Transcript – The Incredible Human Potential

Okay, Chag Semeach once again! I enjoy every time I get a chance to say that because the Feast goes so fast, but praise Yahweh for that. I have a message I'm going to give today from a new class that I developed at the Bible School called, *The Incredible Human Potential*. And I've mentioned it before, but some of you were actually here, this school we had this time, but I've been doing that school for twenty some-odd years, we never had a program like we had this year, and right here. It brings back memories sitting in this chair and some of the brethren were saying that being here again.

And I've always said it, I've always *known* one of the things that started the school was people coming to the Feast and seeing how much one week can change people because it is ... you come to the Holy Land and you're in Jerusalem and the emotional aspect that's coming out, but then I notice that like as people went back it didn't stick. That it was more emotional. It wasn't really foundational. And I said we need to get more into this. We need to do this longer. And we've had school programs, all different kinds of programs. I think almost everybody in this room, or a lot of you — at least two thirds, have been to one program or another. We've had programs where we had six months Ulpans, learning Hebrew. We've had programs on Ambassador. We've had programs on all the Land of Israel and the archeology. And every program in itself was wonderful, but there was just nothing like this.

This program that I'm doing now because of how close we're getting to the ends is *really* on conditioning the brethren for that because I know from Scripture many people aren't going to make it. Its life and death. And Yahweh has really instilled in me, "You have to get them prepared! The time is short!" So in the past in the school I more or less ran the schools in a way where ... I mean I put the program out there but I didn't *challenge* people more than they were willing to be challenged. And this year I did. This year I felt more like I have to challenge you. I wouldn't be doing my responsibility before Yahweh if I wasn't. And never before in all the years we did it, that **every single person** ... there's always like the majority of the people come out good but there's always that last couple. But this time, I mean we saw some miracles and *really lasting* change, which was awesome.

So this was one of the big courses, different courses that I've done before. I'm going to be talking a lot about this in the coming months and probably, Yahweh willing, years ahead, but on the incredible human potential because I don't believe that even as believer's we really understand that potential, what we're here for. And when you think about it, and I hope that video we showed last night really opened up your minds to some. We are being conditioned. We are living in Satan's society and you're being conditioned every day of your life – by the time you wake up, from the food you're eating, the job you're working, the billboards you're seeing, the video you're watching, everything is conditioning you and not toward anything good. It's conditioning you to be servant of the system.

And Yahweh called us for something completely different. He called us out, one out of five million people out there to be His ambassador to bring this Good News of what's coming. And because of the conditioning in Satan's system, we're born into a system where we don't realize that. And we're born into a system of failure. Ninety-nine percent of people in this world fail. And the big thing the last couple of years is the one percenter's, right? And everybody's mad and they want to go out and kill George Soros and all this other stuff because of these one percenter's. But hey, don't get mad at these people, just because they happen to make a lot of money. Get mad at yourself for not fulfilling your great potential. So yes, do they put borders there before you? Do they try to stop you? Of course they do! But we have something they don't have. We have the Ruach H'Chodesh! We have Yahweh's backing behind us. But it's a mindset you have to live in every single day.

So today I'm going to talk about this for a short time but at the school this is like the **foundation for a month** of getting people to change those old associations and it does take time. And even, I haven't been in total contact with everybody since they left but I pray ... some of you are here that were here ... I pray since you left you're continuing to do those

neuro associations so you don't back to the old way. Because the key is: **it is totally possible to fulfill your great human potential.** 1st Corinthians 2 in verse 9 says:

1st Corinthians 2:9 according as it has been written, "Eye has not seen, and ear has not heard," nor has it risen up into the hearts of men, the things which YAHWEH has prepared for those that love Him ... Wow ... "Eye has not seen, and ear has not heard," nor has it risen up into the hearts of men, the things which YAHWEH has prepared for those that love Him.

And it is. Even when we know it, we don't fully know it. We look through a glass half-darkened. But we have to have that as our focus. We have to narrow our focus in this life or you'll never fulfill your potential. And the first thing is you have to know what that potential is if you're going to fulfill it. And most people just randomly go day to day. Satan is a master at stealing time. In the *Great Falling Away* book, I have this paper that somebody gave me years and years ago about Satan having this meeting with all his demons on, *Steal their time! You can't stop them from a relationship with Yahweh.* You don't have ability to stop their freewill, but steal their time! Take their time with all kinds of ends of useless stuff. If you've never read it go to the *Great Falling Away* and read that. It's really, really interesting because it's true.

So like I said, it's Satan's society. We're conditioned to fail from birth. We tend to focus on the world which is a world of destruction, and terror, and war but we have to focus on our great destiny that's coming. Because actually even in a horrific world we're living in, we should have joy in our life every day because our destiny is not the horrors of this world. Our destiny is the Kingdom of Yahweh. So, like I said, it's Satan's society. We're conditioned to fail from birth. And it's a mindset that people accept.

That's one of the reasons why from a young kid, for different reasons, it wasn't for good reasons, I wanted to be wealthy because I wanted to be independent. But I knew I was never going to work a job. That's why my family wanted me to go to college. I went to college because I did good on math tests and I was told *you're going to be an accountant someday!* And I'm like, "no, I doubt that!" But in my mind, I'm thinking to myself, you could give me twenty dollars an hours, fifty dollars an hour, or a hundred dollars an hour. I don't care the amount you're giving me. I don't want it. You know why? Because now I'm limited, I'm limited what I can do. I'd rather take the risk, going my own business and then I could make nothing or I could make a million dollars in a day. And there's days I've made fifty/sixty thousand dollars in one day in business. And I loved it because I didn't want social security. I wasn't looking for somebody else to take care of me. I was good with that. If I fail, okay it's on me. If I'm homeless when I'm sixty years old, that's on me. But you know what? Nobody is going to stop my potential because I felt very confident, and like I said in those days for the wrong reasons of Yahweh giving.

As a kid, I didn't do what normal kids did. I was ten years old and I'm playing real estate. I'm going in the New York Times and taking all the things out and going around my house and building these little ... with towels and blankets, houses and I'm making believe I'm selling these houses and buying these houses and doing it. It was just in my mind from a little kid. But I never wanted *my potential* to be minimalized. And that's why I didn't want to work. And I understand not everybody has that. For some people it's the opposite – getting that check at the end of the week is security. And there's a fear if I'm working for myself, what if I don't make it? What if my business goes under? We see during Covid a lot of people went out of business and lose it. So it's not for everybody.

But our potential in the Kingdom of Yahweh is for everybody. It is for everybody but it has to be a mindset. You have to have a mindset of "the sky is the limit". You can't limit yourself in this life. And most of the time that's what we do because when we *brainstorm* and we think of ... this is really what the school is about. It's about finding out what your gifts are and putting that into *functional ministry* plans. And people may come and not know what their gifts are but they surely know it when they leave. People may come not knowing a ministry plan but they sure have one when they

leave because you have to know. And that's what Yahweh expects from us. **He expects from the gifts He's given us for us to** *use* **these gifts to bear more fruit for His Kingdom.** And if we don't, there's accountability as we're going to see here later in the message.

So failure is the normalcy bias that we need to change. That's what we're conditioned to. We're conditioned that it's okay, to just accept it. But as I say: success is 80% physiological and only 20% skill. So that was the thing with me. When I was younger I had no problem going in any business. It didn't matter whether I knew about it or not because I knew business. I knew how to run a business. So if I didn't know a particular business, I could always hire a manager who knows how to run a restaurant or knows how to do this, whatever it is. But I knew how to run the business itself. And that's why I say, success is 80% physiological and only 20% skill. The skills important but you have to believe it. And I see sometimes ... I see people with the most amazing skill in the world and they never utilize it because they don't have that physiological mentality of using it.

Faith is simply belief, as we learned here. But you must have belief, not only in Yahweh, but you have to have belief in the great human potential that He's given you. You have to believe it. He says He didn't call any of us for nothing. So the fact that you're called, the fact that you're baptized, the fact you're sitting in a chair brings accountability. So we have to believe in that. You have to believe in the purpose He's called in your life. Philippians 4:13, I say that in the school because nobody's taking any credit for themselves. We do all things through Yahshua who gave me the strength. So we know that. That's a pre-condition. We don't have to keep coming back thinking, well I don't want to get too prideful, because it's not pride. Because any gift Yahweh gave you He could have easily given it to somebody else.

I don't play the violin. He could have given me the gift of the violin and somebody else the gift of teaching. So **it's His gift. So I can't take any credit.** Where is the boasting? But I certainly take the gift He's given me and use it to the best of my ability. So like I said, if it was the violin then I'd be here playing like Mozart. And if I couldn't, I'd learn how because I want to fulfill it to the greatest ability. So that's what the Bible says like when it talks about spiritual gifts, right? The one who has the wisdom, due it with diligence. **Every gift is to be used to greatest of our ability.** Genesis 1 in verse 26:

Genesis 1:26a And Elohim said, let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; ...

Comment: Do we get what that means? Wow! Yahweh creates all this stuff. He creates the birds. He creates the fish. He creates the animals. And it is just that He named them. He's not like Adam that just popped up and sees these things and ... *Ah, Ox! Okay calling him by names*. No, Yahweh created all this stuff and then He creates us. He creates out of dirt and water, right? And the minerals that are in our body. That it's kind of a miracle too that even though you could name those minerals, how it makes us a human being is a miracle in itself. But Yahweh says, I'm making you according to My image, in My own likeness. Not ... the fish is made in the image of the fish. The cow is made in the image of the cow kind, but we're made in the image of the "YAHWEH" kind, the Elohim kind. We're made in His very image.

Genesis 1:26b and let them **rule over** the fish of the sea, and over the birds of the heavens, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over all the creepers creeping on the earth.

Comment: So we're not here ... we have dominion over all these things. And like I said, you don't see the fish out there getting together saying, "Hey, you know it's going to be a bad winter. Let's all pack up together and let's swim up to Canada and stay there." They don't think that way. Yahweh's given us a mind to create, to think, to be like Him. And Satan through this system of commercial Babylon is stunting it. It's getting us where we're so ... and that's why I say, you get so defensive that your life is so filled with money worries and this worry and that worry, that we never have any time to be offensive to get that plan of action together, to write it down, to say it, to do it and fulfill it. And then verse 27:

Genesis 1:27 Elohim created the man in His own image; in the image of Elohim He created them. He created them male and female.

Comment: So here it is, we're made in the image of Elohim, in His own image but we have to grow in His likeness. We have to grow in His likeness and that takes character building.

Genesis 1:28a And Elohim blessed them; ... the humans ... and Elohim said to them, Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the land,

The same thing Yahshua said in the Parable of the Sower and the Seed. Genesis 1 is not about planting tomatoes. Not that I'm against it. I love planting tomatoes. We just planted tomatoes right before we came out here. And also all kinds of other plants, but that's not what it's about. It's an analogy. Can you imagine He's creating the world and the universe and everything else and the bigger thing He's going to tell man, *Make sure you get a good garden!* That would be an Elohim after my own heart, right? But that's not what it's about. We know it. We know when you parallel this in the New Testament with Yahshua, He's using this as an analogy of the fruit that we have to bear in our life. Meaning, **bringing** more people to salvation, sharing our salvation with other people. And that's what the Great Commission is about. We do it as a group, as a Congregation, but we also do it individually.

Just like in a government. There's a president. There's a vice president. There's a secretary of state. There's all these different people that have jobs, right? And everybody's job is important. So if your job is the secretary of agriculture, the president isn't there figuring out the land isn't good and checking for the chemicals in the land to make sure there's enough minerals. That's the minister who's in charge of that. So it's the same way here. We have a Congregation and from Jerusalem, we are bringing this Good News and we go and we set up congregations. And we have a world-wide preaching work. And we have the Matthew 24 program. But on a local level every brother or sister should be doing the same thing. Maybe not in the same way, but you should have some kind of ministry. Or what are you doing here? What are you doing here? What are you sitting in the chair for if you're not doing something? And Yahweh's Word says it. It's a responsibility before Him.

And I say it boggles my mind that sometimes human beings can go to Satan's school for fifteen, twenty, twenty-five years sometimes. Sometimes when you get out of the school, you have to go to by law sometimes, people will go to college and then get a Master's Degree and this degree and a doctor degree and all this stuff and spend all their years, and most of these jobs that will not be here in a few years when the Kingdom comes. And yet, I look over the years how many people had opportunity to come to the school and didn't ... for a month. Sometimes, two months or three months, but a sure opportunity in your life that can **change your life**, that can make that same rut that you're going in over and over and magnify the fruit that you're bringing to Yahweh. But you have to get your focus on it. And again, of course I know most people can't come to the school. I know a lot of people want to come and can't come. So but you still, whether you come to the school or not, **you still have to magnify your fruit**. You still have to do it. You have to bear fruit before Yahweh and you have to grow like this. Yahweh called us to become creators the way He is a Creator. Psalm 139 in verse 13 ... Psalm 139 in verse 13, look what he says:

Psalm 139:13-18 For You have possessed my inward parts; You wove me in the womb of my mother. I will thank You, for with fearful things I am wonderful; Your works are marvelous, and my soul knows it very well. My bones were not hidden from You when I was made in secret; when I was woven in the depths of the earth. Your eyes saw me as an embryo; in Your book all my members were written the days they were formed, and not one was yet among them. And how precious are Your thoughts to me, O El! How great is the sum of them! If I should count them, they are more than the sand; when I awake I am still with You.

So here it is. And I mean how on earth can people say that an embryo is not life? And not only is it life, that **you're not an accident.** You're sitting there and everything about you, you have special DNA and special fingerprints, and even thumbprints and all this stuff. And Yahweh created you. Yahweh knew exactly when you were being formed. He knew you from the day you were born. He's followed you every day of your life. And all He wants is the best for you. He just wants you to fulfill the great purpose that you've been called for.

So I just want to read here some facts about the human body that you might know some of them, maybe not. But some amazing facts that maybe you never thought of before because the human body is a miracle in itself. And that's why evolution is so ridiculous. That you could take a body as intricate as a human body and how the body works and how it heals itself, all the premises of it. And to think that it could all just come from an explosion. I've lived in Israel for many years. I've seen a lot of explosions. And like I said, explosions bring chaos and death. Explosions don't bring order. So if we went outside and we took a whole bunch of stuff and put it there and we put a stick of dynamite and blew it up, it wouldn't all of a sudden be in order in this thing. It would be chaos.

But just to give you some facts:

- The largest bone in the human body is called a femur. It can support thirty times the weight of a person's body, ounce for ounce it's stronger than steel. Stronger than steel, can you imagine a bone?
- Messages from the human brain travel along nerves up to 200 miles an hour 322 kilometers. Can you imagine 200 miles an hour messages from the human brain?
- It would take somebody typing 60 words a minute, 8 hours a day, around 50 years to type the human genome. 60 words a minute, 8 hours a day it would take you 50 years to type the genome.
- If a human being's DNA was uncoiled, it would stretch 10 billion miles, from Earth to Pluto and back. One person's DNA. DNA really topped it! When they started finding out about DNA that's where there's no way evolution can be there, that it could work that way. And then recently to find out Yahweh's gematria being the connecting point of all DNA. But wow, 10 billion miles to Earth and Pluto and back. **One person's DNA!**
- Every hour humans shed about 600,000 particles of skin or about 1.5 pounds every year. By the time a person is 70 years old, they would have lost 105 pounds of skin. Now I heard a lot of diets before, I never heard the skin diet. Amazing!
- The brain contains 86 billion nerve cells joined by a 100 **trillion** connections ... 86 billion nerve cells joined by a 100 trillion connections. This is more than the stars in the Milky Way. One brain!
- Like fingerprints ever human being has its own unique tongue print. And I hope they don't start that at airports because that will be it. My traveling days will be over.
- The lining is a person's stomach is replaced every 4 to 5 days to prevent it from digesting itself. Can you imagine every day? Every day your body ... or every 4/5 days stomach lining. It also creates new skin like we saw and even bones.
- Your body reproduces itself over time. And that's why doctors say like if you had a tumor and it was a cancerous tumor, a year from now it's not the same tumor because your body changes. And how you change your body and change your mentality will be how that tumor will change. It could be gone completely. It could be bigger, but it's not the same. And that's the point. That's why Satan wants us to be conditioned on failure. He doesn't want us to be conditioned on overcoming.
- A human sneeze can travel a hundred miles an hour or more. We're not going to have any sneezing contest. Don't worry!
- Your spit, when you spit it contains your entire genetic blueprint ... one spit.

- The liver, the largest internal organ is the only organ that can regenerate itself. However, repeated damage to the liver can eventually injure and scar this amazing organ. And we could sit here for an hour just talking about your liver, what your liver does and how it cleanses your blood and your body and everything.
- A human brain uses just as much power as a ten watt light bulb. Right, we had a light go out. Maybe we need a ladder and somebody to stick their head up on the roof. Your brain uses as much power as a ten watt light bulb.
- There are so many nerve cells in the human brain; it would take almost 3000 years to count them.
- An adult skin weighs begin 8 and 11 pounds 3.6 to 5 kilos. It surfaces about 18 to 22 square feet 1.7 to 2 square meters which is the size of the floor of a one person tent. When I read this I was thinking about like when they skin bears and stuff. You see the skin that's there.
- An average person walks a hundred thousand miles. A hundred thousand and sixty kilometers in his or her lifetime which is like walking around the world four times at the equator. It's amazing. I try to walk four or five times a week and sometimes it's amazing where you start to walk, and it's only a few minutes, and you look back where you came from, and you're like, wow, how can legs go that fast?
- An adult is made up of 7 octillion atoms. That's a 7 with 27 zeros. That's how many atoms a human being is made from.
- In an adult human, blood circulates about 12,000 miles 19,000 kilometers a day. It's like travelling from east to west across the widest part of the Pacific Ocean. So here it is you're not turning on a button. It's not like when you make juice and you have a mixer there, right? But your blood is travelling 19,000 kilometers per day, all these things that Yahweh inherited from it.
- A human heartbeat beats over 3 billion times during an average lifespan.
- A human eye can distinguish between approximately 10 million different colors on its own. And just the eye itself when you understand how it works and how it comes in and turns and sees, it's absolutely amazing.
- And the greatest of all creation is mankind itself himself, herself; the marvelous machine precise and efficient. The human body has a dynamic framework of bone and cartilage called the skeleton. The human skeleton is flexible with hinges and joints that were made to move. But to cut down harmful frictions, such moving parts must be lubricated. Manmade machines are lubricated only by outside sources, but the body lubricates itself by manufacturing a jelly-like substance in the right amount in every place that's needed. That does not happen with evil-ution. It only happens by creative design by a Creator.

There's a lot more. I just kind of hit some of the highlights just to show you the amazing human body that Yahweh made us with. And we don't think about it. And that's why the Scripture says, **our body is the sanctuary of the Ruach H'Chodesh.** Although we're not living to preserve this body for eternity, you do want to preserve it while you have it.

And the body is an amazing gift that Yahweh has given us. Psalm 8 ... Psalm 8:1-9:

Psalm 8:1-4 O YAHWEH, our Master, **how majestic is Your name in all the earth**; You have set Your glory above the heavens! Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings, You have ordained strength, because of the ones distressing You, to cause the enemy and the avenger to cease. When I look upon Your heavens, the work of Your fingers: the moon and the stars which You fixed; what is man that You are mindful of him, and the son of man, that You visit him?

Psalm 8:5-9 For You have made him lack a little from Elohim; and have crowned him with glory and honor. You made him rule over the works of Your hands; You have put **all things under his feet**: ... We just read that in Genesis 1 ... all flocks and oxen, and also the animals of the field, and the birds of the heaven, the fish of the sea, all that passes through the sea. O YAHWEH, our Master, **how majestic is Your name in all the earth!**

Wow! What Yahweh has done, the gift that He has given us, the life that He's given us is just absolutely amazing. And we need to understand and fulfill that potential. Psalm 82 ... Psalm 82 in verse 6, says:

Psalm 82:6 *I have said,* **You are Elohim**, ... He's talking to humans now ... *I have said,* **You are Elohim**, and all of you are **sons of the Most High.**

Wow! And that is our potential. **Our potential is to** *become* **spirit-beings and children of Yahweh in His Kingdom forever.** It's hard to concept because like I said, everything in our life from the day you're born is timed. We have so many days of life on this earth, you see it as you get. And when you think about it though, I used to think life was long until recently because now the time goes so fast. Sixty/eighty years doesn't seem like anything. But when you think of eternity, no beginning/no end, it's just inconceivable. And that's what Yahweh said. That's what He gave us. He said, *You are Elohim and sons of the Most High.* Wow! What a truly Elohim we serve.

We will be transformed into spirit to be full family members with Yahweh and Yahshua ruling with Them. And like I said Genesis 1:28, we are though ... if we want to be there, we have to bear fruit and multiply and accomplish to fill the Land. And this message will go out to our Congregation around the world. And my question is: what are doing for that? Thinking of being a co-heir of the universe and being with Yahweh over the entire universe, what is your part? What are you doing every day for that? Minimal-wise we should at least be reading Scripture and praying, but those are requirements that we have to do just for ourselves, just to keep our mindset. But what are you doing? What is your ministry? What part do you have in this? Because if you don't have a part in it now, you're not going to have a part in it later. That's why Yahshua said, He says, Unless the Kingdom of Yahweh is within you, you will not be in the Kingdom of Yahweh.

And it's this thing, this "Sunday Christian-type" mentality, and like I said, unfortunately most of us come from Christianity that we think we're doing better than the Sunday Christian because we're meeting on Saturday. We're not eating pork. And we're keeping Sukkot, instead of keeping Christmas. And again, those are only things that Yahweh does to bring us to a greater reality of His truth, but that is not bearing fruit. It's bearing nothing. It's a Commandment, but it's not bearing fruit for His Kingdom by doing that. And what is your day? That's one of the first things we have the students do when they come. Even now before, I actually started the school about three weeks beforehand to get the people prepared. And we do it through the internet. But I have them write a planner of your day from the time you wake up to the time you go to bed. And then look at that planner, who are you living for? Are you living for yourself or are you living for Yahweh? How much time is spent on ministry? On bearing fruit? It's a requirement. And if we're going to fulfill this great potential, we have to do it.

John 3 in verse 3 ... John 3 in verse 3. And this is when Nicodemus came to Yahshua, right?

John 3:3-8 And Yahshua answered and said to him, Truly, truly I say to you, that if a man is not born again, he is not able to see the Kingdom of YAHWEH. Nicodemus said to Him, "How is it possible to enter the womb of his mother the second time and be born?" And Yahshua answered, Truly, I say to you, that if a man is not born from water and spirit, he is not able to enter into the kingdom of YAHWEH. The thing, which is born from flesh, is flesh, and the thing, which is born from spirit, is spirit. Do not wonder because I said to you, You must be born from above. The wind will blow where it desires, and you hear its voice. But you do not know where it comes or where it goes. Likewise is everyone who is born from the spirit.

Right? So, this is what it's about. This is what baptism is the beginning of. **Baptism is the beginning of** *dying* **to the old life** and being ... coming up and getting the Ruach H'Chodesh ... just a down payment of it, and starting to get that. But you're only ... it's like a baby in a womb. When a baby is conceived, day one, day two, day three, that baby isn't *formed*. It's a life, but it's not formed. It takes nine months. And that's what we're like after baptism, it takes the rest of our life to be *nurtured* until the time Yahshua comes where we shed these bodies and we will be *born again* into His Kingdom. That's why **Yahshua is the** *first-born* from the dead. That's what being born again is. It's not an emotional experience

like some of these born-again people think. And like it says, everyone born from the Spirit is like the wind. So I have a very simple way to find out if somebody's born-again. If somebody comes up to you, a Christian, and says, "No, I'm already born again." Stick them with a pin! And if he screams, he's not born again. Give them the pin test because everyone born again is like the Spirit. So if somebody thinks he's born again ... sometimes like we say, break the pattern! You have to shock them. Make sure it's a big pin ... big safety pin!

Genesis 3 in verse 17, because you know what? From the beginning Adam did not *cherish*, he didn't internalize what I'm going over today. Adam was the first teacher that Yahweh set apart in the Garden to teach things. And he should have been sitting in this chair teaching and bringing more people into the Kingdom, but he chose a different path. And there was a penalty that not only he paid, but we've all been paying since that time. Genesis 3 in verse 17, and this is his punishment for not fulfilling his purpose:

Genesis 3:17-19 And He said to the man, Because you have listened to the voice of your wife, and have eaten the fruit about which I commanded you, saying, You shall not eat from it, the ground will be cursed because of you; you will eat of it **in sorrow** all the days of your life. And it will bring forth **thorns and thistles** to you, and you will eat the plant of the field. **By the sweat of your face** you will eat bread until your return to the ground. For you have been taken out of it; for you are dust, and to dust you shall return.

So in the Garden of Eden there were no weeds. There were no restrictions with plants. We know in the Kingdom the trees are going to **every month** going to have fruit on them. But because of Adam, because of Adam *choosing* to be part of the system of commercial Babylon of Satan instead of the Kingdom of Yahweh, he opened up the door. And every human being, all of us, we've all chose the same way. That's what repentance is about. **It's about** *turning* **from that way of commercial Babylon (Satan) to the way of the Kingdom of Yahweh.** That's what we're doing at our baptism. And of course all the sins that came along with it.

So Adam lost a kingdom. He didn't lose a religion. Religion is something that is manmade. It's something that doesn't help your relationship with Yahweh. It actually restricts it. There is no such word as religion in Scripture. It's about relationship. It's not about religion. So Adam lost a kingdom, not a religion. And mankind will now struggle to fulfill his great potential. And this is why as people are born, like I said, they're born into a system of failure. And they're taught failure from birth and its okay. And we have to change our mindset. You have to change your mindset. You have to get new neuro associations and you have to realize that's not why you were created. You were not created to fail. You were created to be a spirit-being of the child of the Most High in Heaven. Revelation 20 in verse 4:

Revelation 20:4-6 And I saw thrones, and them that sat on them. And judgment was given to them, and the souls of the ones having been beheaded because of the witness of Yahshua, and because of the Word of YAHWEH, and who had not worshiped the beast nor its image, and had not received the mark on their forehead or on their hand. And they lived and reigned with Messiah a thousand years. **This is the first resurrection.** Blessed and holy is the one having part in the first resurrection. The second death has no authority over these, but they will **be priests of YAHWEH** and of His Messiah, and will reign with Him a thousand years ... priests of YAHWEH ... **Kings and priests**!

So remember, because of Adam's rejection of Yahweh, the king and the priesthood separated. So we know in this world, in Israel, you had Levi as the priest, but you had Judah as the king. Where in the Kingdom, like Yahshua – Yahshua is the King and the Priest, and we will be kings and priests, both. And when you look at Levi, that's only a shadow, what were some of the restrictions of Levi as a priest? He couldn't own private property. He couldn't have his own land. He couldn't have ... certainly didn't have a night job. He wasn't delivering pizzas at night. He's serving Yahweh day and night. That was his job. That's what he's set apart for. And here we are in the *real* priesthood ... Levi is only a shadow, we are the

Melchizedek priests, what are we doing? Are we taking that serious? Do we have a ministry? Are we serving Yahweh? Or is it only talk?

Micah 4 ... Micah 4 because we read here in Revelation, when Yahshua returns we have to prepare now to be ready for day one. Day one in the Kingdom, the training isn't going to be then. The training is now because when day one comes, He's got an envelope for each of us. Yahshua returns and His reward is with Him to give *each* according to what? According to His grace? No! The grace is what got us there. Our position is according to our deeds, our works. If you have no deed, there'll be no envelope. And you don't want to be there as Yahshua's handing all these envelopes out and you're the last guy standing there and everyone's gone. And you're wondering, where's my envelope?

Everyone sitting in these chairs and everybody watching this now has the Ruach H'Chodesh if you've been baptized, and you have gifts that Yahweh has given you and you are **required to use those gifts for His Kingdom. That is our main purpose in life.** Now granted, because of our dear forefather Adam, we are living in the system, when we do have to pay our bills and we do have to *work*, and we have to eat. So that's our big challenge in life. We have to *figure out* how can I do one without neglecting the other?

And this is one of the things why I like being in my own business. Because I lived a long time when I was young, I got my first like job on the books, when I was 14 years old. I was working at a Duncan Donuts. And you know I forget at that time whatever minimum wage was ... \$2.50 an hour ... but you work ten hours and you're, *Wow I made \$25.00!* This is good. I'm going to work 20 hours. I'm going to work 40 hours. And then I'm going to work in the summer, I'll work 90 hours. Then there's a point when you realize you can't work anymore hours. But then this other guy sees me and says, "Hey, I'll give you a job. Come over here and load these trucks. I'll pay you \$5.00 an hour for unloading the trucks." And I'm all of sudden like, "Wow! I'm making double the money in the same amount of time." And I started to realize it's not the *time* that you put into a job, it's the compensation you're getting, right?

So this is where you have to figure out — how can I, in this world, get enough compensation in a short amount of time to pay my bills, but have the majority of my time to serve Yahweh? And you have to brainstorm. It's do-able. It's hard. It's not easy, but it's do-able. But that's the potential Yahweh's giving us! We have that amazing brain. We have His Spirit in us. And we can do it! We can do it. I love that! The greatest part of my life is when I'm brainstorming. I love challenges because I love to sit there and figure out how to overcome it. That's something that Yahweh gave us. So we can't look at that as a negative way. We got to look at that as a positive way and figure out how to do it. And there are ways to do it. And I'm hoping that even as a Congregation, we could do things more.

As communities, I have ideas in my mind, how communities get money to support themselves. Some of our communities are already doing it. They have a restaurant in the community. They're selling this, they're selling that. So this is where we need to brainstorm as a people to be able to ... but the time is the thing that no matter who you are, like I said, if you're Donald Esposito or you're Donald Trump, you have 24 hours in a day. **Money doesn't give you more time**. Money doesn't buy you more time. So that's the time that Yahweh allotted and that's what we have to do now is figure out how I can separate that time and still fulfill my earthly commitments as a human being to family, whatever, but still have that time on working for Yahweh.

Micah 4, because like I said, we have to be ready for day one. This is what our great destiny and hope is. *For behold the day is coming* ... Whoop, I'm in Malachi. Maybe I'll read that later because that is also a very good scripture. But right now I want to read Micah. Micah 4 in verse 1:

Micah 4:1a But it shall be in the end of the days, the mountain of the house of YAHWEH will be established **on the top of the mountains**;

Comment: Right? So what is it saying? Just like the places of worship, we're always at the highest point because you're trying to get closer to Yahweh, closer to Heaven. And he's saying here that the mouth of Yahweh is going to be the highest point. It's the *highest authority* that's on the earth. That's where it's coming from?

Micah 4:1b-2 and it will be lifted up from the hills; ... so the hills that were shorter before, right? Before we may have only been able to reach the hill. Now when Yahshua returns, we're all going to on those high mountains ... and peoples will flow on it. And many nations will come and say, Come, let us go up to the mountain of YAHWEH, and to the house of the Elohim of Jacob. And He will teach us from His ways, and we will walk in His paths. For the Torah will go forth out of Mount Zion, and the Word of YAHWEH from Jerusalem.

Comment: That's why we're a Congregation of Yahweh Jerusalem. It's because that's where Yahweh's Word started. That's where His doctrine comes from, but it's a world-wide work. That's what it is. Today, Jerusalem is a corrupted place. And it will be redeemed and Yahshua will do that, but always that is where the Word comes from, from Jerusalem.

Micah 4:3-4 And He shall judge between many people, and will decide for strong nations afar. And they will beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks. Nation will not lift a sword against nation, nor will they learn war anymore ... Wow, what a great time. That's why we're sitting here. That's what Sukkot is all about. It's about us preparing for this time ... But each one will sit under his vine and under his fig tree, and there will be no trembling. For the mouth of YAHWEH of Hosts has spoken.

So that's why I say, we don't have to fear all these things. We have to be ... the Bible says watch and pray. We have to be knowledgeable of them so that we don't *partake* in some of these things. But we have to be looking forward to this. **We will be the leaders in this retraining process**. What are you doing about it? We will be the leaders of this. Matthew 28 in verse 18:

Matthew 28:18-20 And coming up Yahshua talked with them, ... His disciples and the apostles ... saying, **All authority in Heaven and on earth was given to Me (to Yahshua).** Then having gone, **disciple all nations**, baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son, and the Ruach H'Chodesh teaching them to observe all things, whatever I commanded you. And, behold, I am with you all the days until the completion of the age.

So this is not a commission just to the elders. This is a commission to every New Testament believer from that time until today, until He returns. **That is our commission.** That is our marching orders. That is what each person is called to do to be a part of this ... a part of this of **bearing fruit for His Kingdom**. That is the Great Commission. Revelation 1:5 and 6, says:

Revelation 1:5-6 even from Yahshua Messiah the Faithful Witness, the First-born of the dead, and the Ruler of the kings of the earth. To Him loving us and washing us from our sins by His blood, and He made us kings and priests to YAHWEH, even His Father. To Him is the glory and the might forever and ever. Amen.

So, we will be kings and priests onto Him. And I look at the royal family and like I say, not that they're the greatest example in everything, but in one thing they are a good example is: from the time a child is born into the royal family, like take Prince William, they are set apart and trained from birth for their destiny. They know it from their birth. And some of the things they're trained for is by going in the military, by serving people so that they're not ... don't get an attitude of "they're above people". Like Yahshua said, *He who wants to greatest among you, let him be your servant.* So one way we learn is by serving, like the Matthew 24 Project; part of it is – go to soup kitchens, go to hospitals, go anywhere to be doing some kind of service to people because that's what we're going to be doing for eternity.

But **you have to know your destiny to prepare for.** And do you think about it every day? Write it on your refrigerator and put it there; I am a king and a priest of Yahweh. That is to be foremost on your mind day and night. And every day of your life, do you have a plan on living toward that? Because *that is* what our destiny says. And it won't just happen. You have to prepare for it. Matthew 13 in verse 10. Matthew 13 in verse 10:

Matthew 13:10-12 And coming near, the disciples said to Him, Why do You speak to them in parables? And answering, He said to them, Because it has been given to you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of Heaven, but it has not been given to those. For whoever has, ... Right? Whoever is doing it, whoever has, whoever's bearing fruit ... to him will be given, and he will have overabundance. But whoever does not have, ... the one who is doing nothing ... even what he has will be taken from him.

Comment: So, you're quenching the Spirit if you're not using your spiritual gifts. So why would Yahweh give you a spiritual gift ... because He doesn't give the same gifts to everybody. He gives us different gifts so that we come together as a body. Why would He give you a gift if you're just putting it inside of you and not using it? If you're not, you're going to lose it. Like they say, use it or lose it. So you need to be using that gift that He's given you.

Matthew 13:13-17 Because of this, I speak to them in parables, because seeing they do not see, and hearing they do not hear, nor do they understand. And the prophecy of Isaiah is fulfilled on them, which says, "In hearing you will hear and in no way understand, and seeing you will see yet not perceive. For hardened is the heart of this people, and with their ears they're hard of hearing, and with their eyes they're blinded so they should not see with their eyes and hear with their ears and understand in their heart and return and I heal them ... He's talking basically about the world, the non-believers. But look what He says to the believers ... But your eyes are blessed because you do see; and your ears because you hear. For truly I tell you that many prophets and righteous ones desired to see what you see and did not, and hear what you hear and did not.

Wow! How many of the apostles would have given their right arm to live in the time we're living in now, to be that last generation. To not just to live in a time for whatever for 60/70 years, but to actually be here where our bodies will be shed and we're going to go up and meet Yahshua in the air and turn into a spirit-being. How many people would have done that throughout the times? And here it is, He says prophets and kings would have loved to see the things we're seeing and didn't, but we are ... we are. To much is given, much is expected and the more is given, the more is required. And Yahweh is requiring something of us. All we have to do is expect it, embrace it and go out and do it! It's exciting! It should be the most exciting thing in your life. It is for me because it gives me purpose in my life. This world has no purpose. What's the purpose in this world?

You look at all these people. Look at Solomon, one of the saddest books in the Bible, we read it at Sukkot, is Ecclesiastes. Here's a man that was not only the richest man in the world, he was wisest man in the world. He had *everything* you can imagine, anything he wanted. And at the end of his life, I want to read his book. Is his book like the Napoleon hill? Is it going to be one of these things? His book is, boy it's all vanity. Life stinks. That's basically his message **because** *his focus* wasn't on the Kingdom of Yahweh, unfortunately. And there's a good message there. It's actually one of my favorite books because of that. Because it keeps me in line to say never put your goal in this world. Always keep your focus on the Kingdom. Because even you do live a great life, even if you have a wonderful family, even if you're never sick, even if you're a multi-millionaire and can do whatever, do you know what's going to happen? The time in this world will run out like it did on Solomon. It'll run out sooner or later. And you could live now for the 50/60/70 years *in time*; or you could use this time now to live for eternity. It's your choice and we have freewill.

What's it going to be? That's what Yahweh does. That's what He's putting before us. Because do you think He wants people in His eternal cabinet, do you think He wants eternal children that are like nonchalant about what He's given?

Like, "Ah okay, eternal life? I guess I'll do it." No! He doesn't want that! **He wants people that are** *zealous***. He wants people that are so excited, people that have** *joy* **in their life because of this!** That's what He wants **because they believe in Him because the joy isn't coming from what we're getting. The joy is coming from what He's giving! And it's showing, we** *believe* **in Him. It's showing that we trust His Word.** And it's showing we look at Him as a Father and we're looking at *us* as His children. So that's what it comes down to. We're born for this great purpose. We have to fulfill it.

Luke 19, parable of the talents. We've heard it many times but I couldn't give a message like this without going over this because it's all about this. Luke 19 verse 11:

Luke 19:11-14 But as they were hearing these things, He spoke, adding a parable, because He was near to Jerusalem, and they thought that the kingdom of Elohim was immediately to be revealed ... we said that. They thought at that time that was the last generation, which it wasn't ... Then He said: A certain well-born man went to a distant country to receive a kingdom for himself, and to return. And calling ten of his slaves, he gave to them ten minas and said to them, Trade and keep busy until I come. But the citizens of his city hated him ... He's talking about His Jewish brothers ... and sent ambassadors after him. And they were saying, "We do not want this man to rule over us."... They're still saying it today.

Luke 19:15-17 And it happened as he returned, having received the kingdom, he even said for those servants to be called to him, those to whom he gave the silver, that he might know what each had gained by trading ... And the silver is indicative of the spiritual gifts. He's using that as the gifts that we're given from **Corinthians 12** ... And the first came, saying, Master, your mina has gained ten minas. And he came and said, Well done, good slave! Because you were faithful in a least thing, have authority over ten cities ... Right? The same as His coming, we're going to have authority over, not only cities maybe planets. Who knows?

Luke 19:18-21 And the second came, saying, Master, your mina has made five minas. And he said to this one also, And you be over five cities. And another came, saying, Master, behold your mina which I have stored up in a facecloth. For I feared you, because you are a harsh man, taking what you did not lay down, and reaping what you did not sow.

Comment: So here's the guy who had the gift and out of fear he did nothing, right? Maybe like today people are fearing the New World Order. They're fearing this, they're fearing that. But **fear will immobilize you**. Fear is not going to make you go out and work for Yahweh. It's going to do the opposite. So the only fear we should have is fear of Yahweh, not fear of the world. And look what Yahweh says, He says:

Luke 19:22 I will judge you out of your own mouth, wicked slave. You knew I am a harsh man, taking what I did not lay down, and reaping what I did not sow. Why did you not give my silver on the bank table? And coming, I might have exacted it with interest.

Comment: Right? So the *least* you can do ... the least you can do, it doesn't take much. I've said that to people sometimes that were living in Babylon that said, "You know, you have a house here that's worth like \$300,000. If you sell that house and put that money in the bank, you don't even have to work! You could live a modest life. That money could pay your bills and now you could work for Yahweh full time!" That's what Yahweh's saying here. Did you even do the minimal? Did you do the *least* of it? Or are you just taking it for granted?

Luke 19:24-27 And to those standing by, he said, Take the mina from him, and give it to him who have ten minas. And they said to him, Master, he already has ten minas. But He said, To everyone who has, it will be given. And from the one who does **not have**, even what he has will be taken away ... And again, He's talking about the Ruach. So here it is ... But

to those my enemies who did not desire that I rule over them, bring them and execute them before me!" ... And again, He's talking about Judah.

So we're born for a great purpose but we must live our whole life to grow in this and bear fruit. We have to. It's not just something that we get emotional about in our tummy. It's something you have to live. It's something you have to live and you have to bear. And it's the greatest feeling in your life. Bearing fruit brings more feeling than anything. Just like in life if you've ever maybe graduated from a school and you get a diploma, or you went to a program and something happens. Or whatever it is, when you accomplish something there's a good feeling to you because you've sweated something out. You've done it. You finished. And now, wow, now you're getting the reward from it. So it's the same way here. When you're bearing fruit for Yahweh it is the greatest feeling in your life because you're feeling that you are living for the calling in which you were called for.

- 1st Corinthians 12, and again like I said, it wasn't silver. He's talking about in that parable, He's talking about **spiritual gifts** that He's given. 1st Corinthians 12, it says:
- **1st Corinthians 12:1-3** But concerning spiritual gifts, my brethren, I want to remind you. That once you were pagans and without exception, you were led to dumb idols. Because of this I made known to you that no one speaking by the Spirit of Elohim says, Yahshua is a curse. And no one is able to say Yahshua is YAHWEH, except by the Holy Spirit.
- 1st Corinthians 12:4-10 And there are diversity of gifts, but there is one Spirit; and there are diversity of ministries, yet YAHWEH is first. And there are diversity of powers, but the same Elohim is working all things in all. And to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit as a help to him. For through the Spirit is given to one a word of wisdom, another a word of knowledge, according to the same Spirit; and to another, faith by the same Spirit, to another, gifts of healing by the same Spirit, to another, workings of powers, and to another, prophecy, to another, discerning of spirits, to another, different kinds of languages, to another, interpretation of languages.
- **1**st **Corinthians 12:11** But **the one and the same Spirit works all these things**, distributing separately to each as He wills.

Right? So this is what it's saying. That if you're not using these gifts the Holy Spirit has given you, it simply will diminish. It won't come back. We have to take advantage of every opportunity to grow in the gifts that are given and to use them. Isaiah 11 in verse 9 says:

Isaiah 11:9 They will not do evil, nor destroy in all My holy mountain. For the earth will be full of the knowledge of YAHWEH, as the water cover the sea ... the earth will be full of the knowledge of YAHWEH.

How will that be? When Yahshua returns, probably 96/97/98% of the people on this earth are going to be dead. So out of 8 billion some odd people even 2% though is still 30 million, 50 million people that are going to be left. And these people aren't going to know what happened. They're not going to understand. Most of the world is dead. Nuclear war has come. How are they going to understand by us? We will fulfill this scripture. We are going to go to these places. It says in **Isaiah 66** Yahweh will send us to these places, to these hurting people to comfort them and to start to teach them - *There's a King that is here from Heaven. Things will be different.*

So if we do not *prepare*, we're not going to be ready for that. We will be the ones teaching and re-educating the people in the Kingdom. But just like anybody here that's a teacher, or ever been a teacher, you know you don't just go up and start teaching. I didn't just come up and start teaching. Yahweh had to prepare me the way He prepares you. He prepares you for a job and then you have to fulfill it. Romans 8, last verse we're going to go into here. Romans 8:14-23 says:

Romans 8:14-17 For as many as are led by the Spirit of Elohim, these are the children of Elohim. For you did not receive a spirit of slavery again to fear, but you received a Spirit of sonship by **which we cry**, ... Like I said, Daddy! ... Father! Abba! The Spirit itself witnesses with our spirit that **we are children of YAHWEH**. And if children, also heirs; truly heirs of Elohim, and joint heirs of Messiah, if indeed we suffer together, that we may be glorified together.

Romans 8:18-20 For I calculate that the sufferings of the present time are **not worthy** to compare to the coming glory to be revealed in us ... Wow, what an understatement! ... For the earnest expectation of the creation eagerly awaits the revelation of the sons of Elohim ... Creation itself is groaning and waiting for us to get out there and manifest to be what Yahweh created us to be ... For the creation was **not willingly subjected** to vanity, but through Him subjecting it, on hope;

Romans 8:21-23 that also the creation will be freed from the slavery of corruption to the freedom of the glory of the children of Elohim ... All creation will go back to the way it was for our benefit and for our help to teach others ... For we know that all the creation groans together and labors in pain together until now. And not only so, but also we ourselves having the first-fruit of the Spirit, ... Right? We're not born again but we have the Spirit in us ... also we ourselves groan within ourselves, eagerly expecting that son-ship, the deliverance from this body;

And that's what will happen. We will shed these bodies. We'll be a glorified spirit-being. And we will be part of the Elohim family. Praise Yahweh for that. Verse 28 says:

Romans 8:28-32 But we know that to the ones loving Elohim all things work together for the good, of those being called according to His purpose; And He knew them in advance; and He sealed them with the likeness of the image of His Son; that He might be the first-born of many brothers. But whom He marked in advance, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; whom He justified, these He also glorified ... And that's what's coming when Yahshua returns ... What then shall we say to these things? If YAHWEH be for us, who can be against us? ... Don't fear the New World Order. Look out what happens when Yahweh comes with that New World Order ... If YAHWEH be for us, who can be against us? Truly He who did not spare His own Son, but gave Him up on behalf of us all, how will He not freely give all things to us with Him?

Romans 8:33-36 Who will bring any charge against the elect of Elohim? YAHWEH is the One justifying! Who is he condemning? It is Messiah who has died, but rather is raised, and also is at the right hand of YAHWEH, who is also making intercession on our behalf. Who shall separate us from the love of Messiah? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? Even as it has been written, "For Your sake we are killed all the day; we are counted as lambs for the slaughter."

Romans 8:37-39 But in all these things we are **more than conquerors** through Him loving us. For I am persuaded that neither death, nor life, nor cherubs, nor rulers, nor armies, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other thing created will be able to separate us from the love of YAHWEH in Messiah, Yahshua, our Master.

Yahweh wants a relationship with us. He didn't call us to be slaves. He called us to be children. He wants that relationship, but we have to accept it. We have to grow into it. We're called to children of the Creator of the Universe. Wow! What an incredible human potential. We come from a royal lineage and we're destined to be priests and kings with Yahshua over the universe. We need to prepare for this great calling now or we risk losing it if we're not bearing fruit and preparing for our job. This is our amazing destiny. This is our life and our vocation. Not just to be alive, but to live with purpose as a spirit-begotten child of Yahweh and work with Him and Yahshua as redeeming mankind back to Him and creating more sons of Elohim forever and to colonize the earth to be as Yahweh has His Kingdom in the Heavens, like He said in the prayer that Yahshua said – Our Father who art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy Name. Thy

Kingdom come. Thy will be done on the earth as it is in Heaven. And we are the ones He's allowing to rule over that colonization.

So what I've been teaching you now in about an hour's time is what I extensively teach for about a month at the Bible School. And it's more than just the teaching as the ones that were there know. Because I thought about, I thought about trying to go around to the congregations and teaching this worldwide; which I can partly. But a big part of it is environment. Like I always say, environment is 90% of the battle. And a lot of what people don't understand ... almost like what we were learning last night on that video how we're being conditioned, how your mind works ... it's extremely harder to change when you're in your same environment. By bringing the people in an environment like this, and I've done this program 20 something years. We've had good environments in Israel, but never nothing like this. I mean we're really out in no-man's land. There's nowhere to go. There's no stores to go to. There's nothing to do.

So the environment is a big part of it and the neuro-associative conditioning; teaching people how to get rid of those old patterns, how to create new patterns. And it takes time. That's why the program has to be a month, sometimes longer than that and then you have to continue it on your own. If you don't, you'll go back to the old way again. But like I said, what I've taught here in about an hour is what I teach for a month at the school to help the people fulfill the great human potential that Yahweh's given us.

The last thing I just want to say is, people have fear sometimes and the greatest fear of humans is the fear of death. But death is not the worst thing that can happen to somebody. Death is natural. Death is just the last part of the life cycle. The worst thing way more than death, is to live life without purpose. That is way worse than death. So praise Yahweh, we don't have to do that. He's given us a life and we want to fulfill that life and we want to fill it to the greatest. So I encourage you from here to go out and fulfill your great human potential. Yahweh bless, Chag Semeach!
