press on, if I also may lay hold, inasmuch as I also was laid hold of by Messiah Yahshua. Brothers, I do not count myself to have reached the goal, but one thing I do, **forgetting the things behind,** and stretching forward to those things before, I press toward the goal to receive the prize of victory of the highest calling of YAHWEH in Yahshua Messiah.

We have to do this. We have to be **forgetting the things behind and stretching forward to those things before.** So yeah, you can live in that victim mentality that Satan wants you to and just be mulling it over for years and years and decades of how bad it was. Like I said, it could be a parent, a teacher, whatever ... whatever happened to you in the past, but then you'll never get to the other side. **You have to forget it. You have to look forward** ... you have to look forward. And like I said, the past doesn't equal the future. These are rules you have to live by. That's should be a core value of yours that the past doesn't equal the future.

Remember though, you still live in Satan's world. So at times, pain is going to come. It's part of life because like I said, if eighty percent of the people out there are not good people, then you're going to hit some of them. But what you have to do is you have to thankful for all the good ones that you do have. But you mature to learn how to handle it and learn

the lessons and move on. You will be stronger for this as the pain you once had is now a strength. So you're not living in that pain anymore. And once you get to the other side, it can never affect you the same way. Because once you see it, once you see the pattern of what's coming, you simply refrain from it. And not only for you but like I said, for future generations, for your children, your grandchildren.

In any given situation if we change the meaning of it in our life from **negative to positive**, then we broke the curse and we've gone from pain to strength. So every single thing, **Romans 8:28**, every single thing that happens in your life would only be allowed by Yahweh if it's ultimately for your good. So that's what you have to do. Like with Joseph, Joseph in the Bible in Genesis. You have to have the mental mentality of the Kingdom to **be looking**, **What is the good that comes out of this?** In any given situation if your life if you **change** the meaning of it in your life from negative to positive, then you've gone from pain to strength and you reached the other side. Truly being on the other side is a mentality and **once you reach it**, **you will never go back**—if you truly reach it.

So you have to make a choice. Do you want to live in the false fear of Satan's system, or the true reality of the Kingdom of Yahweh? And that's a choice you have. Because even, like I said, we're physical human beings, right, we're made of matter. We're made of dirt and water. So because we're not spirit being yet, even though the Spirit of Yahweh is in us physical human beings can take us and even put us in bars, put us in a prison with bars there, right? So they can chain your body or put your body in a prison, but they can't do it to your mind. And that's one thing. And that's the one thing I really appreciate with the stories about Richard Wurmbrand that shows that.

If you live in the Kingdom mentality, it doesn't matter where you are, even in a prison, you're free ... you're free. So you have to ... you can't allow Satan to steal that from you—never allow him to steal your mind, to steal your Kingdom mentality. And it's your choice though. We have free choice. So you have to decide. Do you want to live in the false fear that he has or the true reality?

So number three, *fear*. 1st John 4:17 and 18:

1st John 4:17-18 By this, love has been perfected in us, that we have confidence in the Day of Judgment, that as He is, we are also in the world. Therefore there is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear, because fear has torment; and the one fearing has not been perfected in love.

So this gets back to pain, right? Because pain also brings fear because as physical human beings, the last thing we want is pain. And sometimes there's questionnaires, they'll say, "What would you rather do? Would you rather be imprisoned or would you rather be in pain?" ... and this and that. And usually pain is the last thing on somebody's list what they want. "Would you rather go hungry or would you rather be in pain?" That nobody wants pain. And if you've ever had a really bad toothache or something even worse, you know it. Pain is terrible. Nobody wants pain. But you don't want pain to bring fear because fear is simply false evidence appearing real. That's the acronym for fear. F-E-A-R, false evidence appearing real. And the reality is that most fears will never happen.

So as people fear ... and a lot of times this is why although we have to understand about world government and what's happening in the times we're living in, you don't want to focus on it so much that you're living in fear. Living in fear of the government, living in fear that they're going to do this to me, they're going to do that to me. You can't live that way because it's the opposite of faith. You either live in faith or you live in fear. And most fears will actually never even happen.

So we see that. How do we get rid of fear? Perfect love ... perfect love casts out fear. When you have that true, agape love of Yahweh, the true love, there is no fear in that. So how do we get to the other side? **Perfect love casts out fear—by giving more than what you're getting.** And in one way, you really can't do it because the more you give, the more that's going to come back. And this happened to me years ago. There was a point in my life where you just don't want nothing and you read that Scripture that says, "Yahshua says: give everything away to the poor."

And I tried doing it, and every time I tried to give away, and in some cases it was quite a bit, **it came back to me double**. And almost like with the story with Joseph and the brothers, remember he kept putting in the sack double. And then I finally realized because Yahweh was showing me a lesson. And the lesson was, well if I have nothing, then I'm not going to be able to help anybody and I'm going to be dependent. So I'm not even going to be able to feed myself or put clothes on my back. So yes, *mentally* you have to live as if nothing belongs to you. You have to use your assets to give, but you don't just give every asset away or you'll have nothing to be able to do the ministry with and help other people with. And sometimes Yahweh has to show this.

So we give more than what we get, which is really like I said, impossible anything. By changing our focus from ourselves to our loved ones. So you got to get your focus off yourself. When you're focused on *yourself*, you become prideful. You almost become an elohim to yourself. And it doesn't matter. You got to get the focus off of yourself. And we are focused on outward love to Yahweh and others, then we've gone to the other side. So this one is really not that hard. It's just a matter of not allowing *anything* to affect you to the point where you're loving yourself more than you're loving Yahweh and your neighbor.

Love really is not just the greatest of the Ruach, the Spirit, as we see in Corinthians 13, but is the most powerful tool and motivating factor in our lives to overcome any challenge that we may have because you're not doing it for yourself. And that's what I say, the number one reason I want to get in the Kingdom is not for me. I'm probably a close second ... I really want to be there for me too. But the main reason why I want to get there, even more than myself, is because of what Yahweh invested in me!

And I'm thinking, wow, out of five million other people He could have chosen, He chose me and I don't want to let Him down. I don't want Him to think, "Oh boy, you know well they say Elohim never makes a mistake but I guess did this time. Look at this guy. I should have never picked him." No, I want to make Him proud. I want to make Him thankful that He chose me. I want Him to say on Judgment Day, give me a hug and Yahshua say, "Welcome good and faithful servant. Enter My Kingdom." So I want to do it more for Him then myself. Then like I said, I'm still human. I'm a pretty close second. I also want to be there. I don't want to not be in His Kingdom. But we have to really ... love is a motivating factor. It helps us to overcome any challenge we may have. Love conquers all including fear, right? Jacob 4 in verse 4 says:

Jacob 4:4 Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that the friendship of the world is enmity (hatred) with YAHWEH? Whoever, then, purposes to be a friend of the world is an enemy to YAHWEH.

So here it is *hate* is the opposite of love, right? And fear comes from hate. Fear is also the opposite of love. But if you're an enemy to Yahweh then that's the opposite of love. So **the opposite of love is the world, being a friend to the world is the opposite of love.** So if you really want to have true love, you can't be a friend of the world because what you're doing is, *you're giving your allegiance to Satan*.

And loyalty ... and I've given sermons on this ... loyalty means more to Yahweh than anything. Because if you sin—if you lie, or you stole, or you disrespected your parents, or you coveted ... they're all sins and they all bring death—but you can repent of that. It's a mistake that you do as a human being because to the core, we all are selfish. And we have to get rid of that. But disloyalty is more than just a sin. It's more than just an act in passion. Disloyalty is a character trait. And usually disloyalty can't be changed. Because what is the core of disloyalty? Selfishness! Disloyalty comes from looking out for yourself more than anybody. And it doesn't matter who it is, your husband, your wife, your parents, your best friend, Yahweh. It doesn't matter who it is. When you're disloyal, you will, like Judas did, you will throw anybody under the bus to save your skin, and you become your own elohim again.

So this is where **when you're a friend of the world, you're an enemy to Yahweh**, why? Because you've given your loyalty to Satan, not to Yahweh. If you live in the mentality of Satan's world and you have to *rely* on Satan's society for food, for clothing, for rent, for job, for healthcare, you know what then? Of course, you're going to live in fear. Of course you will because in Satan's society, you know what? You're going to lose your job and you're not going to get food. We already

saw it with Covid. And when the next thing coming is worse. But you know what? If you're not in that society, then there's no fear because what can they do to you? There's nothing they can do to you. You're already on the other side. You're not looking to Satan's society for your daily needs. You're looking to Yahweh. The Master's prayer that Yahshua told—you pray to Yahweh for your daily needs. You don't pray for Satan's society.

So this is what it comes down to. This is really what it comes down to. But if you have the mentality where you're relying on Satan's society for all your food, your clothing, your rent, your job, your healthcare, you're going to live in fear. And never mind *perfect* love, there's *no* love! There's *no* true love in Satan's society. It says *perfect* love casts out fear; real love, agape love. But **in Satan's society, there's no true love period**—never mind perfect. There's no love *there*.

And I tell this story of a brother that I know that when I was talking to him, before he went into one of the communities and he was talking to me and he's saying, "But how can I survive outside of the system?" And you think about that right? He's going to give up his job that he was making pretty good money. He's not going to have money to pay his rent or do any of these things or buy food. He's like, "How can I survive outside the system?" Right? Then he moved into the community and after living in the community for a while ... whatever it was, a year or two, and I saw him again ... you know what he said to me? He said, "Wow, how could I ever have survived if I didn't leave the system?"

He said the **total opposite!** He saw it! He had to go into the community to understand it because when you're living in Satan's world and that's your reality, of course you're going to think that way. Because every single *thing* of your reality is in the twilight zone; it's in that alternative universe that you're going and working and living and having your help. And everything is in every day of your life. But once you leave that and you're living in community and now you see it and you see how different you are. You see how you've changed. And you see you're on the other side. Then it's like you realize, "How could I have ever gotten into the Kingdom of Yahweh if I stayed in there?" And you can't.

And that's why the mark of the beast is Yahweh's cut line. Because that will be where people will either *totally* come out of the society or not. And you won't do it at the last minute. If you're not doing it now, and you're not doing it step by step to get to the other side, you don't get to the other side overnight. It is a journey. Like I say, there's only one road to the Promised Land. It's the wilderness—and it's not a short road. It's not a one kilometer walk there. It's a long and windy road. And you have to get on it as quick as possible because there's a lot of detours on that road and you have to make sure. But that is simply the way you do it—total change of mindset. And when you're outside of that system there is no fear because there's no fear in the Kingdom of Yahweh and everything will be taken care of by Yahweh. But that's the mindset you have to have.

So let's go to a few more Scriptures pulling all this together now. Like I said, 2nd Timothy 3 ... 2nd Timothy shows what Satan's society is all about:

2nd Timothy 3:1-4 But know this, that in the last days ... here we are ... disastrous times will be upon us ... he didn't have to tell us that, we're living in it ... For men will be lovers of themself ... And that's where fear comes. Fear only comes when you're loving yourself. There is no fear when you have total love for somebody else ... lovers of money, braggarts, arrogant, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, ungrateful ... That's another thing that brings all these things we're talking about; pain and fear and whatnot. Doubt—is when we're ungrateful ... wicked, without natural feeling, addicted to lust, slanderers, without self-control ... something you really need if you're going to get to the other side ... savage, haters of good, traitors, hasty, boasters, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of Elohim,

And unfortunately, the only way you *really* are going to pleasurable and happy is if you get to the other side. But that's the deception of Satan. That's the, like I said, that's the counterfeit in his society—that it's all a Disney Land. It's smoke and mirrors. You go there and it looks like, wow, this is this, but it's cardboard that you can knock out and there's nothing behind it. It's not really a castle. It *looks* like a castle in the kingdom, right, but you go in the castle and what is it? It's Babylon. It's a store that's try to sell you things. So that's Satan's kingdom. That's what it is, right?

And what are the fruits of that? Let's go to Galatians in verse 16. Let's see, what are the fruit of Satan's kingdom? Galatians 5 in verse 16:

Galatians 5:16-18 But I say, if you walk in the Spirit, the lust of the flesh will not overtake you ... Right? You're on one side or the other ... For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh ... Right? Can't live in both worlds, can't have one foot in Satan's world, one foot in the Kingdom—doesn't work that way because they are contrary to each other ... and these are opposed to one another; and you are not able to do as you desire. But if you are led by the Ruach, you're not under the penalty of the Torah ... Because it's in Satan's society that you're going to break the Torah and then be under those penalties.

Galatians 5:19a Now the works of the flesh ... Here it is. This is the fruit that's going to come if you stay in Satan's society ... are clearly revealed, which are: adultery, impurity, uncleanness, lustfulness ... right? All the things I was reading here in 1st Timothy (2nd Timothy) ... idolatry, witchcraft ...

Comment: Right? Witchcraft comes from so many things you wouldn't even think about. Like I said, celebrating birthdays; and birthday candles, and cakes, and all this other ritual, and all the things people are doing. It's all part of witchcraft.

Galatians 5:19b *enmity, fighting, jealousies, anger, rivalries, stubbornness ...*

Comment: Why people don't come out because these are all *spirits* that come. When you live in Satan's society then the spirits that Satan has ... and these are all spirits ... they will affect you. When you're living in the Kingdom of Yahweh, you know what spirits are going to affect you? Cherubs—Yahweh's Spirit!

Galatians 5:19b stubbornness, divisions, heresies, envies, murders, drunkenness, reviling's, and the things of these; in which I tell you beforehand, I said before, the ones practicing such things will not inherit the kingdom of Elohim.

So how do you not practice them? By getting to the other side, by not being around them, by not being **tempted** by them because you're out of that system. But what are the fruits in the Kingdom of Yahweh? Let's go on, verse 22:

Galatians 5:22-24 But the fruit of the Spirit is: love ... like we said that's the root of all of these ... love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faith, meekness, and self-control ... the one we really need to get to the other side ... Against such things there is no instruction ... so there's nothing that instructs against having these nine fruits of the Spirit ... But the ones belonging to Messiah crucified the flesh with its passions and lusts. Let us therefore live by the Spirit, and surrender to the Spirit.

You have to surrender to that Spirit if you're going to get to the other side. This is the way you do it. Like I said, **changing** your mindset, **changing the** meaning of what things are and literally living in that Kingdom mindset. If you live in a Kingdom mindset these will be the fruits. And there's no fear in the Kingdom, only fruit. 2nd Corinthians 6:17 and 18:

2nd **Corinthians 6:17-18** Because of this, "Come out from among them and be separated, says YAHWEH, and do not touch the unclean thing, and I will receive you." "And I will be a Father to you, and you will be sons and daughters to Me, says YAHWEH Almighty."

So how do you get to the other side? Leaving it! Because like I said, you have two kingdoms here. You have the kingdom of Satan and the Kingdom of Yahweh. And every day you leave your house and you go in that alternative universe, you're going in the kingdom of Satan that's perishing, like we read in Corinthians. So you have to come out from the kingdom of Satan to the other side, to the Kingdom of Yahweh.

Again, it won't just happen. You have to work on it daily. You *mentally* have to *live* in that mindset and work on it daily. Guard yourself and your mind from Satan's infiltration. And the biggest way he does it is with those stupid phones and

the internet. Stay off of them. Stay off as much as possible. There might be some things you have to do and look up on the internet, whatever. I say use it about as much as you used to use a library, or a dictionary. But don't be surfing on there all of that evil stuff that Satan has in his kingdom.

Keep proper focus to live in a Kingdom mentality. Keep your life *sanctified* from the world. Stay out of the system of Babylon that Satan has created world-wide. So Babylon, yes America is end-time Babylon, *but* **Babylon is also the** *system* **that they brought to the world**—that America has brought to the world.

Pray and study and meditate on the Word of Yahweh daily. You have to focus on it. Whatever you focus on becomes most real. So you have to focus on that Kingdom every day. Read your Bible. Pray to Yahweh and study and meditate. Meditate on this. Think about the Kingdom. Don't just be thinking about everything in Satan's society or you'll never get to the other side. So the last Scripture is in Genesis 19:23-26:

Genesis 19:23-25 The sun had gone forth on the earth, and Lot came into Zoar. And YAHWEH on earth rained fire and brimstone on Sodom and Gomorrah, **from** YAHWEH out of the heavens. And He overthrew those cities, and all the plain, and all those living in the cities, and the produce of the ground.

Comment: Right? So this indicative of what's going to happen in the end-time ... that all of these cities of Satan's kingdom are going to all be destroyed by Yahweh. But looked what happened in verse 26:

Genesis 19:26 And his wife ... Lot's wife ... looked back with pleasure from behind him, and she became a pillar of salt.

Why a pillar of salt? Because salt is indicative in the Bible, like the Covenant of Salt, of something being everlasting. Salt is a preservative. In ancient times without refrigerators, they used salt to preserve meats, to preserve things. Even through a whole Shemita that you could preserve things with salt. So it shows **everlasting**. And she became a pillar of salt showing her destiny now is finished. She's not getting to the other side because she never lived in that mindset. Yahweh took her out of the Babylon of that day, right, out of Sodom, and her mindset was looking back—one foot in, one foot out. She didn't want to leave. She wanted to live in that alternative universe. She *loved* it too much. She loved the things of it. So Lot's wife lusted for the things she left behind. **We must abhor them. We must hate them.**

Going from doubt to faith, pain to strength, or fear to love, **it's a process**. It doesn't happen all at once, it's a process. And once you've gotten to the other side, you never want to go back to your former life or you risk losing your salvation. Yahweh bless. Shabbat Shalom.
