

## TRANSCRIPTION – Bearing the Fruits of the Spirit

Alrighty, Shabbat Shalom again; and those who may be hearing this somewhere in the future we are here at our last Shabbat at the 2012 Ambassador for Israel Program.

So many people...that's the one thing I don't do, even with letters...I don't normally...I don't know why, but don't normally put dates on things; but I have had people tell me, in the past, they're watching an old sermon and it's saying we're going to have this meeting over here somewhere and they run there and it was from six years ago. So sometimes it's good to put a date that people know.

So again, we've been here and we've talked about the promises of Yahweh. We've talked about the redemption of man since the fall of Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden. We've talked about since sin came through man that redemption would also come from man. We've talked about due to faith and obedience to the Torah that Abraham's lineage was chosen for the Messiah to come through.

We talked about Yahshua that He was the confirmation of the promise made to Abraham in Genesis; and by repenting of sins, being immersed or baptized into the name of Yahshua, we are entering Covenant relationship with Yahweh; and having hands laid on us by an ordained elder we're literally receiving His free gift; forgiveness of sins, as well as the implanting of the Holy Spirit into us by the laying on of hands. And we're literally begotten by that Spirit into His family at that time, until the day that He returns and we'll literally be born into His family.

So today I want to talk about...from here we talked a lot about spiritual gifts...we've talked a lot about ministries and that kind of thing. I want to talk a little bit more in depth though about the Ruach H'Chodesh...I want to talk a little more in depth about Yahweh's gift of grace and what that means in our life.

As we're getting ready to walk out that door and Yahweh willing, make an impact on the four corners of the earth; I want to talk a little bit more about it now in a more spiritual sense. We physically...we sat here for weeks and went over all spiritual gifts; we went over the fruits of the Spirit; we went over what they mean. Then we went over the gifts of Spirit; each of us went over what gifts we have.

All of us put ministries together; we went over plan of actions for these ministries. But I want to get a little deeper into it because I want to show you the great manifestations that Scripture tells us can come from the Holy Spirit if we are in a position to accept it.

So interesting enough when you look at the word in the Bible for grace, in the Hebrew it's **chen...chen**, "*chet*", "*nun*", **chen**; in the New Testament it's **charis**, in the Greek. In the Hebrew its **chen** and the Greek its **charis** and literally means **divine graciousness, divine influence upon the heart and the reflection in the life**...which I always felt is extremely important in the definition.

Because when people think of Yahweh's grace, what they think of is just forgiveness. And yes, forgiveness is part of it; but it's *the divine influence upon the heart and the reflection in the life*. So like we've been saying **if there's no reflection in the life there's no grace.... the divine influence upon the heart and the reflection in the life**.

Now it's interesting enough that the word for *gift* is the same word. You know in the Hebrew, like we were saying, you can have for every Hebrew root you have a roughly a hundred and seventy one combinations that you can get verbs from that; and then every noun also comes from the same root.

We were learning that when you put the “vav” in the second position and you change this, then that it becomes...so interesting enough that the word, in both Greek and Hebrew again, both of them work together this way...that **the word for gift is the same word as the word for grace.**

So whenever you see that in Scripture, **Yahweh’s gift is His grace; His grace is His gift; they’re interchangeable.** And there’s many times where I think in the translations people are missing it; they’re missing of what its saying and they’re missing the ramifications that this brings. John 3 in verse 16:

**John 3:16-17** *For Yahweh so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that everyone believing into Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For YAHWEH did not send His Son into the world that He might condemn the world, but that the world might have life through Him.*

Is that Yahweh’s grace or is that Yahweh’s gift? Like we said, it’s both...it’s both; it’s His gift which is His grace. *For Yahweh so loved the world that He sent His only begotten Son that everyone believing into Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For YAHWEH did not send His Son into the world that He should condemn the world, but that the world might have life through Him.*

Just like we were saying in our Torah portion when we were going over the questions today, that in the first Covenant, this was only a hope; it wasn’t a reality. In the first Covenant it was a covenant of cause and effect. If you do this, I will do this; if you don’t do this, you’re going to get cursed this way.

**But now we have a way through the promise of the Brit Chadashah that we can literally, not only be forgiven, but we can have the penalty of our sins removed; and this is the grace of Yahweh and this is the gift of Yahweh; it’s the grace and the gift.**

Now what’s interesting about it is the Apostle Paul...same one we’re doing a lot of talking about...and like I said, for some people thinking that Paul is a heretic, Paul is this...Paul understood this better than anybody and why...because Paul was given the understanding of this message in a way that the apostles never were.

The apostles got a lot and they were with Yahshua for three years and there are a lot of important things they learned. But Paul, literally in his time with Yahshua, after Yahshua was resurrected, got it in a different way. Let’s go to Galatians 1...now it’s interesting that every message, every letter that Paul writes he starts the same way, except for the book of Hebrews...we’ve talked about that for a different reason...but every other epistle, letter, whatever you want to call it, starts:

**Galatians 1:1-4** *Paul, an apostle, not from men nor through man, but through Yahshua Messiah and Eloah the Father, the One raising Him from the dead, and all the brothers with me, to the assemblies of Galatia...so like we said when we were going over this in the epistles of Paul, like him, hate him, whatever; the bottom line is Paul is clearly showing my authority is coming from Heaven. Where’s yours coming from? So again, you want to reject him? Hey, everybody has a free will to do it. But nobody is going to sit here saying that Paul didn’t claim this...that Paul is being misinterpreted. No Paul’s making it very clear; he’s saying, “my authority is coming straight from Heaven.” And then in verse 3...*Grace to you and peace from YAHWEH the Father and the Master Yahshua Messiah...every single letter he starts the same way...Grace. He’s starting with the grace of Yahweh which is the gift of Yahweh... Grace to you and peace from YAHWEH the Father and the Master Yahshua Messiah who gave Himself for our sins, so that He might deliver us out of the present evil age, according to the will of our Elohim and Father.**

Paul also said many times when he preached and he said, “You know that I preach nothing to you except Messiah, Him be crucified.” I mean maybe to the point that people said, “okay, okay we get the idea. We understand it.” But because it is so pivotal now...because you know what...**every single thing that you learn,**

**everything that you're going to take from here...if you're not able to manifest it in a spiritual way, it's going to fail.**

Because what will happen is it'll become one of the two million works of men that's out there. So again, this is so important that we understand; this is kind of like the cherry on the cake. And yes, okay now we understand the fruits of the Spirit, we understand we need to bear fruit. We have our vision; we have our plan.

We know what Yahweh's Spirit has given us; but now we have to understand how to manifest this in the Spirit. **You have to understand how to manifest it in the Spirit;** because if you're going to bear spiritual fruit...if you're going to use these gifts in an un-natural, un-human way...in say a superhuman way, let's say...you're going to have to learn how to manifest the Spirit in your life. Go down to verse 9...

**Galatians 1:9-13** *As we have said before, and now I say again: If anyone preaches a good news beside what you received, let him be accursed. For do I now persuade men or Elohim? Or do I seek to please men? For if I yet pleased men, I would not be a slave of Messiah. And, brothers, I make known to you the good news preached by me, that it is not from man. Nor I did not receive it from man, nor was I taught it, but by a revelation of Yahshua Messiah. For you heard my way of life when I was in Judaism...let's see how far we go down here... For you heard my way of life when I was in Judaism how I followed and persecuted the Congregation of YAHWEH and greatly devastated it.*

So again, Paul is going to give us something that nobody else can give and he's going to give us something that he received directly from Yahshua. 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 8...2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 8:

**2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 8:1-4-8** *But, brothers, we make known to you **the grace**...remember wherever you see the grace, it's the gift...it's the gift. The grace or gift...of Elohim which has been given among the Congregations of Macedonia, that in much testing of trouble, the overflowing of their joy and the depth of their poverty abounded in the riches of their generosity. For I testify that according to their ability and beyond their ability, they willingly gave, with much entreating, begging us to receive of us **the gift, the grace** and the fellowship of the ministry of the saints...See once the Congregation started understanding this...once they understood that Paul had this special ability from Yahshua Himself that he was able to impart spiritual gifts on people...wow! They all wanted him to come...they all wanted it...they wanted it. They understood it; they knew this was something real just like we saw in that film we were watching. That the demons can sense when the Spirit of Yahweh was around; they shuttered. And it's the same way the Spirit of Yahweh, the people and the Spirit testifies against itself that we are children of Yahweh and the Spirit wanted this. So he says here... *with much entreating, begging us to receive of us **the gift, the grace** and the fellowship of the ministry of the saints. And not as we hoped, but they first gave themselves to our Master and to us through the will of Elohim, for us to call on Titus, that even as he began before, so also he might complete this **gift** to you also. But even as you abound in everything, in faith, and in word, and in knowledge, and in earnestness, and in your love in us, that you also should abound in this **gift**. For I do not speak according to command, but through the earnestness of others and testing the sincerity of your love.**

So today I want to give this gift. I want to share with you this gift because I want you to take this gift with you...not to keep in a box somewhere...I want you **to take the gift I'm going to share with you today and bring it to every soul on earth you meet.** 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 4:1...go back...or 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 2...because again there's a reason why Yahweh says not to put earrings on dogs or throw your pearls before swine.

There's a reason why He says that; not that He's against dogs or swine, but **He's saying you don't want to take something that's precious...something that's sanctified...something that's set-apart for the highest purpose on the earth and let defiled, immoral people destroy it.** So I'm going to read here from

Corinthians 2, because we're going to see that **this gift that you're going to have will be life-changing to anybody in your life that you meet**; but to the people who are the defiled...to the people that are the dogs and the swine and everything else...don't throw your pearls before swine and don't put earrings on dogs.

**Take this gift as the most precious thing in your life. Take it as something that you have that can change the life of any single person on this planet that you're going to meet and really, really cherish that as something that you don't want to be defiled.** So look what he says:

**1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 2:1-16** *And, when I came I came to you, my Brethren, I did not preach to you the mystery of Elohim in magnificent speech, nor in wisdom...and we're going to see exactly what he means by this...because you know what the mystery of Elohim is? The gift! **The mystery of Elohim is the gift** that I'm going to give you today. So he's going to show that this is the mystery. He says...For I decided not to know anything among you except Yahshua Messiah, and Him having been crucified...remember keys to the Kingdom? What's the very first key? **Matthew 16** right? Got to have that first key because you're not going to get in the door without the key...remember keys give access. **Without this key you can't receive the gift because to get the gift you have to be in the door; and to be in the door you have to be able to have the key to access...***And I was with you in much reverence for Elohim, and in much trembling. And my word and my preaching was not in enticing words of human wisdom, but with the demonstration of the Spirit, and with power; that your faith might not be in the wisdom of men, but in the power of Elohim...*So again there's a lot of wisdom of men out there; there's a lot of nonsense; there's a lot of people on the internet and all this other stuff. You don't want to go down that road...you don't want to go down that road that's going to take you away from this gift...to take you away from the door to get in there... *that your faith might not be in the wisdom of men, but in the power of Elohim. But we speak wisdom among those who have comprehension, but not the wisdom of this age, nor of the rulers of this age, those being brought to nothing. But we speak the wisdom of Elohim in a mystery...*and this is what we're going to get into; we're going to unravel this mystery today...*having been hidden, which Elohim ordained before the world for our glory, which none of the rulers of this age have known. For if they have known, they would not have crucified the Master of glory; according as it has been written, "Eye has not seen, and ear has not heard," nor has it risen up into the heart of man, the things which Elohim has prepared for those who love Him. But Elohim revealed them to us by His Spirit, for the Spirit searches all things, even the depths of Elohim...*so **without the Spirit of Elohim you can't get the gift of Elohim**; because they're very, very deep things and we're going to see the ones who don't have that Spirit, this is all foolishness to them...*For who among men knows the things of man, except the spirit of a man within him? So also no one has known the things of Elohim except the Spirit of Elohim. But we have not received the spirit of the world, but the Spirit from Elohim, so that we might know the things that are freely given to us by Elohim. For the things which we discuss, are not dependent on the knowledge of words and man's wisdom, but on the teaching of the Holy Spirit...the Ruach H'Chodesh...thus explaining spiritual things with the spiritual minded. But the material man rejects the things of the Spirit, for they are foolishness to him, and he is not able to know them, because they are spiritually discerned. But the spiritual man discerns everything, and yet no man is able to discern him. For "Who has known the mind of YAHWEH that he will instruct Him?"...that's why they said to Yahshua, "Who is He? Where did He come from? How does He know these things without learning lessons?"... the spiritual man discerns everything, and yet no man is able to discern him...why? Because they're not spiritual...For "Who has known the mind of YAHWEH that he will instruct Him? "But we have the mind of Messiah.**

So again to most people in the world, like it says here saying these things and it would probably been like King Agrippa with Festus saying, "Don, you're mad with all your learning!" But **to spiritually minded people, this is life. This is the key that's opening up that door to say; wow; now everything that I've learned is all**

**clicking and now I know how to take it out...now I know how to use it.** 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 4 in verse 1, he says:

**1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 4:1** *This is the way that you should consider us; as servants of Messiah and stewards of the mysteries of Elohim...*

That's what he says as the elders; *that the elders literally are the servants of Messiah and stewards of the mysteries of Elohim* and that's why the mystery that Yahshua set out to the apostles and to Paul and they went on to Polycarp and the other leaders then and then Polycrates and then to the Paulicians and then to Bogomils and then to the Waldenses and the Sabbati and all the other ones in the wilderness; to the Anabaptists and the ones coming over to America and now to us; because Yahweh always had servants of Messiah who were stewards of the mystery of Elohim.

So again when you go to a Congregation and they don't have the mysteries of Elohim when they're teaching you that the dead are up in Heaven and they're teaching you that you don't need baptism and they're teaching you all these other...Sunday is the day of worship...they're certainly not a steward of Yahshua Messiah. They don't have the mysteries of Elohim.

Those are the mysteries of the universal church. There are a lot of mysteries we can over from Catholicism too. Constantine started it, but there were a lot of other mysteries that they have there. But we don't want to know those mysteries; those are things that Paul said, "You don't even want to talk about in private the things that these people do." We want to talk about the mysteries of Elohim. Romans 16...Romans 16 in verse 25 he says:

**Romans 16:25-26** *but now has been made plain, and by prophetic Scriptures, according to the command of the everlasting Elohim, has made known for obedience of faith to all the nations; For Elohim is the only wise one and to Him be the glory through Yahshua Messiah forever and ever.*

So like we said, **the Old Covenant was the mystery of the Messiah concealed and now the New Covenant is the mystery of Messiah revealed.** Colossians 1...Colossians 1 in verse 24...Colossians 1 in verse 24:

**Colossians 1:24-29** *and now rejoice in my sufferings on your behalf and fill up in my flesh the things lacking of the afflictions of Messiah on behalf of His body, which is the Congregation, of which I became a minister, according to the stewardship of Elohim given to me for you, to preach the Word of Elohim everywhere, even the mystery having been hidden from the ages and from the generations, but now is revealed to His saints; to whom YAHWEH willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the nations, which is Messiah in you, the hope of glory; Him we preach, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may cause every man to become perfect in Messiah Yahshua, to this end I also labor, struggling according to the working of Him who works in me in power.*

And here's the mystery...here's the mystery that started in the Garden of Eden with one man, who was being taught to be a priest of Yahweh, to go out and teach Yahweh's character; to teach Yahweh's judicial order, to teach Yahweh's Torah. But this mystery turned...it turned and it went from one human being who failed to millions of human beings who succeeded.

Like we said, Adam was a living soul, but Yahshua became a life-giving Spirit... Adam was a living soul, but Yahshua became a life-giving Spirit. And here's the mystery, **the mystery is the oneness of Yahweh.** How on earth can Yahweh and Yahshua be One?

But in the Hebrew we know that mystery is unrevealed; because They are echad...**They are echad; They are united; They are One in thought, They are One in mind, They are One in Spirit; They're completely One; because there's only one Spirit.**

And like we said, it's like the mind...if any one of us...each one of us thinks differently...if any one of us took the mind of us and put it in each of us; it would be thirty Don's, thirty Adrian's, thirty Sharon's; because your mind is the thing that makes you think. And Yahweh literally, **the same Spirit Romans 8, that's in the Messiah is the same Spirit that's literally in us today...literally in us today through Covenant relationship, through baptism and the laying on of hands. It's living in you and Satan's biggest victory is the people of Yahweh are not realizing it...they're not realizing it. They're not realizing that Yahshua said, "Greater works you will do than Me" because there's hundreds of thousands, if not millions, of His Spirit being in people all over the world.**

And literally, **if you can surrender...if you can give up your way...you can give up your mind...you can give up your thought pattern and never have a thought of your own again...you will fulfill this Great Commission that Yahweh's given.**

See the problem is whenever something comes up, like I said, if someone walked in the door and he's wearing a police uniform, right away we get something in our mind, "was someone robbed? Is there a problem? Is he after me?" You know whatever it is somethings coming in your mind. **We have to learn what to do is to wait for the Holy Spirit.** Why think about what he's doing there, when the Holy Spirit will tell you?

**If you surrender your will of you, the Holy Spirit is living in you; it will take over! It will tell you what to do; it will tell you what to eat.** Remember Yahshua said, "I will send the Comforter and He will lead you into all truth." But the problem is I found the enemy and the enemy is me; **each of us is our own worst enemy.** We are not surrendering to Yahweh and **if you don't surrender to Yahweh, this will never come.**

The mystery of the Good News, like I said, that's foolishness to the world...what on earth is he talking about...he's rattling, he babbling; but to the spiritual minded person, this is life. Not just life now, this is life eternal. And if you can just learn...that's why **we have to learn to discipline our flesh...because when you discipline your flesh, the Spirit can take over.**

But if you don't discipline your flesh, what's going to happen? The flesh is always going to be acting first and the Spirit is always going to be left behind. But **when we discipline our self and we have patience then we are allowing the Spirit to go before us...we're not just arbitrarily making decisions without the Holy Spirit leading us.**

And He says, "This is it." Messiah Yahshua, the One we worship, the One you pray to. **The One that every one of us has been immersed in His name is literally living inside of you; which means He is a part of you; He is one with you; He is you...if you surrender you...if you surrender you.** Let's go to John 17...lest you think I'm mad...because this is exactly the Oneness Yahshua talked about. He didn't talk about the trinity...He didn't talk about the Pentecostal Oneness doctrine...He talked about the true Echad of the Father and the Son...John 17:

**John 17:1-14** *Yahshua spoke these things and lifted up His eyes to Heaven, and said, Father, the hour has come. Glorify Your Son, that Your Son may also glorify You, as You gave to Him authority over all flesh, so that to all which You gave to Him, He may give to them everlasting life. And this is everlasting life, that they may know You, the Elohim of truth, and Yahshua Messiah, whom You have sent...two beings there...I have glorified You on the earth. I finished the work that You gave Me to do. And now Father, glorify Me with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the existence of the world...again, two...I revealed Your*

*name to the men whom You gave to Me out of the world. They were Yours, and You gave them to Me; and they have kept Your Word. Now they have known that everything that you have given to me I have given to them and received from them. And they know that I have truly proceeded from your presence, and they believe that You have sent me...again, two...I pray concerning them; I do not pray concerning the world, but concerning the ones whom You gave to Me, because they are Yours. And all things are Yours, and Yours are Mine; and I have been glorified in them. And no longer am I in the world, yet these are in the world; and I come to You. Holy Father, keep them in Your name...Congregation of YAHWEH...those whom You gave to Me, that they may be echad, they may be united, as We are united. While I was with them in the world, I kept them in Your name; I guarded those whom You gave to Me, and not one of them was lost, except the son of perdition, that the Scripture might be fulfilled...He guarded them. He protected them because they stayed in the camp...And now I come to You, and I speak these things in the world, that they may have My joy being fulfilled in them. I have given them Your Word, and the world hated them because they are not of the world, as I am not of the world.*

**You're going to go out here and when you bring this message, it's powerful; but as we saw with Apostle Paul, it's not going to be freely accepted. And depending where you are, you may get arrested and you may get stoned and you may get beaten and you may even have to give up your life.**

But praise YAHWEH, like I said, **don't fear man who can take your physical life; fear Him who can take your soul and put in Gehenna fire. So all man can do is bring you to do is bring you to the Kingdom quicker.** That's all he can do. He has no authority over you. **Satan has no authority over you.** And if they want to take this burned out piece of hunk of a body, they can have it. Because all they've done is put me that much quicker in the Kingdom because it's the blink of an eye. So we don't fear man because there's nothing man can do to us...verse 14:

**John 17:14-20** *I have given them Your Word, and the world hated them because they are not of the world, as I am not of the world. I do not pray that You take them out of the world, but that You keep them from the evil. They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. Sanctify them in Your Truth; Your Word is Truth...how important is doctrine? It's everything.* You either have the doctrine of Messiah or you have the doctrine of the devil. There's only two elohim's in this world. One is the elohim of this system who is Satan; and one is the only true Elohim which is Yahweh. And we have free choice who will we serve? ... *Sanctify them in Your Truth; Your Word is Truth. As You have sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world, And I fear for their sakes. I sanctify myself so that they may also be sanctified by Truth. And I do not pray concerning these only, but also concerning those who will believe in Me through their word...and here we are two thousand years later, people are still coming to the Truth. There's been no human being on the face of humanity that has made more of an impact in this world than Yahshua Messiah.* Nobody ever born has made more of an impact...verse 20...

**John 17:20-24** *And I do not pray concerning these only, but also concerning those who will believe in Me through their word that all may be echad, all may be united, as You are in Me Father and I in You, that they also may be echad in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me. And I have given them the glory which You have given Me, that they may be echad, united, as We are united: I in them, and You in Me, that they may be perfected in one; and that the world may know that You sent Me and loved them, even as You loved Me. Father, those whom You have given to me, I desire that where I am they might also be with me that they might see my glory that you have given to me because you have loved me from before the foundations of the world.*

This is the oneness; it's not some kind of crazy "shell game" trinity that's going on. **Yahshua says, Father I in You and You in Me and Us in them.** So there goes the whole Pentecostal Oneness out the window; because

we're certainly not all one being, but we should be one spirit. We should be united in purpose, united in love, united in goal.

And I think...I pray and I think from everything you've said, I think that each of you have gotten a little taste of the Kingdom of Yahweh. A little experience to see that when you bring a bunch of **people together with a common purpose and you surrender to each other...Yahweh first**, because it would make no difference if we surrender to each other if we're not surrendering to Yahweh because we all think differently...you see that **this is what the Kingdom of Yahweh is about.**

It's the way the marriage relationship is supposed to be...which again, is a relationship that Yahweh gives us to understand the relationship of the Father and the Son; and it's a relationship we're supposed to have with each other and it is the mystery of the Good News; Messiah in you, the hope of glory.

Because He is One; He isn't double-minded, He doesn't change; Yahshua Messiah, the same yesterday, today and forever. **So that Spirit that's in you, if you could just allow yourself to die, that the Spirit will live!** And it may sound simple, but it is a hard dog-fight and you have to focus on it every day of your life.

It's not something you're just going to do once; it's not something that you're going to learn. **It's something you have to have to experience; it's a mindset you have to get and it's a mindset that you're going to have to know every day of your life you wake up you are going to have a dog-fight with the devil.**

And again, if you are echad with Yahweh, at the end of the day you're always going to bed with a smile on your face. **You have to allow that Spirit to lead you. You have something in you that is the most powerful gift in the world...**it's the most powerful gift in the world.

So now, Yahshua healed the sick, He raised the dead, He walked on water, He cast out demons, He was translated from one spot to another, He commanded the weather and it listened to Him, multiplied food and then He said in John 14...lets go back to John 14 in verse 12...John 14 in verse 12:

**John 14:12-15** *Indeed, I tell you truly, the one believing into Me, the works which I do, that one shall do also, and greater than these he will do, because I go to the Father. And whatever you may ask in My name, this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it. If you love Me, keep My commandments.*

Now, has anybody ever asked something to Yahweh and not been a hundred percent confident that it was going to be fulfilled? We've all said it...I mean it's everyone's...why would that be...**because the only way it wouldn't be fulfilled if it wasn't in the will of Yahweh.**

I did a good message last year saying, *Watch What You Pray For...*you know and I was showing how sometimes people will ask for prayers for their unconverted relatives and say, "let's pray for so and so, that Yahweh would open up their mind." I can't pray for that. Number one, it would be going against Yahweh because Yahweh gives each of us free will. I would be praying against the free will and the Bible also says in **John 6:44, No man can come to Me unless the Father draws him.**

So who am I to tell Yahweh who to call? He knows every person. I don't have to remind of this. No again, I can tell Him to have mercy on my family; I can tell Him to help me to better witness if He's going to use me; but who am I to tell Him to call this?

And I showed him the sermon that Hezekiah...when Hezekiah was thirty-nine years old and Yahweh said he was a pretty righteous King. And He said to Hezekiah, "get your stuff together, you're ready to die." And what did Hezekiah do? He pleaded to Yahweh, "please, please don't take my life." And Yahweh said, "Okay, I'll give

you fifteen more years.” And in those fifteen years he had a son called, Asa, who had a son called, Manasseh. His grandson who wound up being the most wicked King that Israel ever knew.

So does Yahweh know better than us? So when we’re looking what Yahshua is saying here, “Whatever you ask in My name, I’ll do. Did Yahshua ever have to doubt? No, why? Because Yahshua lost Him! **Matthew 26:39, “Father not as My will be done, but Your will be done.”**

**If you can lose yourself...if you can no other aspiration in that mind...if you could let everything of that mind go, except the Spirit of Yahweh, than you’ll never doubt when you ask something.** You will absolutely never doubt.

And I’m telling you when you look at these...I ask people if Yahshua said *greater works than this...* and He’s raising the dead and healing the sick, commanding the weather...has anybody ever seen these kind of things?

When I go to America, people they either say, “why aren’t we seeing the power of Yahweh,” or they say, “Well that was only for Bible times.” That’s another theory...”well that was for them for this reason, but those miracles aren’t happening today.”

And I can tell you assuredly, in this very Land, I’ve seen every one of these miracles happen; including the raising of the dead more than once; and I don’t mean someone that was just dead for a few minutes. I mean sometimes for people who have been dead for more than a day, in a box, completely dead; already signed death certificates and they were prayed over and came back to life.

So these miracles are real; whether it’s casting out demons, healing the sick, any kind of prayer that you can imagine because **Yahshua said, “Whatever works I did, greater works than this you can do.”** And that’s **why we need to understand the works of the flesh and the works of the Spirit; because you got to put to death the works of the flesh for the Spirit to live. You have to put them to death.**

And like I said, **our biggest fight is with our self**; because we...you know it’s a great time to be me. It’s true, but that’s why I got to kill me! I can’t kill you. There’s only one person you can kill and get away with it according to Torah; and that’s your human nature. You’re never going to have a death penalty on you if you kill your human nature. You have to kill the flesh to let the Spirit live. Galatians 5:22...we’ll start in verse 16:

**Galatians 5:16-23** *But I say this, if you walk in the Spirit, the lust of the flesh will not overtake you. For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are opposed to one another; so you are not able to do as you desire...* and that’s why I say, first lesson I learned, the first year in the school, **environment is ninety percent of your battle. We’re flesh and we can’t overcome our flesh on our own; and if you put yourself in the wrong environment, you’ve just got a ninety percent chance of failing.** And **this is life and death**; it’s not just about doing something a little better...this is life and death. There are times that Yahweh will put us in enemy territory because we’re there for a mission; but we want to overall...you want to set an environment overall in your life that’s conducive to be able to walk in the Spirit. **Satan is a roaring lion walking around whoever he may devour...and believe me when I say it, he will devour each of us if we give him the opportunity. The way we keep him out of our life is putting that hedge around our life. So your environment is extremely important...** *For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are opposed to one another; so you are not able to do as you desire. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under (the penalty of the breaking) of the Torah. Now the works of the flesh are clearly revealed, which are: adultery, impurity, uncleanness, lustfulness, idolatry, witchcraft, enmity, fighting, jealousies, anger, rivalries, stubbornness, divisions, heresies, envies...it’s there twice...murders, drunkenness, reveling, and all things like these; of which I said beforehand, as I said before, that the ones practicing such*

*things will not inherit the kingdom of Elohim. But the fruit of the Spirit is: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faith, meekness, self-control. Against such things there is no instruction.*

There is no instruction against those nine fruits of the Spirit; because those are the things that are going to crucify your flesh so that the Spirit can live. You know Yahweh is not barren; every one of us have fruits that He's given us and those fruits are waiting, like it says in **Romans 8**, *the creation is waiting for the manifestation of the sons of Yahweh*. He's simply waiting for us to prepare for His Kingdom to come. 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 15...we'll see that the gift of Yahweh literally transformed the life of the Apostle Paul...1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 15:9 and 10 he says:

**1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 15:9-10** *For I am the least of the apostles, who am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the Congregation of YAHWEH. But by the gift of Elohim, His grace, His gift, I am what I am, and His gift, His grace which was toward me has not been without fruit, but I labored more abundantly than all of them, yet not I, but the gift of Elohim within me.*

So again, we all came from somewhere, right? We all know what we were...we're trying to forget it and that's what Paul said, "I do this one thing, putting those things behind and looking forward, pressing toward the mark." But he says it was the gift of Yahweh within him that transformed him from this evil, wicked, Yahweh-hater, into the greatest apostle that was out there.

Colossians 2...Colossians 2...because let's start looking into now how this gift can change each of our lives...by having this gift manifested...let's look at some of the supernatural things that you can accomplish now. Because like I said, we all understand now the Holy Spirit gives to each of us liberally as it sees fit and each of know what those gifts are He gave us. So how can we manifest those gifts in a better way? Colossians 2:

**Colossians 2:1-7** *For I want you to know how great a struggle I have concerning you, and those in Laodicea, and as many as have not seen my face in the flesh, that their hearts may be comforted, being joined together in love, and to all riches of the full assurance of the understanding, to the full knowledge of the mystery of Elohim...here we are again. We already know what that mystery is now...even of the Father and of the Messiah...Messiah in you, the hope of glory. **John 17, I in You and You in Me and Us in them; this is the great mystery now that He is literally living in us. He's not just someone we're praying to. He's not a High Priest that's far away in the Heavens, but He's literally living inside of you ...in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and of knowledge. And I say this that no one may beguile you with persuasive words. For though I am indeed absent in the flesh, yet I am with you in the spirit...**I'm absent in the flesh with you in the spirit...rejoicing and seeing your order and the firmness of your faith in Messiah. Therefore, just as you accepted Messiah Yahshua our Master, so you must be led by Him, being rooted and being built up in Him, and being confirmed in the faith, even as you were taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving.*

So again, we're flesh right? That's the battle we're fighting. Is Yahweh flesh? No! Yahweh's omnipotent; Yahweh is everywhere. So now **through your gift, you have the ability to be anywhere in the world.** Remember what we were talking about when we talked about time vs. eternity? That if you were traveling almost at the speed of light, you can go to a star that's two hundred light years away and then you can return, what seems like a day, and everybody would be two hundred years older.

So this is the same way here. See **we're limiting our self in the flesh because we're flesh. You have the ability to transcend that.** Let me read it again... *For though I am indeed absent in the flesh, yet I am with you in the spirit.* Paul was using the gift to literally transform himself.

You ever have somebody...you hear about a situation and say, "oh I wish I was there?" Be there! Get on your hands and knees, go into your prayer closet, start praying to Yahweh, and put yourself in that spot! And they can feel the presence with them because there's one Spirit; and the same Spirit is in me is the same Spirit in you and the same Spirit in you.

We're allowing the flesh to block our way from the Spirit; and Paul understood this. Believe me; he understood it because there were no airplanes in that day. And **he understood that he can transcend time, space and matter when he needed to; the same way Yahweh could.** That he could pray to that Spirit that's in him because it's the same Spirit that's in Yahweh, the same Spirit that's in Yahshua and **he can transcend that Spirit somewhere else to give comfort; to give a word of wisdom; to give a word of encouragement, to who? To whoever else is yielding to the Spirit!**

Why does it say that when I don't know what to pray **the Holy Spirit intervenes with words that cannot be uttered? Because I don't know what to say, but somebody else somewhere may be praying for that and all of a sudden as I'm yielding my fleshly way, the Holy Spirit is able to give me that word. This is the unity of the Body; this is the way that all of us are interconnected to each other.**

And this is what shows you, **Proverbs 18:1**, *he who separates himself, seeks his own desire.* The person who's off on his own that wants nothing to be connected to the Body of Messiah; he's going nowhere quick. **We need each other; we're connected to each other.**

So as we leave here tomorrow, we're not really leaving each other. When you hear from each other if there's a problem, if there's distress, if someone needs you; **you literally can intercede on their behalf; and not just that way, but even physically.** Let me show you...Galatians 6...we can do it spiritually, we know that, that's evident; because Yahweh's Spirit is omnipotent...and I'm going to show you, you can even do it physically...Galatians 6 verse 1:

**Galatians 6:1-6** *Brothers, if any man among you goes before you in error, you who are in the Spirit...okay so now it's back to the gift...restore him by the spirit of gentleness and beware, lest temptation also come upon you. And you carry the excess load of one another, and thus complete yourself in the instruction of Messiah. For if anyone thinks to be something, he deceives himself, being nothing. But let each one examine his own work, and then let him glory to himself and not among others. For each one will bear his own normal daily load. But let the one being taught in the Word, share with the one teaching, in all good things.*

So again, each of us has our daily load to bear; but he says over here in verse 2, *and you carry the excess load of one another, and thus complete yourself in the instruction of Messiah.* And I have literally seen it; **I have seen where people have been in pain that they couldn't take and I've done it myself and you pray to the Father because there's one Spirit; and you pray to Him to take person's pain away and literally the pain from that person will come to you.**

I've seen it...I've seen it myself...I've seen many other people do it; that literally you can take pain away from another human being by doing this. Like he says, **we pray to carry the excess load of one another.** Other times we do it physically by...you know some here have the gift of helps...sometimes you do it by utilizing that gift. We can do it through prayer, we can do it through helps, we can do it through many ways.

But literally, **we have the ability through the gift to have eyes to see and literally to help each other.** Help each other with physical pain, to help each other to get through things that we might not have got through before. 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 1 in verse 3...2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 1 in verse 3 says:

**2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 1:3-7** *Blessed be the Elohim and Father of our Master Yahshua Messiah, the Father of compassions and Elohim of all comfort, the One comforting us on all our affliction, for us to be able to comfort those in every affliction, through the comfort by which we ourselves are comforted by Elohim. Because even as the sufferings of Messiah abound in us, so also our comfort abounds through Messiah. But if we are troubled, it is for your comfort and salvation...if we are troubled, it is for your comfort and salvation...being worked out in the endurance of the same sufferings which we also suffer. If we are comforted, it is for your comfort and salvation; and our hope for you is certain, knowing that even as you are sharers of the sufferings, so also are partakers of the comfort.*

**When one man suffers, we all suffer; when one feels joy, we all feel joy.** And literally through prayer we can bring this to each other...verse 8...

**2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 1:8-11** *For, brothers, we do want you to know as to our affliction having happened to us in Asia, that we were excessively oppressed beyond our strength...now this is Paul saying this...we were excessively oppressed beyond our strength so as for us to even be despaired for our lives. And we decided to die, not trusting on ourselves, but on YAHWEH, the One raising the dead, who rescued us from so great a peril of death, and does rescue; in whom we have hope that He will still deliver us, you also laboring together for us in prayer, that the **gracious gift** by many persons be the cause of thanks-giving through many for us.*

Wow! So here he's saying it's the same way that when you have a team going out, a mission team, right? Sure maybe one person or a few people are literally going out, but **everybody in the Congregation is part of it.** And the Congregation that's praying, they're praying for things that they're not even sure what to pray for; but that's why there's one Spirit. **The Spirit will intercede and tell you what to pray for.**

And then when you're out there in the field you may not even know that you just got through a deathly situation because somebody else was praying for you. And at times like Paul is saying...here's Paul saying that they were so despaired almost unto death and the prayers of the people that were interceding with them was what got them through it.

So again, we really...you have to understand not just the physical aspect of the gifts that Yahweh's given you...you have to understand the spiritual aspect. You have to understand what it literally means to yield to the Spirit of Yahweh; to let the Ruach H'Chodesh...to yield your human spirit to His earthly Spirit.

One thing we should not intercede though...1<sup>st</sup> John...the only thing we should not pray for while we're interceding...1<sup>st</sup> John 5 verse 14 he says:

**1<sup>st</sup> John 5:14-16** *And this is the confidence we have toward Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He will hear us...just like we said...And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him. If anyone sees his brother sinning a sin not unto death, he shall ask; and He shall give life to him, to the ones not sinning unto death. There is a sin unto death. I do not say that he should ask about that one.*

So clearly, if somebody is struggling, if somebody is trying to overcome...yes, we can intercede of their behalf. We could help them through addiction, we can help them through sorrow, we can help them through death; but somebody who's committed the unpardonable sin; **somebody who has turned back on Yahweh; has completely gone in the other direction...he says don't pray for them; because now you're blaspheming the Holy Spirit because this person willingly has made that decision to turn back on Yahweh.** And you would literally be praying against that person's free will which would be against the Spirit of Yahweh.

So that's why I say, it's a great responsibility being echad with Yahweh; but **to make it manifest you have to stay echad with Yahweh**. You can't let your feelings, you can't let your...that's why I say in this Oprah Winfrey world we live in when everybody has an opinion...it really don't make a difference. My opinion don't matter and your opinion don't matter. **The only thing that matters is Yahweh's opinion; what Yahweh says.** And that's why **our whole point is trying to surrender our will, surrender our nature and allow Him to work.**

Another thing that happens through the gift of Yahweh...another miracle...Acts 8 in verse 34...this is with Philip and the eunuch...and Peter said to him...oh I'm in 9...8 to verse 34:

**Acts 8:34-40** *And that faithful one said to Philip, I ask you, about whom does the prophet say this? About himself, or about some other one? And Phillip opening his mouth, began to preach from the scripture concerning our Master Yahshua. And as they were going along the highway they came to some water. And that faithful one said, Behold, water! What prevents me to be baptized? And Philip said, If you believe from all the heart, it is lawful. And answering he said, I believe Yahshua Messiah to be the Son of YAHWEH. And he commanded the chariot to stand still. And both went down into the water, both Philip and the faithful one and he baptized him. And when they came up out of the water, the Spirit of YAHWEH caught away Philip. And that faithful one did not see him anymore; for he went his way rejoicing. And Philip was found at Azotus. And passing through he preached the good news to all the cities until he came to Caesarea.*

So literally even, **even physically being able to go from one place to another is not limited by being in a fleshly body**. We know that this happened to Yahshua; we know it happened to Philip; we know it happened to Paul; we know it happened to even Elijah in the first covenant. So again it's not just going to happen for fun; it's not like Star Trek...you know beam me up Scottie...**but when you need to go from one place to another and it's within the will of Yahweh, you could easily have it done**...you could easily have it done. **We have to believe it though...we have to not only believe it. We have to anticipate it...we have to be ready for it. We have to be ready that Yahweh can fulfill His will anyway He sees fit.** Matthew 21 in verse 18:

**Matthew 21:18-22** *And returning early to the city, He hungered. And seeing one fig tree by the road, He went to it, and found nothing on it except leaves only. And He said to it, Let there be no more fruit from you forever. And the fig tree immediately dried up. And seeing, the disciples marveled, saying, How quickly the fig tree is dried up! And answering, Yahshua said to them, Truly I say to you, If you have faith and do not doubt, not only will you do the miracle of the fig tree, but even if you should say to this mountain, Be taken up and thrown into the sea, it will be so. And all things, whatever you may ask in prayer, believing, you shall receive.*

So again, we have to believe this...**you have to believe in faith when you're out there that Yahweh is going to back you no matter what the situation may be**. We know that Yahshua even controlled the weather and we know that Yahweh can control the weather. And there are times that weather will affect us in our travels.

I remember many, many moons ago, I think it was the first time ever I met Kim actually and we were going to Colorado or we were going to New Mexico from Colorado and I forget the name of that pass in that mountain...it was called like Dead Man's Pass or something...it's a mountain that you go from Colorado to New Mexico and wow, there was no guard rail and I mean it was just a little road. And the person I was with, they had a car that was like twenty years old and with bald tires and a snow storm started.

And there was no way we were going to get out there. And they were expecting like three feet of snow and we just said, "Look Yahweh commissioned us. There are people down there waiting for us. Let's just pray." And I prayed for the snow to stop and within about fifteen minutes, the snow stopped. And everywhere we went;

every time we'd stop for gas, every time we stopped somewhere, they'd say "wow, you're lucky! You know they were predicting three feet of snow and out of nowhere it just stopped!" And we said, "No, not out of nowhere."

Like we said, the home office knows. **Don't be afraid to ask for anything if it's in the will of Yahweh. If He's sending you somewhere; if He's commissioned you somewhere. You want to make sure that you are believing all things.** Mark 6...another thing I think that we forget...Mark 6 in verse 4:

**Mark 6:4-6** *And Yahshua said to them, There is no prophet who is dishonored except in his own city in his own kinsmen in his own house. And He could do no work of power there, except He performed healing on a few infirm ones laying on His hands. And He marveled because of their unbelief. And He went around the villages in a circuit, teaching.*

He healed some infirm ones laying on His hands. If you go to Luke 4 in verse 40:

**Luke 4:40** *And the sun sinking, all, as many as had sick ones with various diseases, brought them to Him. And laying hands on each one of them, He healed them.*

Laying hands on each of them, He healed them. Acts 28...Acts 28 in verse 7:

**Acts 28:7-8** *And there were lands in that quarter, belonging to a man named Publius, who was the chief man of the islands: And he cheerfully received us at his house three days. And it happened the father of Publius was lying down, suffering from fevers and dysentery; to whom Paul, entering and praying, laying on his hands, cured him.*

**If the Holy Spirit is dwelling in you, there's a power that comes in the hands...**there's a power. Like I said, we knew some brethren that had ministries of healing and they would say whenever there was someone that needed healing they'd feel it...they'd feel their hands would get warm...they'd get hot, that somebody needs healing.

So again, we know from Jacob 5 verse 13...Jacob 5 in verse 13 says:

**Jacob 5:13-15** *Does anyone suffer ill among you? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him praise in song. Is any among you sick? Let him call the elders of the Congregation, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of our Master. And the prayer of faith will heal those being sick, and our Master will raise him up. And if any have committed sins, it will be forgiven him.*

So we know that **only elders should be anointing with oil.** We went over this before; oil is something that's special ceremony for anointing the sick and it's also for ordaining an elder. We know that in the Old Testament times it was for also anointing the kings. So we know there's a specific purpose for oil. So only elders would go out with oil; but **it doesn't mean that only elders can pray for people.**

**In all of us have a power in our hands.** So you could go out with someone and you could hold their hands or you could hug them and you could pray for them. And I'm telling you **there is a power that the Holy Spirit gives each of us in this regard.**

Yahweh hears the prayers of the saints; and we know that. And **there is power in prayer and there's power that each of us have for our prayers to be heard. So we want to make sure we're using that.**

On the other end I will mention, **be very careful because the laying of hands is powerful because Yahweh transfers His Spirit through laying on of hands. It's a transferring that's being done, but also demonic things can be transferred.** So you don't want to be touching...**you don't want to be holding hands with**

**people you don't know or people that you suspect could have a bad spirit;** because again, there's a transferring that goes on.

But as far as in general, don't neglect this gift...don't neglect the gift that you can be praying for someone and just touching their shoulder, hugging them, holding their hand, whatever. And there we see over and over from Scripture there are power in the hands...there's power that goes out in the hands. John 4...I'll be ending up here in a few minutes...John 4...we also see this in the first Covenant and the second Covenant that also through the gift of the Holy Spirit that one can supernaturally go long periods of time without food and water...John 4:

**John 4:1-2, 6, 13-14** *Now the Pharisees had heard that Yahshua made many disciples and was baptizing more than John (though truly Yahshua Himself did not baptize, but His disciples)...and then He comes to Samaria to the well...in verse 6...And there was there a spring of water that had belonged to Jacob, and Yahshua was tired from the fatigue of the journey. And He sat on the well, and it was the sixth hour...and then we know the woman comes out to Him and look what Yahshua says in verse 13...Yahshua answered and said to her, Everyone drinking of this water will thirst again; But everyone who drinks from the waters that I give to him will not thirst forever. But those waters that I give to him will become in him a spring of water that will spring up into life that is eternal.*

So we know it...we know it from Yahshua, we know it from John the Baptist, we know it from Moses that **at times Yahweh has given, through His gift of His Spirit, supernatural strength to go long periods of time; even more than a month, forty days...** Moses did forty days, came down and then did another forty days **without food and water**. So it's something else that **if we're in that situation, if we're out in the wilderness, if we don't have food; we don't have to worry; Yahweh's Spirit can supersede that.**

So again, there is a great power within Yahweh's gift. It's a mystery to the world, but it's not a mystery to us; because we understand and we know it; it's living in us. That Spirit opens up our mind to His Truth. But we also know as we talked about many times...I won't read again if you're taking notes, you can put **John 15:1-17...we do know that we do have to take responsibility for the gift of Yahweh by bearing fruit.**

And like He says that everyone who is bearing fruit, He will prune, so you bear more fruit; but the ones who are not bearing any fruit He will take the Spirit away. Romans 3...**Romans 3**...I won't go there either, but it talks about everyone is a sinner; everyone has fallen short of the glory of Yahweh. You know that all of us are defiled and unrighteous before we come to faith and that only through the blood of the Son can we experience this gift; only through repenting of our sins and full faith in Yahweh can we get this gift of His Spirit.

And then of course Paul ends the chapter beautifully by saying, **"By the gift of Yahweh's Spirit does it make void the Torah? Absolutely not; it establishes the Torah."** 1 Corinthians 3...I will go there...I'll start in verse 16...I'll start in verse 11 actually:

**1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 3:11-17** *For no one is able to lay any other foundation beside the One having been laid, who is Yahshua Messiah. And if anyone builds on this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, grass, straw, the work of each will be revealed; for the Day will make it known, because it is revealed in fire; and the fire will prove the work of each, what sort it is. If the work of anyone which he built survives, he will receive his reward. And the one whose work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss; but he will be delivered, but so as through fire...we talked about baptism of fire...Do you not know that you are a sanctuary of Elohim, and the Spirit of YAHWEH dwells in you? And whoever defiles the sanctuary of Elohim, Elohim will destroy; for the sanctuary of Elohim is holy, which you are.*

So here it is, like I said, **it's a great responsibility we have because when we defile the sanctuary of Yahweh in us, we're defiling the sanctuary of Yahweh in all the brethren because there's only one Spirit**; and we're defiling the sanctuary of Yahweh in Heaven by it. Ephesians 5...just a few more Scriptures and we'll be done...Ephesians 5 in verse 19. He's telling how we should be living as believers and he says:

**Ephesians 5:19-21** *speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and praising in your heart to YAHWEH, always giving thanks at all times for all things to YAHWEH the Father in the name of our Master Yahshua Messiah. Submitting yourself one to another in the love of the Messiah.*

So we see there's no way on a human level you can ever...any of us...can ever get to this point without the full understanding like we're talking about; that the good news message, it starts, it goes and it ends by the gospel of Yahshua Messiah; the good news of Him. It starts by His life, it starts by His death, His resurrection and unfortunately in the messianic movement that's all been lost.

The very power of the essence...the very power that causes these miracles...the very power that gives us the gift of Yahweh and the eternal life of Yahweh has all been lost...*"That's a Christian thing now!" "Oh, that's a Protestant thing!"*

And Satan has really deceived the people because as they're going back to the Torah, which is a great thing...like we said, **the Torah was never meant to give life. It's to teach us right from wrong; but eternal life can only come by Yahshua. And if you are not embracing His sacrifice every day in your life; you'll never embrace the gift of Yahweh; because He is the gift of Yahweh...**He is the gift of Yahweh. And He, literally living in you, is the gift of Yahweh.

**And by surrendering yourself and becoming Him; that's what He wants us to do. He wants us to follow His example in all ways. He wants us to surrender our flesh and follow Him in all ways.** Philippians 2 he says:

**Philippians 2:1-4** *So then, if there is any comfort in Messiah, if any consolation of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any mercies and compassions, complete my joy, by being in one accord, in one love, in one soul, in one mind. Doing nothing according to strife or self-glory, but in humility, let each regard his neighbor as better than himself; let no one be mindful only of his own things, but let each one also be mindful of the things of his neighbor.*

So like I said, I think you can see **by living in Community, by being around with people with the same Spirit...**I think it's helped all of us in these two months **to surrender to each other and being in a good environment of seeing this be fulfilled.** And I hope as I read this you're literally thinking of yourself now. Like he's saying, *complete my joy, by being in one accord, in one love, in one soul, in one mind. Doing nothing according to strife or self-glory, but in humility, let each regard his neighbor as better than himself; let no one be mindful only of his own things, but let each one also be mindful of the things of his neighbor.*

And I really, I commend everybody here for constantly...everybody looking for who needs what...always thinking of each other...always being considerate of each other. And like I said, I think all of us have made one step further toward the Kingdom in these two months.

So Yahweh bless and keep you. May Yahweh's countenance shine on you and may His shalom lift you up!
