TRANSCRIPT- The Consequence of the Fall of Man

Chag Semeach again, thank you Deacon Jeff for a timely message. It is the Last Great Day and Sukkot is all about the Kingdom of Yahweh that's coming to the earth; and the Last Great Day is about Yahweh finishing up His Plan of Salvation with mankind; and then what happens from there only Yahweh knows.

So I want to start in Genesis 1:31 because I have a message called, *The Consequence of the Fall of Man*. And as I study more about creation and the creation, you watch some of these creation videos and you compare them to the evolutionists, or the evil-lutionists, and what you see is really, what it really comes down to is a paradigm. A paradigm whether Genesis is actually history or whether what the historians say that the earth is billions of years old. And once you get caught into that paradigm of time then everything shifts from there.

But we know if we look even scientifically, we know that if you change the environment of something such as the earth and you change the atmosphere, then you're going to change the things of carbon dating. Carbon dating doesn't only break down when it's more than say seven, eight thousand years, the whole formula breaks down; it also breaks down if something is extremely cold or hot, or whether in water or other things. So in Genesis 1:31 it says:

Genesis 1:31 Elohim saw everything that He had made and behold, it was good. And there was evening, and there was morning, the sixth day.

So the other paradigm is that the evil-lutionist's don't understand the environment of Eden, right? And we don't really understand it. We can read it and we can concept it but we've never lived in it. We've never lived in a perfect atmosphere. But here it was a perfect atmosphere, everything that Yahweh created was good and there was evening and morning, day six, the sixth day.

So what I want to go over today is, I want to show the consequence of the fall of man, looking at what creation was; how it was affected, every part of our life and creation itself by that and what we have to look forward to. So it's not just a matter of Yahshua coming back to stop some of the things going on in our life today that we see are in the world today; but there's really so much more of it of the re-creation, that we are called to be part of. We're actually called to be first-fruits of this.

So what was creation like when Yahweh said everything that He saw was created good? And I encourage you there's a man called Carl Baugh, he has a place in Texas called the *Evidence Creation Museum*. I think that's what it's called. Me and Petra have been there. I know Carl Baugh fairly good, I don't even know if he's alive. I haven't really checked on him in several years but I've met him several times. I was actually one time even on TV with him when he was on TBN; and I met him over there in the back room and wonderful, wonderful man but he has awesome material on creation, really, really good material. And he has something called *The Symphony of Creation*; because the Bible tells us there was a canopy of water above the earth and a canopy of water below the earth.

So what this did was, it kind made like a greenhouse effect and every morning when the sun would rise from the canopy of water above the earth there would be like this pink aurora that would be around. And they say scientifically, they say like when the sun is first coming up in the morning and you see that pink aurora that there's something mentally that makes you peaceful and happy and joyful. And this was actually around the whole earth.

So what happens when you have a canopy of water above the earth and canopy of water below the earth and you have a greenhouse effect? This is why by that greenhouse effect, the atmospheric pressure was much greater; which means the breathing capacity was much greater, and the lung capacity; which means the oxygen you were getting was more. And that's why people lived to 900 years old; if you look why did they live that way before the flood and not after? It's

that simple. You die when your cells don't get oxygen and your cells die, **so before that** and we will see actually before the fall of man it was never meant; **man was never meant to die**. They were never meant to decrease and die like that.

So now, this changes everything; and we're even seeing it here because we're seeing like as you go up in a mountain, there's a point when the atmospheric pressure is changing and the oxygen in the air that the cloud would only come to a certain point, and we're seeing that birds will only go to that point because of that. Like all of creation is dependent on all these things! And Yahweh says everything was good. Everything was perfect at that point.

So every morning, and Dr. Baugh goes into this, what happens? Because birds sound a little different than they do today because of that. They also know that in our solar system there is ... was whatever planet you want to call, planet X that disappeared, why? Because they know there's a sonar residence to each planet and actually in our solar system it's the keyboard. The sonar residence is the *doe*, *re*, *me*, *fa*, *so*, *la*, *ti*. So can you imagine every morning you're waking up and the creation is praising Yahweh; the planets are giving off a residence of music and the birds are singing and the aurora that's coming; and it's a symphony? It's a symphony and Yahweh is the Conductor; and everything is perfect! And it's praising Him and glorifying Him! And that's why man can't understand creation because man wasn't in that perfect environment.

And we know when it changed, everything changed. But we know when you're looking at the sediment levels of rock we know that that happened quickly. It didn't happen over millions of years. Just scientifically, just look at the different levels of sediment in these places. Fossils, a fossil isn't easy to make, something has to happen quickly and traumatically to make that fossil, right? And that's from the flood, most of these things. But the symphony of creation, the beautifulness of all of this and we're at the end of 6000 years of degenerating and degenerating and degenerating that even today you talk about oxygen that the rain forests down in Brazil and South America that they're destroying; and they're burning it and they're getting rid of it. And every single thing that man is doing is destroying that perfect creation where Yahweh said everything is good. So when we look at Galatians 3:10:

Galatians 3:10 For lo, those who rely on the works of the law are still under the curse, for as it is written, cursed be everyone who does not practice everything written in the book of the Torah.

And of course Christianity misuses Scriptures like these to say the Torah is nailed to a tree, a cross, whatever they're nailing it to; it's done away with, is basically is what they're saying. But what is the curse of the Torah? The curse of the Torah is dis-obedience. Like I said, you could to Genesis 1 to Revelation 22; there is no curse for obedience. There is no curse for keeping the atmosphere, the earth, the creation the way that Yahweh made it. Matter a fact not only is there a curse, it's our job. That's where our blessing comes from; that we're here to sustain it. We're here to keep it the way it is, right? And where does that Scripture come from in Galatians 3:10? From Deuteronomy 27:26; Cursed is he who does not carry out all the words of the Torah to do them; and the people shall say Amen. So the curse is in the disobedience. The curse is when you can't keep it; and of course as human beings, we are not part of Eden; we're part of the fall of man. And this is what I want to get into. There are grave consequences to this.

So we've only lived in the fall. We've never lived in the perfection but that is our hope! And that's what I want to share with you today. **Our hope is going back to that perfection** because there will be a time as we read in **Revelation 10** where time is no more. What is time? We're living in time now; this Feast was timed. We had seven days, it was over yesterday and now we have one more day today of a Feast; and then tomorrow it will go on. But when there's time no more because **Yahweh** is **eternal**.

Yahweh is a **circular pattern** that just **has no beginning and no end** but we can't concept that because **we're part of time**. From the day you're born to the day you die, you're timed. You have 25,365 days maybe. So every day that you live, check one off till you go. But Yahweh is not born out of time. Yahweh created time.

And **time** is simply a piece of eternity; it's simply a little line on that infinite line of no beginning and no end. And why did Yahweh create time? He created time so that He can get rid of this massacre that we've done. There'll be none of this massacre in the Kingdom. The consequence of the fall of man will be over. It's an experiment and praise Yahweh, the end. He knows how many, exactly how many new children will be part of His family. That right now is the Father and the Son; but all the rest of it He can just get rid of in time because time always has a beginning and time has an end; eternity doesn't.

And that's why I say we have to overcome now because whatever you bring into eternity it's going to be forever. So you're not going to bring a broken hand or a broken leg and you can't bring pride. You can't bring greed; you can't bring these things into eternity because you'll eternally be that way; and you'll be miserable and unhappy. And that's why as a loving Father who has given us freewill, because we're created in His image, freewill to choose; He also has an outlet. He has the outlet for the ones who don't choose that way that He could just have the Lake of Fire come, burn the people up and it's like they never existed. We won't have that memory; that's the Last Great Day that's part of this is about.

It talks about in Revelation that Yahweh wipes away every tear from our eyes and those tears are some of our relatives and friends who won't make it but there'll only be one day of a tear. After that, you'll never remember it again. If you had five children, you'd only remember four. You won't remember the people who didn't make it. Yahweh is not going put us through that torture and certainly **He is so much love and mercy and kindness, He would never ever think of burning people for eternity**. That's a demonic thought. That's not Elohim-guided thought. That's not the way He works. **He's a Redeemer, He's a Restorer, He's a Creator**. He's not a torturer. So it doesn't work that way.

So let's go back now and let's look Genesis 2 in verse 15 because not only was there a perfect environment, **there was no death**. Like I said, Yahweh made the perfect environment that even though mankind was physical, mankind would have never, he would have never become decrepit; He would have never been dying, his cells, everyday like we are. He didn't make us that way. **He made us to be constant** like Eden. He made us to just survive forever. And Adam would still be alive today. We'd be having the 5900th in whatever year of Adam's birth. He would still be alive today if it wasn't for the fall of man. So Genesis 2 in verse 15 says:

Genesis 2:15 *And YAHWEH Elohim took the man ...* Ha'Adawm, the man Ha'Adawm; not mankind, but Ha'Adawm, the man Adam ... and He put him in the Garden of Eden, to work it and to keep it.

Comment: Right? And you look those words up, to work it and to keep it; and it's literally to **sustain it**; not to change it, not to try to do something against the perfectness of Yahweh but to sustain it and to keep it. The same as we are today.

Genesis 2:16-17 And YAHWEH Elohim commanded the man, saying, Eating you may eat of every tree in the garden ... He gave every single beautiful thing and beautiful tree and **everything that he needed to sustain himself** but He also said ... but of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil you may not eat, for in the day that you eat of it, you shall surely die.

So again, this is a parable but it's also a real story; it really happened. And why did Yahweh do it that way? Why did He make it a tree? Is it really so bad to eat a piece of fruit? Did it have worms? Did it have maggots? What was the big thing with it? It had nothing to do with fruit; it had nothing to do with food, although Yahweh did it. He used it as a test. Like I

say, life is a test. And the test was, if Yahweh ... if He made us in His image, we have to have freewill because He has freewill. And if He doesn't give us freewill then we're not made in His image.

But at the same rate, He's saying to us, **you have to surrender that freewill back** because remember Adam and Eve, as we're going to see here, they're created like children. The old story that comes up, did Adam have a belly button? That's the old thing right because he's the only human being, beside Eve. Eve came out of his side. But Adam is not born from a woman. He's not born from a womb. So did he have a belly button? We'll find out I guess when the Kingdom comes.

But we do know something about Adam and Eve as our forefathers to this plan. Adam and Eve had a mind of a child. I don't know what age, if they had a mind of a ten year old, twelve year old, six year old but **they had a mind of a child**. That's the way that their mind was. And when Yahweh made them there would be no death **until rebellion came in;** mankind instituting his own way. So that's what is said here.

The Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, it's not just about a fruit; it's about, **do we totally trust Yahweh 100% like child does?** When your child is there and you say, "Don't go in the street! I want you to stay in this room." Your child doesn't sit there and say, "Well, explain to me why." That's not the point of a child. It's, "Stay in the room. That's the rule. You don't ask why." Because their mind isn't there to equip that yet; their mind is there to equip, "My parents there. I trust my parents. I'm not going to question what they say." And that was Adam and Eve.

They were not. They may have had physical bodies like an adult but their mind was not like an adult. Their mind was like a child and a child is what? A child is trusting; a child has faith, "If my daddy says that he can make that car fly, my daddy's true. My daddy would never tell me something that's not true." And that's the way Adam and Eve had to be. They had to trust that whatever Yahweh said was going happen, but He had to give them freewill if they were going to be like Him.

So this is what the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil is all about. It's about, **do they decide for themselves**, is it the child that's seventeen/eighteen and say, "Bye Dad and Mom. I'm going on my own. I know better. I know what you taught me. I know what the Bible said but I know better. I'm going to do it my way." As we know it happens a lot of times and that's exactly what happened with Adam and Eve.

So this is what you have to understand where the sin comes in. It's so much more than just eating a piece of fruit that Yahweh said not to touch. It's about choosing a world with Him or without Him; choosing a world absent of Him or His world that He gave you. Are you sustaining His way in your life? Or are you compromising your own way? Because when you compromise your way, you're doing the same thing; it's the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil; you're deciding what is good and what is evil. And now we have to decide are we going back to Eden; or are we going to stay in this world? And who's the god of this world? So all the things from the god of this world we have to decide are you going to get rid of are you going back to Eden; or are you staying in the world from here?

So let's go to Genesis 3 now and let's see how this happened. So this is where we are to this point. We're still in this perfect world. We have these two young adults with a mind of a child – a pure mind, just like, think of a ten year old, that pure mind that they have; and now what comes in? The serpent, did Yahweh know? Of course He knew. Did He allow it? Of course He did because He's got to test them the same way He tests us. And that's why He allows satan to tempt us, to try us; but like He says, with everyone there's a way out. You don't have to take that temptation.

Genesis 3:1a So the serpent was cunning ...

Comment: And it's very interesting because where it says in verse 25, and remember there's no chapter breaks in the original Bible; it all flows through; man put these in later. But they were both naked, the man and his wife and they were

not ashamed; and we'll get into this because there's more to it than just being naked. It's like when you have your little baby that's two years old and running around the house naked and going wild and it's pure, there's nothing wrong with it. It's a beautiful thing to see a little child and he doesn't know and he doesn't understand yet about these kinds of things; and this is the way Adam and Eve were.

They had minds of children running around just playing and they were naked because there's nothing wrong with a child being naked in a pure world. And the serpent though is cunning and that word is derived from the same word as naked; it's derived, it's like a play on words. It's a very similar word to it. So **there's a very, very fine line between being pure-hearted and naked; and being cunning and sinful;** there's a very line there.

Genesis 3:1b ... And then he says to the woman ... the serpent ... Is it so that Elohim has said, You will not eat from any tree of the garden?

Comment: So he uses scripture but he twists it. He doesn't tell the whole Scripture. And think about it, if you read whether it's the Ten Commandments maybe, or it's other things in Scripture, if you read just half of verses you can come up with things very, very different. Or if you take the wrong verses and put them together... Judas went and hung himself. Go thee and do likewise. You put the wrong Scriptures together you're going to come up with a bad result that comes from that. And this is what satan's doing. He's twisting the Scripture now and telling them half of it. So he's saying, Didn't Elohim say you can eat from all the trees?

Genesis 3:2-3 And the woman says to the serpent, of the fruit of the trees of the garden, We may eat, but of the fruit of the tree in the middle of the garden, Elohim has said, **You shall not eat of it, nor shall you even touch it**.

Comments: So it's not even a matter of just not eating it; not touching, and not thinking about it, not having it anywhere in your thought pattern of disobedience. Yahweh said, "Don't eat of that." Why would I even go near it? Because what happens when you touch it? Wow, we're going to see what happens after you touch it. He sees that it's good for food, pleasant to the eyes and desirable to make one wise, right? So if she never touched it; if she never went near it you'd never get.

And sometimes I think as believers we try to see how close we can get to sin without getting burned, right? Oh yeah, I got a Smartphone, but I wouldn't take the mark of the beast. It's the same thing. What is the difference if you're holding it in your hand 18 hours a day; or it's a tiny bit under your skin? It's the same thing ... same thing. That's what hit me when Elon Musk said, "We don't need a chip. It's already there." **The Smartphone is an extension of somebody's hand**; and everything you have to do in the world depends on that, can't get to the airport, you got to have your Smartphone, can't get your ... it's all part of it, right? So how close do you want to get to it before you do it?

This vaccine that's coming, well, it's not the mark of the beast **yet**; it's only a vaccine. Okay I understand I you need luciferase to make it work. I understand it's a mark; it's a permanent tattoo in your hand but it's not the mark of the beast yet; but it's good for good; it's pleasant to the eyes; and it's desirable to make one wise. You don't want to give something up. You might have to give up flying. You might have to give up your job. You might have to give this.

So here it is. Are you keeping the perfect environment of Eden? Or are you trying to get as close to that fence as you could without and it's not even without sinning; it's without putting in your mind; it's your conscience. It's not even reality because brethren are sinning. They are sinning. They do it on the Sabbath.

I see people breaking the Sabbath all the time; and unfortunately sometimes even working on Sabbath; but it's their conscience. And your conscience a lot of times is going to corrupt you. It will. So you don't always want to go by your

conscience, you want to go by the Word of Yahweh. But this is how he deceives them, right? And what does he tell them in verse 3?

Genesis 3:3-5 but of the fruit of the tree in the middle of the garden, Elohim has said, You shall not eat of it, nor shall you touch it, lest you die ... and what does the serpent say? ... surely, you shall not die ... so now he outwardly lies ... surely you won't die but Elohim knows that in the day you eat it, your eyes will be opened, and you will be like Him knowing good and evil.

No, you won't be like Him, **knowing** good and evil, you'll be like Him though **you're able to choose what is good and good and evil**; it doesn't make it good or evil; but at least you'll be able to choose that. Because satan knows as soon as they do this, that Yahweh has to cut them off. Yahweh can't lie; Yahweh can't sin. So He knows as soon as they do this, Plan B has to go into effect; and that's exactly what happens here.

So what do they do? They eat of it and she eats the fruit and she gives to her husband and he also eats; and what is it showing? **They believed the serpent above Yahweh**. They believed the serpent because Yahweh said one thing, the serpent said the opposite; and here's the immortal soul. Yahweh says the soul that sins will die. Satan says don't worry you'll live forever.

Where's the eternal hell fire come from? That's where it comes from. Well okay, you might be burned, you might be hot; but hey, I love hot places. I love to live somewhere where it's real hot. I don't mind that. But you're going to live forever, so I can sin and I can do whatever. No I'm going to live forever. No you won't. The soul that sins, it will die. It will not live forever in an uncomfortable place. That's not what Yahweh says, but that's what satan says. And who do the people believe? They believe satan over Yahweh.

So lack of trust, falsely accused Yahweh; they falsely accused Him because he said; "Yahweh's lying to you. He's afraid you're going to know more than He knows." So they falsely accuse, they didn't believe and here we are today, the consequences. And this is what I want to show, the consequence, not only of them; because I see people that will blame Adam and Eve ... if it wasn't for them, if it wasn't or that decision.

Every one of us has made the same decision in our life. There's not a human being that hasn't lived that hasn't made that decision. That they saw the way that Yahweh said it and we went our own way. If not, you would have never have repented; you would have never come to truth. All of us have done that in our life as we're going to read here. Accept for Yahshua, He's the only One from the womb of His mother that followed because He's the second Adam here. So now what happens? Let's keep continuing here, verse 7:

Genesis 3:7 And the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked. And they sewed leaves of fig tree, and made girdles for themselves.

They lost their innocence. And you want to know something? In Hebrew, the words that are used in the Hebrew actually connote like sexual words; and I don't believe ... some people believe because of that that there was some kind of sexual thing involved here with satan and Eve. I do not believe that; but I believe that Yahweh showed that for the innocence. And I say there's a lot evil in this world but the worst evil that you can even imagine in this world, and I would never take up violence to anybody, but this makes me think of violence, is when a human being, an adult, takes the innocence away from a child. I think you all know what I'm talking about. I'm not going any further with it but that boils my blood. I think I could do bodily harm in that case because you never get it back ... you never get it back.

And that's the point when we look at our children they don't know what I'm talking about, praise Yahweh ... they don't know what I'm talking about because they're innocent. They're pure in that way. It doesn't mean that they're perfect. It

doesn't mean they're sinless. It doesn't mean they don't make mistakes but they're still in the sense of the world, they're still naked. They have no idea of the evils out there.

And what we try to tell our daughter, "Don't go to the garbage alone. Let daddy come with you to put the garbage away." Why? "You want to ride your bike, I'll come with you." I jog while she's riding. There's a reason for it because we know how evil this world is. We know how sinister the world is and we know that nothing has changed from the Garden of Eden. But I praise Yahweh that they don't know. And they don't understand yet, but as they get older they will. But our children are born that way when they're born into the truth they're born where they don't understand the evils of this world.

And that's why like the Qumran Sect why they had to go to the wilderness, **not for them** because like I said, **all of us that are adults, we're corrupted**. We're trying to get rid of it and we will little by little, but we live in this evil system. We understand how evil it is. But our children can grow up and they will be the first generation in that perfect Kingdom. They'll be that first generation and then their children in the Kingdom also they'll be naked. They'll be pure, they'll be running around. They won't understand what satan **did** in that Garden of Eden; what he **did** to each and every human being what he's done to our children today that we can't send them to public school. We can't send them to the world because you know what if you do? They're going to lose that; the same thing that's going to happen over here; it's the world is evil out there.

And it's become so evil that now Yahweh is ready to return. He can't let it go anymore because now they're to the point when we're in **Genesis 6**; it's **above even evil**, it's above genetically modifying DNA, about putting things in people's brain. It's about mankind really saying and they're openly saying it, "We're going to become immortal of our self." Mankind making himself into a g-o-d, right?

Genesis 3:8-11 And they heard the sound of YAHWEH Elohim walking up and down in the garden at the breeze of the day. And the man and his wife hid themselves from the face of YAHWEH in the middle of the trees. And YAHWEH Elohim called to the man and said to him, Where are you? And he said, I heard Your sound in the garden, and I was afraid, for I am naked, and I hid myself. And He said, Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten of the tree of which I commanded you not to do?

Comment: And like I said, it wasn't that there was something in that food. It was the act. It was the act that they denied faith in Yahweh. They denied His way was perfect. They rejected Genesis 1:31 and everything was good and believed satan instead of that. And what does the man do? Does he take responsibility? Does he repent? Does he have remorse? No! What does he do?

Genesis 3:12-13 he says, The woman whom You gave to me, she has given this tree, and I ate ... right? They don't even see remorse of it. They don't even see that there's something evil in this by not trusting Him. And then He goes to the woman ... And He says, What have you have done ... and what does she do? She blames the serpent ... the serpent deceived me, and I ate it.

You don't see remorse. You don't see crying. You certainly don't see repentance. And here we are the consequence of the fall of man. So what does Yahweh do? He tells at least the beginning consequence that we're even seeing today. Let's go to verse 16:

Genesis 3:16 He says to the woman, I will greatly increase your sorrow and your conception; you will bear sons in sorrow, and your desire will be toward your husband; and he will rule over you.

So the first thing we see is that life ... can you imagine, the greatest gift that Yahweh has given us is that **we get to give life**. When a man and a woman are husband and wife, and **the two shall become one**; it's also talking about a union where they're going to be able to give life to another human being; which was supposed to be in Eden; an easy, a beautiful, a happy thing; but now it's done in sorrow. And most women understand that.

At least, praise Yahweh, it says once the baby is born and you see that baby all that pain and suffering you went through you don't even remember; but there's still sorrow in doing it. There's pain that's involved in giving birth. It wasn't meant to be that way. That's one of the consequences of the fall of man. Jeremiah 20 in verse 14, look what He says because it's more than just the actual pain in childbirth, it's what that child is going to grow up to too ... Jeremiah 20 in verse 14 says:

Jeremiah 20:14-15 Cursed is the day in which I was born; let not the day in which my mother bore me be blessed. Cursed is the man who brought news to my father, saying, A man child is born to you, making him very glad.

And it breaks my heart because many times you see these children that are born and they're little babies and they're beautiful and they're cute and they're running around; and then all of a sudden sometimes by the time they're five and 6 you see the purple hair, and you see the things, tattoos by the time they're ten, some of them sometimes. And it's like that's the world we live in. So that's the sad part, cursed is why? Cursed is because a man child is born? Because every baby is cute but no baby stays that way. Show me a cute adult. Show me an adult who's twenty-five, thirty years old that's cute.

No, Hitler was cute when he was a baby; I'm guessing every baby is cute right? But that's the point of it. That's why cursed in child bearing because everyone is going to be ... everyone is going to grow up the same way. Everyone is going to grow up and do exactly what Adam and Eve did. Every one of us has freewill and every one of us will choose in our life. Sometimes when we're old enough and sometimes when we're not old enough but we will choose to go the other way, every single one of us because we know better. Consequence of the fall of man; it wasn't meant to be that way. It wouldn't have been that way and it won't be that way when the Kingdom comes. So Genesis 17, in 3:17 as we continue here and what is the curse to the man?

Genesis 3:17-19 And He says to the man, Because you have listened to the voice of your wife, and have eaten of the tree about which I commanded you, saying, You will not eat from it, **the ground will be cursed** and you will eat of it in sorrow all the days of your life. It shall bring forth thorns and thistles to you, and you will eat the plants of the field. By the sweat of your face you will eat bread until you return to the ground. For you been taken out of it; you are dust, and to dust you shall return.

So now, what is the story of the Garden of Eden all about? Is it really about gardening? I did gardening for fifteen years so I didn't look to Genesis 1 and 2 and 3 as my prototype on how to make the best tomatoes in the world; or how to make the best eggplant in the world because it's so much more than gardening. It's a parable using gardening, or a garden in this sense, but **He's talking about bringing forth fruit for the garden**, meaning what? The same way Yahshua said, *Unless you produce fruit, you cannot be in His Kingdom* – **John 15**.

The fruit is bringing more people into Eden that was the job; it wasn't tomatoes. So here it is Adam failed. He failed and like I say, when you look at when He says I'll give you dominion over the earth that word 'mamlakah' is the word for kingdom. Adam didn't lose a religion; he lost a kingdom. Adam was going to be high in that kingdom, probably like King David; Yahweh, Yahshua and Adam, he would have been the third in that Kingdom, but he failed. He didn't go out to society. He didn't bring the Torah and the Word of Yahweh and bring more people in.

And now He says, "Know what, not only isn't it going to happen; the little bit of fruit you bear it's going to be by the sweat of your brow." And I can tell you I'm in the truth 37 years going on now, 36/37 years and it's never been easy to bear fruit for Yahweh's Kingdom, at times it's dangerous; people rejecting it. Praise Him now as His Spirit is being poured out. I'm amazed when I go to some places like Liberia a couple of years ago. First time I go there's several thousand people waiting there, almost a thousand, just to be baptized.

I always wondered how do you do it? I found out real quick! You got to have a plan for it. But before this, this is what we're dealing with; it's not easy. It's not easy to bear fruit because of this. This is one of the consequences; it wasn't meant to be this way; and it's not only fruit for Yahweh, it's also our work as men, as fathers and leaders of our family, we know it's not that easy. You have to work hard. You have to sweat; you have to fight and toil because you're in the world.

Sometimes get fired over your beliefs for the Sabbath or another belief, right? You have to deal with people in the world, workers in the world. They're not believers; they're going to have foul language; they're going to be this way. So it's a struggle where it wasn't meant to be that way. **Our work was meant to be a blessing** and it will be. I consider my work a blessing. I hope you consider yours for Yahweh, even though it's not easy; it is a blessing.

But when the Kingdom comes as we're going to see, we're not going to have to worry about this anymore. But from Eden the ground was cursed by thorns and thistles; work providing fruit would now be a burden. We'd have to toil. We'd have to sweat after the fall. Before it was blessed, happy, peaceful in the Garden. Genesis 2, let's go back to Genesis 2 now verse 1 and see a little again before the fall what it was like:

Genesis 2:1-3 And the earth and the heaven were finished, and all their host. And on the seventh day Elohim completed His work which He had made. And He rested on the seventh day from all His work which He made. And Elohim blessed the seventh day and sanctified it, because He rested from all His work on it, which Elohim had made to create.

So now the Sabbath is not just a day set apart because Yahweh worked really hard for six days and boy was He plum tired out; and He's going to take the seventh day and He's going to rest. We know Yahweh doesn't get tired. No, it was about the verse before that was **everything Yahweh created was good**. So now He's setting apart a day in the seven day week that He created, and like I say, the atheist has no answer for this, the atheists, why it's the seven day week, but it's always been for six thousand years because Yahweh willed it that way.

But the seventh day was meant to picture this perfect setting; it was meant to glorify Him for this perfect setting. And here we are almost six thousand years later and still we have to toil and struggle and sweat and fight for six days in satan's world; but the seventh day is free ... the seventh day is free. You're free from that if you allow it to be! Sunset Friday you could cut everything off; and that's why, why have the internet on, on the Sabbath? Why have it on any day? Why have it on the Sabbath? Why have your cell phone on, on the Sabbath? Anything that's going to happen, if the world ended, if there's World War 3 going on right now then let's just have these few hours of peace before we find it out. You don't need it! That's the blessing you're taking from yourself. You are blessed every seventh day to go back to Eden mentally.

I gave a message like this once years ago and a woman came up to me and she said, "Oh I just don't believe that. What you're saying is just not true." And I said, "Oh no, it's absolutely true." Because I went through a time in my life, a very, very hard time where I was struggling and I had a really hard time. I went through bankruptcy; I was going through all kinds of stuff; and I'll tell you something — when sunset Friday came, I couldn't wait to turn that off and I did. And all Sabbath studying Friday night, being with the brethren doing everything; and when I would go down before sunset Saturday and I would say my prayer to Yahweh, tears would be in my eyes because I knew I had to go back. I knew that

that problem wasn't ending but it certainly went away for 24 hours. For 24 hours it was just me and Yahweh and His brethren in the Kingdom and you get that blessing every single week!

And that's why it says *pray your flight be not on the Sabbath*; it has nothing to do with weather or anything else. It has to do with you're going to lose your blessing. You're going to lose that one day. We don't want to lose any of that; we want to keep it every seventh day and you can. That's what He's talking about, entering His rest; it doesn't matter what happened. It doesn't matter if someone died. It doesn't matter if you're sick. **Every Friday sunset you could enter His rest; you can go back to Eden** and you need it the same way we need this Feast that will take us for the next six/nine months. You get it every week. You get it every single week. **Don't let satan take it away from you** the way he did Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden.

He's already taken the world here, this world, and this society. He's taken so much from our lives. He's taken some of our family members, right? Don't let him take that, hold on to that every seventh day because **it's the greatest blessing of the week**; and Yahweh gives us that. Because it wasn't just that everything was perfect; **it was that mankind had a relationship with Him!** He actually had a relationship with Adam. If you go through Genesis 2 you see He explains the way everything is ... in verse 7:

Genesis 2:7-10, 15 And YAHWEH formed the man from the dust of the ground, and blew in his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul. And YAHWEH planted a garden in Eden to the east; and He put the man in the garden. And out of the ground YAHWEH made up to spring every tree that is pleasant to the sight, good for food. The Tree of Life was in the middle of the garden; and also the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. And a river went out of Eden to the garden, and from there it was divided and ... all this stuff; and when we get to verse 15 ... YAHWEH Elohim took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden, to work it and to keep it.

And Yahweh's talking to him directly, there's no mediator. There's no need for a mediator because it's under the perfect environment of Eden; and Yahweh's there and has a relationship. He has a real relationship with Adam at this time, as a friend of Elohim. The only other time we see that is Abraham; Abraham is called the friend of Elohim. So he has a relationship before the curse; a one on one relationship. He's made in Yahweh's image and he's going to be taught all these things and then he's going to go out and he's going to bring other people into Eden.

But like we said, what happened in Genesis 3:6 and 7? They lost the innocence. They lost that child-like spirit. They lost their nature. And like I said, a child is innocent. He's pure minded; he's correctable, he's forgiving; and now that whole nature is corrupted. The whole nature is corrupted from this time; and in a short time let's go to Genesis 4.

How bad can it get? It can get pretty bad, pretty quick when the Spirit of Yahweh isn't there. So now what happens? Adam and Eve have two sons – the first son, Cain. Cain which means ... why did they call him Cain? Because in Hebrew that means to purchase, to redeem; because of the promise in **Genesis 3:15** is even though you failed, even though I said the day you eat it, you'll die; and like I said at that point the atmosphere changed, everything changed. The DNA changed and now their body is physically starting to die at that point; the same we do from the day we're born. Yahweh still had a plan B; and that's what He said, "Don't worry ... don't' worry. You're going to have a seed and from there that seed is going to be the Redeemer." **Genesis 3:15**, the first Messianic prophecy that comes there.

So they're thinking ... they're not understanding that's going to be many moons down the road. They think that's their son. So Eve has given birth and the first one that comes out is Cain. They name him Cain, why? Because it means: to redeem; to purchase, to draw back. Then the second one comes out, Abel; they're twins. And what happens? They're thinking, "No, no, no. Yahweh only said one. What are we going to do with the second one? I don't know. What do we call him?" Havel which means: vanity, nothingness. "We don't need him. We already got one." That was their thought

pattern. But of course Cain was not the Messiah. And I'm not going to go into the first ten names of the genealogy because this is something from Adam and Eve all the way down to Noah. They're waiting for that Redeemer. They're waiting for that calling back. But what happens? Genesis 4 ... now you have these two brothers and how fast, like I said, can it go down? Genesis 4 in verse 3:

Genesis 4:3-5 And in the end of days, it happened that Cain brought an offering to YAHWEH from the fruit of the ground. And Abel also, he brought from the firstlings of his flock, even their fat. And YAHWEH looked to Abel and to his offering. But He did not look to Cain and his offering. And Cain glowed greatly with anger, and fell on his face.

Comment: And I did a message a long time ago, *Are You Bringing a Bloodless Sacrifice?* And that's what it comes down to. It wasn't that Yahweh was like Isaac; he was a meat eater and he's looking for a good solid stew and he didn't look to the vegetables. It wasn't like that. It was the fact that one was bringing a bloodless sacrifice. One was just bringing it from his excess and one was bringing it from his heart; and that's what Yahweh wants to see. Like I said, you don't tithe the last ten percent; you tithe the first ten percent; and you tithe on everything including your time. There's 24 hours in a day – minimum 2.4 hours go to Yahweh; and it's not the last. It's like I said, it's not the end of the day when you forgot about it and you're praying on your bed and you fall asleep. You give Yahweh your ten percent best, not the leftover! That's what happened here. So what happens?

Genesis 4:6-7 YAHWEH says to Cain, Why have you glowed angrily, and why has your face fallen? If you do well, is there not exaltation? And if you do not do well, sin is crouching at the door; and its desire is toward you; but you should rule over it.

Just like with satan with Adam and Eve. We're commanded to rule over this, but he didn't. He had envy; he had strife. All these things are consequence of the fall of man. And then what happens? He talks with his brother to go to the field and Cain rises up against his brother and kills him. Wow! I mean today we're saying this influence in the world on our children and everything else, which is true. But over here this is the very beginning. Where did they get this from? Was there domestic problems with Adam and Eve? Maybe but I don't think like this ... killing! You're thinking of killing your brother.

And then just like with Adam and Eve, is there remorse? Yahweh comes and says, "Where's your brother?" And what's his answer? "Am I my brother's keeper?" Yes we are ... yes we are. That's part of the community mindset. I am my brother's keeper. I am only as happy as my brother is happy. If I have something my brother needs, I give to my brother, right? And then Yahweh tells him the voice and the blood of your brother cries to me from the ground. So wow ... wow. In such a short time a new nature turned totally evil; jealousy arose, even murder of their own flesh and blood; and this is what happens you take the Spirit of Yahweh away. Then we get to Genesis 6, not that long from there, right? I mean how many chapters are in the Bible altogether, and we're only in the first six and we're getting to the point where Yahweh is saying down here in verse 5:

Genesis 6:5-7 And YAHWEH saw that the evil of man was great on the earth, and every imagination of thoughts of his heart was only evil all the day. And YAHWEH sighed with sorrow that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved to His heart. And YAHWEH said, I will wipe off man whom I have created from the face of the earth, from man to beast, to the creeping thing and birds of the heaven; I repent I made them.

You know why? What did the bird do? What did the animal do? Nothing but **they were made for the man. Everything of creation Yahweh made for us**. He didn't make one bird. He made thousands of birds, different colors, different voices, different noises; the same with animals – beautifulness. He made it for us, for us to be able to see! Like we saw in that creation video, there's a reason why the sky is blue and the grass is green. He did all this just for His love for us. And now

mankind is just so **wicked and destroying** and evil that He's saying *I wish I never even started this*. And it cuts to your heart as a human being but it's the consequence; it's the consequence of the fall of man. The end result of mankind's freewill, making their own choices of what is good and evil. Romans 8 in verse 7, He says:

Romans 8:7-8 because the mind of the flesh is hatred toward YAHWEH; it's not subject to the Torah and it is impossible to do so. And **those being in the flesh are not able to please YAHWEH.**

So we see without the Spirit of Yahweh this is the way it's always going to end up; and that's where the world is today. They're trying to become g-o-ds without Yahweh. They think they can do it by changing DNA, by science, by whatever they're trying to do, but it's not going to work because it never worked. It never worked that way. **Corrupt human nature is a part of the human DNA, not possible to do good without the Spirit of Yahweh**; and now we see, you see rebellion of women in the home; it's called human rights.

You see abortion and murder is called a woman's choice. We see homosexuality is a life choice. So **they're choosing what is good and what is evil**. And that's why Isaiah says, *they call good for evil and evil for good*; and that's the world we live in. And that's why **we have to come out of it.** We have to come out of it and **now more than ever** ... now more than ever. It's like now it's for survival, we have to completely come out of the world. Hebrews 11:6, I hope you really understand this more as we're going over these things.

Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it's impossible to please YAHWEH. For it is right the one drawing near to YAHWEH should **believe He is**, and He is a rewarder of those that diligently **seek Him**.

Right? Did Adam and Eve believe this? No, they did not. Number one, they didn't believe what Yahweh said was hook, line and sinker 100%, and they certainly didn't believe that He was a rewarder of those who seek Him. But that's the point of it. Every time we have doubt, every time we go our own way, we're not doing this; and it says it's impossible ... doesn't say it's hard ... hardly will a rich man get into Heaven. If I was a rich man I'd be like, Whew! Well, maybe the odds aren't with me ... at least it's hardly ... He didn't say never. Here it's impossible. It's impossible because how on earth when Yahweh's been here forever and we're just here these few short days can we doubt Him and think we're going to have a relationship with Him.

It's that simple. Either we believe it or not and that's what I keep getting back to ... it's one of the things I can put in ... as long as the Red Sea crossing happened ... as long as He is actually, He's not just a part of nature, but He's a real Being with a real thought and a real plan. He actually wrote the Ten Commandments. If they find this, it wasn't written by Moses; it was written by His finger! So now we have things, we have prophets and we have scrolls that somebody wrote that Yahweh inspired them, but we have nothing that Yahweh wrote with His finger except the Ten Commandments. So when they come out, that proves He's there! The parting of the Red Sea proves He's real; He's there! And if we believe that a 1000% you're never going to doubt! Because if He parted the Red Sea, He certainly can take care of any problem we have in our life.

And as we're going to see here, the redemption is just awesome! Like I always tell this story, a bumper sticker I saw one time that said, the ministers of Elohim, *The pay is not good but the retirement plan is excellent*. That's what we're looking for. We're looking for the 401K up in Heaven. We're not living for the pay increases here on the earth. We're looking for that great 401K in Heaven.

So I want to go now through the rest of the message the changes that came from here, physically in the world and how they'll go back to Eden. I want to start with 2nd Kings 2 in verse 23 and 24 ... 2nd Kings 2:23 and 24 ... and it's talking about Elisha:

2nd Kings 2:23-24 And he went up from there to Bethel. And he was going up in the highway. And little boys came out from the city and mocked him, and said to him, Go up, bald head! Go up, bald head! ... I always thought that kind of a strange story but what happens ... And he turned aside from him, and he cursed them in the name of YAHWEH. And two bears came out of the forest and tore forty two boys of them.

Wow, strange story put in here. We're not going to talk about that. The only reason I'm going here is to show this is one of the consequences of the fall of man that animals were not made to harm human beings. Animals were made as Yahweh gave mankind dominion over the animals. And if you have dominion over something then certainly they're not going to rip you apart and destroy you. But from the fall of man, not only did mankind's DNA change, and mankind's mindset change, so did all creation. All creation changed at that point because there's a reason for everything in creation.

And I'm not the greatest scientific person but there will be times where you ever been somewhere and maybe you're getting bitten by mosquitoes and you're like, "Oh boy, I wish these mosquitoes were all gone." And we're like, "No, no, no, no the mosquitoes actually eat this and they actually do this, does that and the fauna and the fauna and all the ecosystem." You find out everything is part of Yahweh's creation ... cross pollination. So even a mosquito and actually what Dr. Baugh says is that mosquitoes didn't bite people because of the environment in the Garden of Eden but whether that's true or not, I don't know but that's what he says. But there's a purpose for the mosquito and the purpose I'm sure wasn't to bite people. That's not the reason Yahweh created them but they do something else.

So it's all part of that creation and here what we're seeing is something went wrong because animals were not meant to kill human beings. That was not their purpose. And what happens in Isaiah 11? Isaiah 11, what do we have to look forward to? And this is what the whole Last Great Day is about; it's about going back to Eden ... it's about going back to Eden. And look what happens in Isaiah 11 ... I'm going to start in verse 6:

Isaiah 11:6 And the wolf will live with the lamb; and the leopard will lie with the kid; and the calf and the young lion and the fatling together; and **a little boy shall lead them**.

Comment: Right? We're going back to Eden. A little boy will lead them. Is his name Ha'Adawm? Is his name Adam? That's what Adam was, he was little boy who went in the wrong direction. A little boy will lead them.

Isaiah 11:7 the cow and the bear will feed, their young shall lie together; and the lion will eat straw like the ox.

Comment: Right? We saw that video the other night where the lady is singing the song, *It Won't be Long Now*, with the little girl with the lamb in her hand and there's a lion right there. He was a pretty big lion too but he's pretty calm. And like they're saying it won't be long now till that's the case that the same way that your child goes out and pets a little kitty cat, he's going to be petting a lion and playing with the lion. And there'll be no harm to them.

Isaiah 11:8-9 The cow and the bear will feed and their young shall lie together; and the lion will eat straw like the ox. And the infant ... we have a little baby here ... The infant will play on the hole of the asp ... the snake ... yea, the weaned child will put his hand in the viper's den. They shall not do evil, nor destroy in all My holy mountain ... Mount Zion, that's our last stop ... For the earth shall be full of the knowledge of YAHWEH, as the water covers the sea.

Wow ... wow, how awesome that will be ... how awesome that will be. Just like the water it doesn't stop it just goes and goes and goes, right? The same way **the Word of Yahweh will cover the whole earth**. 1st Kings 14 in verse 30, what's another consequence of the fall of man?

1st **Kings 14:30** And there was war between Rehoboam and Jeroboam continuously.

Right? Starts with Adam, not Adam but it starts with Cain and Abel, and we see this through the Bible. We see brothers, we see also Jacob and Esau and we see this through the Bible. We see brothers and we see, not just brothers but war in general but here it is again; it's brothers – Rehoboam and Jeroboam. We see Ephraim and Judah fighting with each other. And I looked up and I found that the word war in the Bible is there more than 330 times, the word war.

And yet when the Kingdom comes ... let's go to Micah 4. Do we have to worry about this? Because it's part of mankind's nature and that's what I say when you're talking about bringing in implants and you could automatically play the piano and be perfect at it. It's like, oh yeah, all those things sound great until you get to the bottom line of it; because if mankind is going to get more knowledge, you think he wants knowledge to play the piano? No, he want's knowledge to destroy other people, that's what happens.

The most serious thing in the world today is with the military and why do you have things like CIA and FBI and covert operations? They say it's for the survival of countries. So whether its China or America or Russia, they're all trying to figure out how to get more weapons to kill the other guy. So you really don't think if they can put brain implants and make people a hundred times smarter than what they are now, you think they're really going to use it to get the cure of cancer? No! They're going to get to use it to kill each other. That's what they want. That's what it's all about. It's about war because that's mankind's nature. His nature is that he has to fight against everyone and himself. That's the sad part. Most humans fight themselves more than they fight anybody. But yet when the Kingdom comes, the Last Great Day, we're going back to Eden, what is it like? Micah the fourth chapter:

Micah 4:1-4 But it will be in the end of the days, the mountain of the house of YAHWEH will be established in the top of the mountains.

Comment: Right? Think of the top of the mountains and there's no higher mountain in the world than Mount Zion, not physically ... not physically but spiritually. There's **no taller mountain in the world than Mount Zion**. That's where Yahweh's Kingdom is established for. That's where we've been. Many of you have seen it and that's our last stop. **That's our hope**, right? So that's why **we love Israel**. We love Jerusalem and we're looking for that day when the Messiah returns because we know He's bringing all of us back there. So the ...

Micah 4:1-3 mountain of the house of YAHWEH will be established in the top of the mountains and it will be lifted up from the hills; and peoples will flow on to it. And many nations will come and say, Come, and let us go up to the mountain of YAHWEH, and to the house of the Elohim of Jacob. And He will teach us from His ways, and we will walk in His paths. For the Torah will go forth out of Mount Zion, and the Word of YAHWEH from Jerusalem ... Right? That's what our ministry is all about that we're bringing the Word of Yahweh from Jerusalem to the nations ... And He will judge between many people, and He will decide for strong nations afar off. And they will beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks. Nation will not lift up a sword against nation, nor will they learn war anymore.

Comment: Israel is a tiny nation; they're not a big nation. And we know Yahweh's hand is always with His people even when He has to spank them a little bit. Overall, we know that He's still there with them. And you think about it, it's not easy for a little nation like that when you have five hundred million Arabs around you that want to destroy you. It's not an easy situation. But in this day they won't have to worry about that. And this day, like it says when the Spirit of Yahweh is there, not only will they fear it because Yahweh is with them; they won't have any desire to do it. So what does this show us? Verse 4:

Micah 4:4 each one sit under his vine and under his fig tree, and there will be no trembling. For the mouth of YAHWEH of Hosts has spoken.

That the very nature of man will be changed, it's not just that we don't have the opportunity or the circumstances to do this because all of the weapons of war are going to be melted into plowshares and stuff. There will be **no desire in the heart of man for war**. And I think we're going to tell our children and our grandchildren at that time when we're sharing with them the world that was before. And the same way now that it's hard for us to concept this because it's been a long time since we've been in Eden, our children will be the same way opposite.

They'll say, Daddy or Grandpa, really? There were people that actually would want to hurt each other? Really, there were people that want to kill each other? They'll have no concept because the heart of man, the mind of man, the nature of man will be completely changed ... it'll be completely changed, even in the animals, everything. It's going to be like Eden again; it's going to be that **perfect environment**. There will be no more war in the Kingdom because **humans will only think of love**, not war. The very nature of human beings will be changed. 2nd Kings 6 in verse 25 ... 2nd Kings 6 in verse 25:

2nd Kings 6:25-27 And there was a great famine in Samaria. And behold! They were laying siege to it until the head of a donkey was at eighty silver pieces ... wow, that's got to be a pretty bad famine ... and a fourth of a cab of dove's dung at five silver pieces. And it happened; the king of Israel was passing by the wall. And a woman cried to him, saying, Save, my master, O king. And he said, If YAHWEH does not save you, from where shall I save you? Out of the threshing floor, or out of the winevat?

2nd Kings 6:28-30 And the king said to her, What ails you? And she said, This woman said to me, Give your son and we will eat him today; and tomorrow we will eat my son. And we boiled my son and ate him, and I said to her on the next day, Give your son, that we may eat him. But she hid her son. And it happened when the king heard the words of the woman, he tore his garments. And he was passing by on the wall, and the people looked. And, behold, the sackcloth was inside on his flesh.

Can you imagine getting to that point eating their own children? It's part of the consequence of the fall of man; famine in the world; famine and pestilence. COVID-19, there was no COVID-19 in Eden. But this is what you're looking at. This is the way that was there. Yet, when the Kingdom comes, what's going to happen? Joel 2 ... Joel the second chapter ... and again, man getting food by the sweat of his brow ... part of the consequences that is. There'll be time where there's not enough food. Famine would bring, and then wow, you see those unimaginable conditions. So Joel 2 in verse 12:

Joel 2:12-14 Yet even now turn to Me with all your heart, and with fasting, with weeping, and with wailing ... right? Repentance from the bottom of your heart ... declares YAHWEH. Tear your heart, and not your robes; and turn to YAHWEH your Elohim. For He is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and He pities concerning the evil. Who knows if He will turn and have pity and leave a blessing behind you, a food offering and a drink offering for YAHWEH your Elohim? ... drop down to verse 18:

Joel 2:18-19 Then YAHWEH will be jealous for His land and have pity on His people. Yea, YAHWEH will answer and say to His people, Behold, I will send you **grain, and wine, and oil**, and you shall be satisfied from it. And I will no more make you a disgrace among the nations.

Right? The grain, the wine and the oil, this is about Sukkot. The **grain** is where we get our bread; the staple of life. The **oil** is where we get for medicinal and healing and things like olive oil are very, very healthy for you. And the **wine** is always showing happiness; it means that Yahweh's blessing is there. Right, that's why at weddings they have a toast with wine because it's showing Yahweh's completeness, His happiness and His blessing ... drop down to verse 21:

Joel 2:21-24 Fear not, O land, be glad and rejoice, for YAHWEH is doing great things. Fear not, beasts of the field, for the pastures of the wilderness grow green, for the tree bears its fruit, the fig tree and the vine give their strength ... right? The Garden of Eden all over again ... Then be glad, sons of Zion, and rejoice in YAHWEH your Elohim. For He has given to you the early rain according to righteousness, and He will cause the rain to come down upon you, the early rain and the latter rain in the first month ... and we're living in that time of the latter rain. We're seeing that Yahweh is blessing His people and He's blessing His Congregation and He's bringing people to faith and He's giving us our needs ... And the floors shall be full with grain, and the wine shall overflow with wine and oil.

Joel 2:25-27 And I will restore to you the years which the swarming locust has eaten, the locust larvae, and the stripping locust, and the cutting locust, My great army which I sent among you ... And we saw that this year; the locust armies came and devoured many places in Africa but the people of Yahweh, didn't touch! Yahweh didn't even have to restore it, He never took it ... And you shall eat fully and be satisfied; and you shall praise the name of YAHWEH your Elohim, who has dealt wondrously with you. And My people shall not be ashamed forever. And you shall know that I am in the midst of Israel, and that I am YAHWEH your Elohim, and there is no other. And My people shall not be ashamed forever.

Praise Yahweh ... praise Yahweh! The consequences of the fall of man, **the redemption**, the redemption of Yahweh, this is where we're going back to. Yahweh will redeem mankind for what's lost when Yahshua brings His Kingdom. Romans 3 ... Romans 3 in verse 10 like He says:

Romans 3:10-12, 23 According as it has been written, "There is none righteous, not one!" "There is not one understanding; there is not one seeking YAHWEH." All turned away, they became worthless together, **not one** is doing goodness, not so much as one!"... in verse 23 ... for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of YAHWEH,

This is the consequence of man, like I said; in the Garden mankind was the friend of Elohim. There was a one on one personal relationship that was there that was lost through the fall of man. Yet, what's here, what's coming? Jeremiah 31 in verse 31, the New Covenant:

Jeremiah 31:31-32 Behold, the days come, says YAHWEH, that I will cut a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah, not according to the covenant that I cut with their fathers in the day I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt (which covenant of Mine they broke, although I was to be a husband to them, says YAHWEH).

Jeremiah 31:33-34 But this will be the covenant that I will cut with the house of Israel: After those days, declares YAHWEH, I will put My Torah in their inward parts, and I will write it on their hearts; and I will be their Elohim, and they will be My people. And they shall no longer each man teach his neighbor, and each man his brother, saying, Know YAHWEH. For they shall all know Me, from the least of them even to the greatest of them, declares YAHWEH. Because I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sins no more.

Wow, so this like I said, for us today it's frustrating enough when we have to go to the world and they don't want to hear it; but it's even, it's even heart rendering to us when our family and the people we love don't hear; but He says in this day everybody will. Anybody that's there will hear Yahweh; will have a relationship with everyone. Revelation 21 in verse 3:

Revelation 21:3-7 And I heard a great voice out of Heaven, saying, Behold, **the tabernacle of YAHWEH is with men!** And his tabernacle with them, and they will be His people, and YAHWEH Himself will be with them as their Elohim. And YAHWEH will wipe away every tear from their eyes. And **death shall be no longer**, nor mourning, nor wailing, nor will there be pain anymore; for the former things have passed away. And the One sitting on the throne said, Behold! I make

all things new. And He says to me, Write, because **these Words are faithful and true**. And He said, It is done! I am the Aleph and the Tav, the Beginning and the Ending. To the one thirsting, I will freely give of the fountain of the Water of Life. The one overcoming will inherit all things, and I will be Elohim to him, and he will be My son.

Yahweh Himself will be with His people in all the earth for that matter. Every single person on earth will have a relationship with Yahweh. Isaiah 65 in verse 21 ... Isaiah 65 in verse 21:

Isaiah 65:20-22 There shall not still be an infant of days, or an old man that has not filled his days. For the youth shall die the son of a hundred years, but the sinner the son of a hundred years will be accursed ... so there will be no more abortion. There'll be no more suffering. There'll be no more infant death. There'll be none of these things in the Kingdom ... And they will build houses and live in them; and they shall plant vineyards and eat their fruit. They shall not plant, and another live in them; they shall not plant, and another eat. For like the days of the trees are the days of My people; and My elect will grow old to the work of their hands.

Comment: No more one percent controlling everything. As somebody works, they'll be rewarded, **everybody getting the work of their hands**. You're not going to build a house for someone else, but for yourself, and live in it; every man under his own vine and fig tree.

Isaiah 65:23-24 They shall not labor in vain, nor bring forth for terror. For they are the seed of the beloved ones of YAHWEH, and their offspring with them. It will be, before they call, I will answer. While they are speaking, I will hear ... right? The oneness of mind ... the oneness of mind. We will have the mind of Yahweh; and before we even say it. Just like with Yahweh and Yahshua, He'll know what we need and He'll bring it to us; and the same with us because we're only seeking His will.

Isaiah 65:25The wolf and the lamb will feed as one; the lion shall eat straw like the ox. And dust will be the food of the snake. They shall not do evil nor destroy in all My holy mountain ... Mount Zion ... says YAHWEH.

Wow, world will be back to Eden; no more injustices. Like I said, no more one percent controlling and enslaving the world. No more commercial Babylon making slaves of the souls of men but each will help his neighbor and give all he has but only take what he needs. And how blessed are we that Yahweh is allowing us today to make communities all over the earth and be prototypes of that? I don't know of any other congregation in the world that's doing what Yahweh's doing with us because it won't work with most of the time unless you surrender.

And like I said, since 2014, we're only growing. There's not one community that fell apart; everyone is only prospering and growing. And what a blessing that Yahweh is allowing us ... we're His sons, we're His children, we're His prototype and He's allowing us to do this on a world-wide level to show, to give a little glimpse of hope to a world without hope. That this is the way the Kingdom will be. Isaiah 35 ... Isaiah 35 ... be ending soon ... Isaiah 35 because we're going back to Eden and this is what this day is all about. The Last Great Day, the end of Yahweh's planned when we're going back to Eden.

Isaiah 35:1-2 The wilderness and the dry land shall rejoice for them; and the desert will exult and bloom like the crocus. Surely, it will bloom and exult, even with joy and singing. Lebanon's glory will be given to it, the honor of Carmel and Sharon; they will see the glory of YAHWEH, the majesty of our Elohim.

Comment: So this is starting Mount Zion, Jerusalem, Israel – that's where the redemption takes place. This is where the transformation takes place. That's where Eden was and then it will go throughout all the world ... let's drop down to verse 5:

Isaiah 35:5 Then the eyes of the blind will be opened, and the ears of the deaf opened.

Comment: And Yahweh is doing that in our Congregation today. Not just spiritually; which He's been doing for a long time, but physically, physically that elders are laying hands on people that are blind and being healed or deaf and being healed instantly in some cases.

Isaiah 35:6-7 Then the lame shall leap like a deer, and the tongue of the dumb will sing. For waters will break out in the wilderness, and streams in the desert ... and I say this in Israel this already happened down in the deserts, artesian wells and water springing from nowhere ... And the mirage shall become a pool, and the thirsty land will become springs of water, in the home of jackals, in its lair, and the place for the reed and rush.

Isaiah 35:8-10 And **a highway will be there**, and a way, and it will be called, **The Way of Holiness**. The unclean will not pass over it. And it is for them, the one going in the way; fools shall not go astray. **No lion shall be there**; and no wild beast will go up on it; it shall not be found there. But redeemed ones shall walk. And **the ransomed of YAHWEH will return and enter Zion, with singing and everlasting joy on their head; gladness and joy shall reach them; and sorrow and sighing shall flee.**

So we have to think about that. We're living in the worst time man has ever known; it's stressful some time on us, the living situations, like I said, what we're going through now with COVID and all these things, but **this has got to be hope!** We have to keep those blinders on. **This is our vision because we're right there**. We're very close. We're right at that end and **we have to believe because of how close we are**. We're going back to Eden and like I say, **it's a mentality as well as a reality**. You have to live in that mentality every day. We have to live in it. Isaiah 66 in verse 22 it says:

Isaiah 66:22-23 For as the new heavens and the new earth which I make stand before Me, declares YAHWEH, so your seed and your name shall stand. And it will be, from new moon to its new moon, and from Sabbath to Sabbath, **all flesh will come and worship before Me**, says YAHWEH ... from new moon to new moon, and from Sabbath to Sabbath, all flesh will come and worship before Me.

Comment: And I think about this all the time. This is one of my favorite scriptures because I think about even when I was only 18/19 years old and I'm going to services, it's a Saturday and you're driving to services and everybody you see, people going to play softball and then you see people working and you see people gardening, you see people doing all this stuff, going to malls; and I'm like this one guy going to a Sabbath meeting and I think of this. When that day comes, when the Kingdom is here **every single human being** that's around you will be walking. There'll be hundreds by the hundreds and by the thousands all walking **with Bible in hand** and you don't have to guess where they're going to.

Isaiah 66:23 from new moon to new moon, and from Sabbath to Sabbath, all flesh will come and worship before Me ... all flesh, not just human beings.

Like I said, it'll be like the Garden of Eden again. The symphony of creation, every day when we wake up we'll hear the birds and we'll hear the animals and we'll hear the wind in the trees; we'll hear all this creation worshipping Yahweh; and we'll be going back to Eden. And it's been a tough 6000 years, more for Yahweh than us. Although a day to Him is like a thousand years but He's had to live through all of this and He's had to watch it, can't be easy.

But now, we're right at the end. Now we're at that very end and Heaven's getting ready and there's a lot of murmur up there and the cherubs are getting ready to go out and do what they're going to do; and they're all excited because **the Scriptures I'm reading are about to become a reality**. And that's why Yahweh doesn't just give us the seven days of Sukkot; He gives us the Last Great Day because **once this happens it will never go back** ... it will never go back.

You know there's things like ... there's people who fight cancer and it might be a five year battle cancer and it's great and you're fighting and you overcome it but then you're still going to get sick and die. You know Lazarus, the great story in the Bible ... *Lazarus come forth!* And he comes out and what a story! But 'x' amount of years later he got sick and died. This is where there's time no more. This is where this is forever! When this comes, we're never going back again. We're never going back to what we read in Genesis 3. It's the Last Great Day because that day will bring us into eternity forever. What a great time to think about this! How wonderful! Galatians 3 and 13 ... Galatians 3:13 says:

Galatians 3:13 Messiah redeemed us from the curse of the Torah, having become a curse for us; for it has been written, "Cursed is everyone having been hung on a tree;"

He redeemed us from that curse of the Torah. What is that curse? We read it in Genesis 3. The curse was not believing Yahweh and taking satan, taking the serpent, taking his word and his world and his society instead of Yahweh's. And like I said, can't blame Adam, can't blame me, every one of us has done the same thing. Every one of us has had freewill and anyone of us could have chosen to go in another direction. We didn't have to choose to disobey Yahweh but every one of us has but praise Him that Yahweh had a second Adam. Praise. Him He had a plan B; and He didn't need a plan C. Yahweh's perfect, He didn't even need a plan B because He could have did something different, but He did it for us; because if He didn't have a plan B we wouldn't be here today.

So the second Adam redeemed what the first Adam lost. And like I said, we are here today to be a witness of that – let my life praise You. Our life is the thing that praises Yahweh. Our life is the thing that shows there really is a second Adam. Our life is the thing that shows we're going back to Eden. Yahshua not only conquered sin, He ended the curse of Adam. The curse of sweating for the food and having to work in thorns and thistles will end as well as the curse of broken families – divorce, wild animals, killing people, all of this will end; the curse of severe weather and earthquakes ravaging cities. I don't know if you've seen this summer with California, the worse they ever had with wildfires and all these things. But severe weathers, earthquakes, fires, all these things will be a thing of the past no more.

The curse of pestilence and famine; and because of COVID and different things, and the locusts, they're predicting a very, very bad famine coming in Africa this year. Praise Yahweh our Congregations are set but we still think of all the other people there. And there'll be at least they said, thirty to fifty million new people going into famine this coming winter. So something we need to keep in prayer. But no more famine; the curse of famine, the curse of disease and sickness, COVID will be completely eradicated; we're going back to Eden.

Yahshua will bring a new world. He will bring us back to Eden. Like I said, which is not only a place; it's a mentality. And Yahweh commands us to enter that mentality every seventh day but it's up to you. You can live in that every day of your life. I know I do. I live in that mentality every day of my life. I eat, I breathe, I taste it and I know how close it is. And that's why as much it weighs down my spirit seeing the world out here and the things while the Spirit of Yahweh just lifts it up to the Heavens because I know that Eden is just around the corner.

I know what's coming and like I said, every day I go to bed and every day I wake up because we're on time, there is a time where Yahshua and He says, only the Father knows the time, the day and the hour; there's a specific one. But **every day you go to bed and every day you wake up is one day closer to that!** And once it's here, it'll be there forever. Once it's here we'll have it forever.

A way of life that trusts and believes Yahweh 100%! When you tell your grandchildren in the Kingdom you mention, "Well there was this thing called doubt in the old world." And they'll say, "Huh?" "Doubt" "Grandpa, I don't know that word. What do you mean doubt?" "Well, there were people that actually they weren't so sure if what Yahweh said in

the Bible were true. And they were actually people that said the Bible." And they'll be like, they'll be scared, "What, how could that be? Yahweh's forever!" They won't even be able to concept it.

It's a way of life that believes and trusts Yahweh 100% in His Word and loves his neighbor as himself. The only way to get there is to *unconditionally* reject the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil; reject free choice and freewill to make your own decisions apart from the Word of Yahweh.

We need to *unconditionally* believe Yahweh in all things to love Him with all our heart, our mind, our soul and our strength; and to only take from the Tree of Life. Here it is, almost 6000 years. We're that close. Yahweh brought us here, what a special Feast. It's the Last Great Day but now we go back and we're one year closer to Mount Zion and closer to going back to Eden.

I hope you're encouraged. I know I am. You read these Scriptures, they're true, they're 100% and we're getting close to it. So it's been a wonderful time to spend with all of you and just a really, really special Feast. Yahweh bless, Chag Semeach!
