Transcript – The Timing of Yahweh

Shabbat Shalom. Praise Yahweh for the good weather that we are having and beautiful Shabbat that we are having. I wanted to go over a message today called, *Yahweh's Timing*. I'm going to start in Ecclesiastes, the third chapter and the first eight verses.

Ecclesiastes 3:1-8 To all there is an appointed time, even a time for every purpose under heaven: time to be born, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to pull up what is planted; a time to kill, and a time to heal; a time to tear down, and a time to build up; a time to weep, and a time to laugh; a time to mourn, and a time to dance; a time to throw away stones, and a time to gather stones; a time to embrace, and a time to refrain from embracing; a time to seek, and a time to let wander; a time to keep, and a time to throw away; a time to tear, and a time to sew together; a time to keep silent, and a time to speak; a time to love, and a time to hate; a time of war, and a time of peace.

So, one of my favorite verses that I just read, because I think it's so great; really when you are reading it... really what is showing is Yahweh's timing. That so many things in life like we talked about with emotions so many times, emotions are trigger points; and they are there to control our emotions, but not suppress them. There's a time for everything...there's a time for everything; and I know probably in this room...you know everybody in this room there's somebody that you're missing. There's somebody that you wish you could be with, there's somebody; or maybe somewhere you wish you could be at a certain time, which is normal.

Probably, just about everybody in the world is that way. If not, somebody would be pretty lonely; if they are somewhere and they just don't think of anybody if you're there by yourself. In this scripture, we are out of Babylon now about fourteen years; and this scripture that I read before we left America Babylon really, really helped me to keep things in perspective. I remember when we were leaving it was very hard on my parents because we are very close family. I remember telling my mom that for now on, I said, "we're not going to have quantity of time, but we're going to have quality at time."

So, we're not going to see each other every day, but when we do see each other, there's going-to be points to it. And as time is going on, it wasn't that I stopped missing my family; because I love my family, but I would think to myself; sometimes when you feel like you're missing somebody, think on the other side.

Okay, so now, what if you get to see that person, then what? Like my family, I love my family; but what would happen if I saw my family?

My family is not converted; my family aren't believers. What's going to happen then? So I stop the work of Yahweh, I stop everything I'm doing, I stop my bearing fruits and I sit around the table with my family? So again, when I would see my family every year, every two years or whatever, it was great. You would see each other for a few days and that was the time to see them. That was the time to spend with them. That was a time to honor my parents, but after those days were over, I was ready to move on. I was ready to get back to the work of Yahweh.

That's the thing that you have to think about. I've said this many times, **people** spend most of their time regretting the past, or worrying about the future; and when you do that, you miss the now... and that's Yahweh's timing....that's YAHWEH's timing. If you remember, I'm going to refer a couple of times in this message to something that Sharon said when she was here, "it's a great time to be me", and it's a great time to be you...it's a great time to be you.

Do you realize that one third of the Bible is prophecy? This Bible is pretty thick; one third of every three pages on average is prophecy. Ninety percent of that prophecy is for the time we're living in right now; ninety percent of it; and ninety percent of the prophecy is about what? It's about Yahweh redeeming this land of Israel, redeeming the people of Israel and redeeming the Covenant.

That's what most of what's happening in the end time...and I say that in people I don't care what church, religion, whatever you believe...but if you're not following, if you're not understanding, if you're not praying, if you have no concept of what Yahweh's doing in Israel in the end times; then you have no concept of what Yahweh is doing; because most of what He's doing, in the times we're living in, is right in this land.

So now, when you think about that; what an honor to be here, yeah, it's a great time to be me; it's a great time to be you! You know why? Because there are thousands upon thousands of brethren around the world and it's a great time to be them too, if they're first fruits. It's a great time to be the person who's not a first fruit yet; who will be called through the work we're doing here. It's a great time to be the Christian that may not be a first fruit; but will live through the tribulation and actually be here when Yahshua is here; and be the first human being in His Kingdom.

So, it's a great time to be a lot of people; but when our mind is focused on, there's a time for war, there's a time for peace and during the time of war if you're thinking about peace, you know what's going to happen? You're going to get your throat slit and you're going to die. And if it's the time for peace; like the time with Solomon there was peace in the whole kingdom and you're a war monger like Joab, what happened? You got your throat slit; because during the time of peace, we don't need a Joab; and during the time of war, and you don't need somebody who is afraid to fight.

There's a time for peace, there's a time for war; there's a time for one thing, there's a time for everything. So, I said by understanding everything in our life, when you're a first fruit, is Yahweh's timing and you got to embrace it...you got to embrace it. You have got to embrace it; because if you don't embrace this fact, you will never live to fulfill the potential that Yahweh has for you.

So, the first thing we think of also, like I said, there's nothing wrong with missing people. There's nothing wrong with thinking of situations; maybe thinking of a feast, there are many people that during the year, what gets them through the year thinking of the memory of being here in Israel. The fact that wow, I'll be there again in a few months when the next feast is.

But the first thing we want to think of, is it even in the will of Yahweh what we're missing? If we're missing unconverted relatives, if we're missing people that are not going to draw us closer to Yahweh; if we're missing people that have no interest in the work of Yahweh, is it really going to make you stronger? That's why I say, what if Yahweh wishes...remember I did a message a while back, Watch What You Pray For...what if you Yahweh gives you that prayer?

Like I said, there's no one on this earth that loves their family more than I do; but I thank Yahweh that He took me out of Babylon when he did. I mean I have hundreds of cousins and uncles and aunts; and I love every one of them, but not one of them has anything to do with the work of Yahweh. So my work is the work of Yahweh.

Well like I was saying to somebody a few days ago, when we left Babylon, we never built another life outside of Babylon. Besides our relationship with my parents, I have no other life; not even my brothers and I love my brothers. They're good people; if they called me, anything they need; but I have no life with

my brothers. I don't talk to them, hardly ever, never see them; unless maybe once every year or two. Like I said, I love them and I would do anything for them; but really there is no life there anymore; because my life is the work of Yahweh...my life is the work of Yahweh.

The greatest time in the world is to be you, because you're here. The other thing is we're not going to be here forever. There's a time for everything...there's a time for everything. Today, we're sitting here in the Sea of Galilee as part of a wonderful work of Yahweh. You could blink your eye and tomorrow you can be in a prison somewhere in Romania, you could be somewhere in South America, you could be dead.

So, who knows what tomorrow is bringing; but today, you're here...today you're here. Today you're part of something that you know Yahweh is doing; because everything Yahweh is doing is here in the Land of Israel in the end time, absolutely everything Yahweh is doing. So you want to embrace it because it's not always going to be here.

There's a time to be in Israel, there's a time to be out of Israel. **Everything is a time for Yahweh**. Like I said, all the scriptures is telling us is Yahweh's timing; and **this is the key to life, you've got to embrace Yahweh's timing**. As a spirit-filled child of Yahweh, and we're going to see from the examples here, **every single thing in your life, every step, every day, every situation, is being set by Yahweh and His Spirit for you.**

The key is; are you going to understand and embrace it and fulfill your will to it? Or are you going to be sorrowful that you're not doing something else? Like I said, remember most people in life will lose most of their time regretting the past or worrying about the future; and when you do that, you lose the now. Because the past is never coming back, good, bad or indifferent...hey we got to go back to the days of the 1940s...it's never coming back again, they're gone. The future isn't here yet and for all we know, we can die this very day.

So we can't worry about the future or regret the past; we have to do the now. We have to bear the fruit now, while we have the opportunity. And the other thing you have to think about, is that everything that we do desire, if it's rightly so, there's nothing wrong with desiring to be around our loved ones. Nothing wrong with desiring, many people desire to be here in the land of Israel. Nothing wrong

for these desires; but we have to realize that whatever we are missing, Yahweh will restore; sometime, either in this life or the next life.

So for me, I think to myself, "hey you know what, I had pretty good parents." Praise Yahweh for that; and I'll have an eternity to spend with my parents when the timing is right. But if I don't fulfill Yahweh's purpose in my life, I might not be there. And how terrible that would be, when the Kingdom comes to have my parents resurrected in the White Throne Judgment and be there, and all of a sudden their son's not there; because I disqualified myself as a firstfruit, because I didn't fulfill the will Yahweh had in my life. Remember, to much is given, much is expected. The more that's given, the more will be required.

And to unconverted relatives, they have a much lower bar. They have a different judgment; but for us that Yahweh has opened up our mind **He's got a great purpose He's working and we have to fulfill that**. **We have to walk in faith and fulfill that**. We always say, *Yahweh is my Shepherd, I shall not lack*. When we're sorrowful to the point where we're not being able to really function, Yahweh is not my Shepherd anymore; we're denying the scripture *Yahweh is my Shepherd, I shall not lack* more than I shall not want. I shall not lack which means when Yahweh is my Shepherd, there's nothing I lack. That if you were on a desert island for the next thirty years, or if you're in a prison somewhere, like I said in Romania or Russia, if you're being tortured on the other side of the world, you're lacking nothing; because Yahweh is your Shepherd; because Yahweh is with you every step of the way.

Because as we were saying here because we embrace to the fullest extent, the blood of our Savior Yahshua that He shed for us; right here in this Land almost two thousand years ago. By being overly depressed we deny Him and we lose focus of the goal. With Yahweh, that should be all we need, with Yahweh that will be all you need; because one thing that is certain in this life, we are old enough to know this; that people will die, people will move away, people will fall away. It's part of life. We have to learn to be content with Yahweh alone. Unfortunately, through life, I've seen it; I've seen people, a husband or wife very, very strong couple; one dies, the other one falls away. "How could Yahweh allow this? How could He allow this one to die?"

For six thousand years everyone dies. We're not eternal. What do you mean how can He allow to die; it's going to happen. We have to get used to it, it's going to happen in our life. People will die, that's part of life. There's a time to be born, there's a time to die. People move away. Like I said, you never see in

the Bible where a congregation, one particular group of people, is the congregation and they're there together. Today, we're all here together, next year it could be different people. You could be somewhere else, you could be starting a congregation, and you could be leading a congregation.

Like I said, you could be in a prison, who knows? But we know that the Congregation of Yahweh is a spiritual organism; it's not an organization. And unfortunately, people will fall away. So, what is going to cause you to fall away? The fact that your pastor, your best friend, your husband, your wife, your child, they fell away. Not me, because I know on Judgment Day the only One that is going to be before me is Yahweh; and I pray every day of my life that Yahshua will be there at my right side; as my only Advocate, before the Father, to defend me before Him by His shed blood. That's all that matters.

I pray for my family every day. I pray for my wife. I pray for my daughter. I pray for my friends, pray for you; but in the end of the day, everyone has to work out their own salvation with fear and trembling. We're heading into a time, the worst time the world will ever know; and chances are, that somebody you know will be dead; a hundred percent or fall away or something else. Chances are most of us will be dead if ninety-nine percent of people are going to die.

So, we've got to get used to it. You have to mentally be strong enough to know it's not about this life. It's not about these few measly days that come and go. Sixty, seventy, eighty years maybe; it's not about that. It's about the Kingdom of Yahweh that's coming. It's about Daniel 2:44, that when Yahshua returns, He will crush every kingdom of this earth to the ground. The stone cut without hands; and that Kingdom will go on forever. And each of us has been called for a job now today.

We've all been here several years; and we always say all the time, "why me? I can't believe He called me"; but we're passed that point. We all can't believe it. It's unbelievable. It's not about why He called me. Like I always say, I understand exactly why He called me; because **He calls the weak of the world**, that's why he called me. Of course He would call me. Praise Yahweh. I'm glad I couldn't get any weaker and that's why He could make me stronger. If I was a real strong person then He couldn't have called me.

So we know why He called us; because He gets the glory, when He can work with people like us. But now we're passed there. Now we know He called us, we worked on our spiritual gifts, we know what we can do, we know what we

can't do; and now is the time to work; because if you're not working, you're going to fall away. There's a time to rest, there's a time to work. This is the time to work.

I've met many people who are single and they're depressed; because they're not married. Like I said, when I first became a believer I was a young man, maybe eighteen or nineteen years old, had a hundred seventy something single men in the congregation and one single woman. Wow, talk about her schedule, to make a date you have to do it six months out. To get a date to services; but people were always depressed. I was never depressed as a single; because I would say, "hey, the way not to be depressed is serving other people." Every month, I would have a dinner over my house. I'd invite a family, I would invite a widow, I'd invite a single person; I try to serve. That's the way you stop from being depressed.

And then like I said, singles are depressed when they're not married and then people get married and you know what? They're depressed, because they don't have kids. Well, if they only have a kid, if I only have a child and then they have a child and you know what? They are depressed because they don't have more children; and then people have a whole bunch of children and you know what happens, a few years go on and then they are depressed because they are not a grandparent. And then they become a grandparent and one of the grandparents dies and then they're depressed; because they don't have their spouse.

It's the life cycle that this is life; but life, when you understand it, is that there can always be something that you don't have. There is always can be something you don't have; but yet, **whatever you focus on becomes most real to you**. So, think of how much more you do have. Think of how much more you do have because you know how great it is to be married; the Bible also says, that for the un-married, they can serve Yahweh completely.

So it's great to be single and it's great to be married. It's great to be married without children; because you can travel or go around and do all these things, and it's great to have children. It's great to have one child that you can give all your focus to; and it's great to have multiple children, that they can all play together. Yahweh's timing...its Yahweh's timing and that's the point, when you're depressed and unhappy in your situation, you're depressed at one person, Yahweh. "Yahweh, why aren't I married, Yahweh, why am I single? Yahweh, why don't I have children, why don't I have ten children?"

Whatever you're thinking you're lacking, you're showing it toward Yahweh; and everything in His time. Life is always changing. People will always come into your life. People are always going to leave your life. People are going to live, people are going to die. It's part of life. It doesn't mean we don't mourn, of course we do. *There's a time to mourn and there's a time to laugh.* So when someone dies, you're not going to sit there and say, "Oh I'm not going to mourn." Because it's Yahweh's will. No, you mourn for the time and then you move on; you have to, you never forget the person; but you move on, because that's part of life.

There's a time to mourn and there's a time to laugh. There's a time to live, there's a time to die. But what we understand is Yahweh never leaves us. You must grasp this timing in your life. Like I said, it's a great time to be you and it's a great time to be you; and I'll tell you something, there's about a million people out there that would love to be each and every one of you; believe me when I say it.

Appreciate today, as tomorrow may be worse. I mean you think about it, we've had a pretty good time here. What you're doing, you're volunteering; everything has been awesome. So, who knows, maybe tomorrow will be better. Maybe that pot of gold will just come shining down when we see the next rainbow and hit us all in the head. Maybe Yahweh will put all these things in our laps, who knows?

But you know on the other side of it, maybe this is the best that it's going to get in a physical stance. We know war is coming. We know the tribulation is coming. We know the worst time Yahweh ever said is coming. Why not appreciate every day we got here now that is good? Why not appreciate it; because I can't think of too many bad things around this community. I really can't. This is one of the greatest times of our life and it's almost like a dream to me. To be around true believers that loves each other; to care for each other, everybody pulling together.

It's a great time to be us and everybody that comes around at the school this year, people are just flawed how so many people can live together, work together, serve each other; without not even one problem. So it really is, its a great time to be you. And like I said, not knowing if tomorrow will bring; embrace it. Embrace the wonderful things that Yahweh has blessed each and every one of us. We don't know, tomorrow could be worse.

Death may take more of our loved ones. Sickness can immobilize us. It happens so quick. You can be driving down the road; drunken driver comes and smashes

and I can be crippled the rest of my life. So appreciate today I've got legs, appreciate yesterday that we were walking around up there in the mountains, the day may come up that I'm too old to do it. Each one of us was able to walk and see the beauty of Yahweh. What a wonderful day! Appreciate every moment that we have.

If you don't focus on and grasp what you have today, you'll never fulfill your calling. It really is a beautiful calling that Yahweh has for each and every one of us. Like I said, most spend time regretting the past or worrying about the future. You must capture today; embrace it.

If we go to **Genesis 1:14** And Elohim said, Let light sources be in the expanse of the heavens, to divide between the night and the day. And let them be for signs and for seasons, and for days and years.

Light sources simply recognizing Yahweh's clock, is simply His judicial order; and that's what Yahweh's timing is. Yahweh's timing is simply Yahweh's judicial order. Time from creation there was a time for the flood, there was a time for the Covenant with Abraham. There was a time for Israel to go into Egypt, we're just talking about, and there was a time for Israel to leave Egypt. During the two hundred fifteen years of hard bondage of the children of Israel in Egypt, many would have wanted to leave, right? But it wasn't the time...it wasn't the time.

There was a time for the Death Angel to pass and there was a time to put the blood on the door. If your timing was off you would have died. Time to have sickness, time to be healed; you must understand everything in Yahweh's timing. One of the reasons why I, much rather like, the earlier Passover than the later one; if I was early by a day, the blood is still on the door. If I was late by a couple hours, I'm dead. So there's a time for everything.

Galatians 4:4 says But when the fullness of the time came, YAHWEH sent forth His Son, having come into being out of a woman, being subject to the Torah,

Yahshua was not a Druze. He didn't just pop out of the leg of a pants of a man. There was a specific time that it was prophesized that He would come. Yahweh's timing. Everything in Yahweh's perfect timing. And time for the Messiah to appear and a time for the Messiah to die, a time for the Congregation to start; a time for the Congregation to go into the wilderness; and a time for the Congregation to come out of the wilderness.

A time for Yahweh's work to cease in Jerusalem and then a time at the end for Yahweh's work to start again in Jerusalem; everything according to Yahweh's perfect timing. When you understand this concept I'm telling you, it is so empowering in your life; because if you can conquer time, if you can understand everything in Yahweh's timing, Satan has no hold over you; because no matter what you're going through, you realize its Yahweh's timing.

That nothing is happening in your life that Yahweh is not allowing. Look at Job, everything is going great and boom, one day he loses everything; but he kept his perspective, at least in the beginning. You know naked I came to the world and naked I go out of the world. He's understanding everything is in Yahweh's timing.

Revelation 9:13-15 And the sixth cherub trumpeted. And I heard one voice out of the four horns of the golden altar before YAHWEH, saying to the sixth cherub who had the trumpet, release the four cherubs, those having been bound at the great river Euphrates. And the four cherubs were released, those having been prepared for the hour and day and month and year, that they should kill the third part of men.

A time for peace and a time for war. These cherubs are there. They're ready for the day, the hour and the year that this should happen. There's a time for it. There's a time this will happen, there's a time it will not happen. In Revelation, almost everything is timed; seven bowls, seven trumpets, seven seals. Almost everything in the book of Revelation is timed.

Two witnesses will prophesy exactly 1260 days. The beast power will reign exactly for forty-two months. It's all timed. So again, by understanding this, by being in Yahweh's will, by understanding Yahweh's perfect timing; it will help us to get through it; and we will never have doubt during it; because it's Yahweh's timing. I want to go through some examples in the Bible that teach us this, about Yahweh's timing to help us understand the concept a little bit better. First one is in 1 Kings 20. 1 Kings 20 and verse 35:

1 Kings 20:35-36 And a certain man of the sons of the prophets said to his neighbor, By the Word of YAHWEH, please strike me. And the man refused to strike him. And he said to him, because you have not listened to the voice of YAHWEH, behold, you shall go from me, and a lion shall kill you. And he left him, and a lion found him and killed him.

Probably nine hundred ninety-nine times out of the thousand, here's a man of Yahweh, he's having fear I'm not going to hit this guy, he's a man of Yahweh. Nine hundred ninety-nine times out of the thousand it would have been the right decision to make; this happened not to be the time for that. This was the time when he said "hit me" to him; because it was Yahweh's timing. Yahweh was trying to make a point. We know the story that happened afterward; he's coming up and showing before the King; but here it was.

Now this guy, was probably a good guy, probably had character. He doesn't want to touch somebody that Yahweh put there. The problem that he didn't know was Yahweh's timing. He didn't understand Yahweh's timing and literally he lost his life.

So again, this is not just a semantic type subject, this is life and death. Because in your life things will come up, that if you don't understand Yahweh's timing ...one of the things that talks about Matthew 24, the very first thing that Yahshua says to watch for, for the end time is deception. But not understanding Yahweh's timing, you are prone to be deceived...you're prone to be deceived. And by understanding Yahweh's timing, is simply, throughout your whole life, being within Yahweh's judicial order.

Because as we're seeing here, there's a time for crying, there's a time for laughing. Neither is wrong, all in their proper time. So **you have to be able to understand Yahweh's will in your life to understand what time to laugh and what time to cry**. If you came into a funeral where everybody is crying; and a young child died, and you started laughing, people would think you're crazy or worse. So you have to understand the concept of this. You have to understand about being in the will of Yahweh and being able to follow His judicial order in His timing. 2 Samuel 6 and verse 5:

2nd Samuel 6:5-7 And David and all the house of Israel were dancing before YAHWEH with all instruments of fir wood, with lyres and with harps, and with tambourines, and with cornets, and with cymbals. And when they came to the threshing floor of Nachon, and Uzzah reached out to the ark of the Elohim, and took hold of it, for the oxen nearly upset it. Then the anger of YAHWEH burned against Uzzah. And the Elohim struck him there for the fault. And he died there by the ark of the Elohim.

Now again, I'm sure he was a pretty good guy, I'm sure his intentions were good. Nine hundred and ninety-nine times out of a thousand, if he was walking by and somebody's cart was falling and he tried to help the person, it would have been fine. He would have probably got a thank you very much sir. This happened not to be that time. How important is it, understanding Yahweh's timing? And what was the really big problem here, we know before this, Yahweh clearly said the Ark of the Covenant should have been held by the Levites, held by poles.

So right off the bat, they were outside of Yahweh's judicial order with bringing the Ark of the Covenant on a cart with oxen; instead of having the Levites following. What happens? This guy gets his life snuffed out from him. So important, extremely important to understand Yahweh's timing. How many people will say, "it doesn't matter, He knows my heart." Sure He knew Uzzah's heart. It made no difference. He died because he was outside of Yahweh's judicial order. 1 Samuel 26 verse 4:

1 Samuel 26:4-11 And David sent spies... and this is when Saul is after him and Saul is going to be put in his hand by Yahweh; and it's interesting what happened ...And David sent spies and he knew that Saul had certainly come to Nachon. And David rose up and came to the place where Saul camped. And David saw the place where Saul lay down. And Abner the son of Ner, his army commander, and Saul were lying within the barricade. And the people were camping all around him. And David answered and said to Ahimelech the Hittite, and to Abishai the son of Zeruiah, Joab's brother, saying, Who shall go down with me to Saul, to the camp? And Abishai said, I will go down with you. And David and Abishai came to the people by night. And, behold, Saul was lying down, sleeping within the barricade. And his spear was stuck into the earth at his head-place. And Abner and all the people were lying all around him. And Abishai said to David, Elohim has shut up your enemy into your hand today. And now please let me strike him with a spear, even to the earth one time, and I will not repeat it to him. And David said to Abishai, Do not destroy him. For who shall put forth his hand against the anointed of YAHWEH and be guiltless? And David said, As YAHWEH lives, except YAHWEH strike him, or his day shall come and he dies, or he goes down and is devoured in battle, far be it from me, by YAHWEH, from putting forth my hand against the anointed of YAHWEH. And now, please take the spear at his head-place, and the jar of water, and we will go.

Wow, talk about understanding Yahweh's timing. Now here's a guy that had every right to go there and kill Saul. Number one, Saul was coming trying to kill him. Number two, David was already anointed king. Number three, he was

already told that he is going to be the ruler over Israel; and yet, David understood Yahweh's timing.

How many times in our life do we jump the gun? How many times in our life do we go before Yahweh? How many times in our life, something that actually would be Yahweh's will, if we waited on Yahweh, do we mess up by doing something too early? So that's the point here. I look at, even sometimes people that will leave the Congregation; or even somebody in leadership, does Yahweh set up one leader and take down another?

Was it just like David said, "When the time is right, Yahweh will take Saul out," and then he'll rightfully get what is his. And yet sometimes people because they can't wait on the time of Yahweh; because they're impatient, they're prideful, they'll take matters into their own hands; leave the Congregation and then many times fall away from there; because they don't know Yahweh's timing...they don't know Yahweh's timing.

There's a time to live, there's a time to die; there's a time to cry, there's a time to laugh, there's a time for war, there's a time for peace. The same with leaders, Yahweh puts one in, Yahweh takes one out. Blessed be the name of Yahweh. So we have to realize in our life, we need to take this example as a good one from David. That even though David knew the will of Yahweh, he waited on Yahweh first. We want to make sure that we're not going before Yahweh; maybe taking, a potentially good situation and messing it up, by going before Yahweh that way.

Genesis 45, another really good example, as we see from Joseph. Sometimes in our life, like I said, many times we spend too much time regretting the past or worrying about the future. Many times we'll start to think and try to blame somebody. Oh it was my father, oh it was my pastor, oh it was my brother, oh it was my boss, oh it was this one, that one. If only this didn't happen, if only that didn't happen. If only I didn't do this, if only this one didn't do this, if only that one didn't do this; but let's look at Yahweh's perfect timing for everything.

Genesis 45:1-5 and this is when Joseph is before his brothers... And Joseph was not able to control himself in regard to those standing beside him. And he called out, Cause every man to go out from me. And no man stood before him as Joseph was making himself known to his brothers. He wept aloud; and the Egyptians and the house of Pharaoh heard. And Joseph said to his brothers, I am Joseph. Is my father still alive? And his brothers were not able to answer him,

for they trembled before him. And Joseph said to his brothers, Now come near to me. And they came near. And he said, I am your brother Joseph, whom you sold into Egypt. And now do not be grieved, and let no anger be in your eyes because you sold me here, for Elohim sent me before you to save life.

Genesis 45:7-8 And Elohim sent me before you to put a remnant in the land for you, and to keep alive for you a great deliverance. And now you did not send me here, but Elohim. And He has placed me for a father to Pharaoh, and for a master in his house, and a ruler in all the land of Egypt.

Wow, talk about perspective. Here's a guy, that he's saying this, after being thirteen years in prison. After being thirteen years in prison, falsely accused, put in there; he had every right to say, I did nothing wrong. He could have had the Job syndrome; but he didn't. He understood he had perfect perspective of Yahweh's timing. He knew that, that time in the prison was preparing him to build the humility that he needed to come and be the second to Pharaoh.

He knew that everything that was there was Yahweh's timing; and he knew ultimately all those years that he sacrificed in the prison and in Egypt and all those things, was to save the nation of Israel. Yahweh sent him before, to prepare him. What a great lesson we can learn from this.

Sometimes when something happens, there's a mean person that's not letting you do one thing, maybe it's Yahweh's will that, that's actually a person being used by Yahweh to push you in another direction. When one door is closing, Yahweh's timing; maybe another door is opening. Like they always say, Yahweh never closes the door without opening a window.

You have to think about this; that every single day of our life, as long as we're in Yahweh's will, He's timing something for us. So like I say it doesn't matter where you end up. You know something terribly goes wrong, you're inside of a prison; you don't sit there crying, crying, crying, "Why did this happen to me." You look around and say, "Yahweh what is my work now? What am I to do here? Okay all this is preparation; now I'm here. Who is it Father?" Let His Spirit speak to you.

One of the things I constantly tell people when we go at mission trips that we're sanctifying this time for Yahweh, every minute of that trip from the time you leave your house, to the time you come home is sanctified to Yahweh. **You have to be listening to the voice of the Holy Spirit**. You have to hear it; because it's going

to talk to you; "go here, go there, talk to this person, follow this man; and we see that scripture is filled with that".

When Saul was knocked down on the road to Damascus, "go into a town, you'll see this man. Go with him, follow him". Clearly, Yahweh does that; because we have to be being led by His Spirit in order to fulfill our purpose. I'm telling you, as we get closer to the end it's going to be more profound in major ways; but if we're in a pity party or if we're only focusing on what we don't have or what we would want, we will never hear the voice of the Holy Spirit.

We will lose that connection that we have. Like I said, being here it's a local call. You don't even need your cell phone; we get that automatically by being close to Yahweh.

Proverbs 16:9 another great scripture... A man's heart plans his way, but Yahweh fixes his steps.

So we make our plans, we do our plan of actions, we set our goals; but then Yahweh fixes the steps; and that's what comes into Yahweh's perfect timing. That when something doesn't go exactly the way we wanted it to, don't fight it; because Yahweh's perfect timing is taking us where He wants us to be at that given time. Another great example of this is Hebrews 11, when we look at Moses. Hebrews 11 verse 24:

Hebrews 11:24-26, Having become great, Moses by faith refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, having chosen rather to suffer affliction with the people of Elohim than for a time to have enjoyment of sin; having counted the reproach of Messiah greater riches than the treasures of Egypt, for he was looking to the reward.

One of the things if you're going to be within Yahweh's timing, you can't compromise; because in Yahweh's timing, there will never be sin, there will never be compromise, there will never be anything that contradicts His Word; and I've seen people do it. You're invited before the King of Bangladesh and he puts pork before you. Are going to eat it, not to offend the King? Or are you going to refuse it not to offend and the real King?

When we compromise we totally take our self out of Yahweh's will and His timing. So again, it doesn't matter what the repercussions are; because whatever the repercussions are just standing on the truth, is Yahweh's timing. If

those repercussions mean prison or torture or anything, it really doesn't make a difference; because as long as you're in Yahweh's will, then you can be confident in His perfect timing, just like Moses.

If Moses would have... he could have logically thought, you know what...."few years down the line when the Pharaoh dies, I'll be Pharaoh. Let me bide my time and wait my time, then I'll just free the Israelites". But he knew that would not be Yahweh's timing; that would be his man-made thinking. So he knew, *having chosen rather to suffer affliction with the people of Elohim then for a time to have enjoyment of sin*. We have to think the same thing.

Compromise will never put you in Yahweh's timing; and that's why I say sometimes, we have to think to our self the things that we're sorrowful of; what if Yahweh gave it to us? Watch what you pray for. What if He did give it to you? If I was sorrowful that I miss my family, what if He gave me that? Am I going to be any better off around my family that is all unconverted? Absolutely not.

Like I say, unfortunately, I hate to tell you this; but after you've been here wherever you go from here, you will have the worst sorrow of your life of missing Israel. It's one of the things that come with the territory. Whenever we leave, whether it's a day, a week a month; once you've been in the presence Yahweh, once you've been in His Holy Land, there's nowhere else on earth you can go, that you don't yearn with all your heart to be back here.

And that's why I say, there's a time for everything. There's a time to be here. There may be a time to be out of here. Embrace it every day of your life. Embrace this great gift that Yahweh's given. I look back now, fifteen years of coming here, and I if I died tomorrow, I had the greatest fifteen years a person could ever have. I couldn't imagine anybody that I've ever met or read or anything that had a better life than I've had; being here in the land for fifteen years, administrating the work of Yahweh, baptizing thousands of people, meeting people all over the world.

Physically, we haven't had so much. Some years leaner than others, but that made no difference. The years we were lean or the years that were heavy made no difference on the happiness of being here in Yahweh's Promised Land. There's just nothing like it on earth; yet at the same time, Yahweh's timing. Some people that come here because of that will convert to Judaism or take some roundabout means; and I would never sacrifice my eternal existence in this Land for a temporary existence. That's why I wouldn't convert to Judaism. I wouldn't

do something illegal, I wouldn't do anything that would jeopardize my eternal life, just to be here.

Yahweh's perfect timing; there's a time to be here, there's a time to be out of here. As long as the time to be here Yahweh will keep the door open and when the time to go I do something else. I'm telling you, by understanding Yahweh's timing, it makes your life so peaceful and it gives you full faith and assurance of everything you do, that you're in Yahweh's will.

Our job is to stay in the will of Yahweh and to follow His timing. To follow His judicial order to be within His will and to understand wherever we are in life, it is because of Yahweh's timing. If Uzzah had helped anybody else's cart, he wouldn't have died.

There's a time to have a baby, it's a beautiful thing in life when you're married, it's a blessing. When you're not married, you get stoned to death. It's that simple. There's a time to have children, there's a time not to have children. There are things that Yahweh ordains as a beautiful thing; is relations with a man and a woman within marriage. There's a time, it's abominable to Him, and it is the death penalty.

There is a time for everything. If the Israelites put the blood on the door on the 15th of Aviv, as many believe, they would have all died. If that's not enough to go by an early 14th Passover, I don't know what is. Very clearly, if they were a day late, it would have been too bad. **You must stay with Yahweh's judicial order. People don't find Yahweh's timing because they don't seek His will**. It's that simple.

When we seek Yahweh's will, we're not fighting His timing. We need to seek the face of Yahweh daily. Like it says in Psalm 23, Yahweh is my Shepherd, I will not lack; He leads me beside living waters in green pastures. Yahweh gives us everything that we need every day of our life. Yahweh is my Shepherd; I will not lack.

Learn the lesson from Joseph and David to stop blaming others for our trials that are not caused by others, but simply are Yahweh's timing. **Everything in our life is Yahweh's timing.** And that's why, like I said, even if we remember when Absalom was coming after David and he's fleeing the city and Shimei is there throwing rocks. And one of the sons of Zeruiah wanted to come "let me cut off his

neck, that dead dog", and what does David say, "leave him alone, this might be Yahweh's will for me". Maybe Yahweh's having him come and stone me.

Because remember what Yahweh said when he committed the sin with killing Uzziah, the Hittite, and then he took his son away and he told him what was going to happen; that the fruit of his loins was going to come against him and he would have war around his camp; when that was happening when Absalom was coming after him. Here he is, he's crying and because he's realizing this might just be his punishment for the dumb things he did in life.

When you look...and when he's crying afterwards for "Absalom, Absalom, Absalom"...I believe a big part, why he was sorrowful so much, not even as much as Absalom being dead; but the thought that he thought he might have caused it by being outside of Yahweh's timing.

Because his sin caused this curse that brought what Absalom did; and at the end of the days he saw one son killing another son, his head of the army killing this son all because of times he was outside of Yahweh's timing. Yet in other ways, he knew it very good as we see.

People fight Yahweh's timing because they don't seek His will. We need to seek the face of Yahweh daily. We need to learn the lessons of Joseph and David. Romans 8 and verse 28, a very, very encouraging scripture...

Romans 8:28 but we know that to the one's loving Elohim; all things work together for good to those people called according to purpose.

So again, time and chance happens to everybody; but even at the same rate, to the children of Yahweh, Yahweh is always in control. Nothing is going to happen to you that He's not going to allow; and everything is going to work out for your benefit.

Romans 8:29-39 And He knew them in advance; and He sealed them with the likeness of the image of His Son; that He might be the first-born of many brothers. But whom He marked in advance, these He also called; and whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified. What then shall we say to these things? If YAHWEH be for us, who can be against us? Truly He who did not spare His own Son, but gave Him up on behalf of us all, how will He not freely give all things to us with Him? Who will bring any charge against the elect of Elohim? YAHWEH is the One justifying! Who is he

condemning? It is Messiah who has died, but rather also is raised, who also is at the right hand of YAHWEH, who also makes intercession on our behalf. Who shall separate us from the love of Messiah? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? Even as it has been written, "For Your sake we are killed all the day; we are counted as lambs for the slaughter." But in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him loving us. For I am persuaded that neither death, nor life, nor cherubs, nor rulers, nor armies, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other thing created will be able to separate us from the love of YAHWEH in Messiah, Yahshua, our Master.

Really, really great scripture; must embrace this and we must live for eternity, not time. Like I said, this too shall pass. This time that we're living in it's going to get worse, we know that; but it will pass in Yahweh's timing. And in Yahweh's timing, Yahshua will return to the Mount of Olives and in Yahweh's timing, His Kingdom will be set up.

The last scripture I want to go over is Hebrews 11. We read a little bit there before. I just want to read one more; because like we said, the Bible is not finished yet. The book of Acts is still being written today. Who knows how many things that we might be doing right here are being recorded for that book.

But also, Hebrews 11, the chapter of faith is still being recorded and the acts that we show are also being recorded. We want to make sure that we're being recorded as a good example of someone who's showing faith, not somebody who's lacking it. But in Hebrews 11 verse 32...

Hebrews 11:32-40 And what more may I say? For the time will fail me telling about Gideon, Barak, and also Samson and Jephthah, and also David and Samuel, and the rest of the prophets, ... So now I'm giving you a few small stories, examples of people in Yahweh's timing; but like it says here, we can go all day talking about all these people, brothers and sisters of faith... who through faith overcame kingdoms, worked out righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions, quenched the power of fire, escaped the mouths of the sword, acquired power from weakness, became strong in war; made armies of foreigners to yield. Restored to women their sons, raised people from the dead; but others were beaten to death, not accepting deliverance, that they might obtain a better resurrection. And others received trial of mockings and of scourgings; yea, more, bonds and of prison: they were stoned; they were tried; they were sawn in half; they died by murder of sword; they went about in

sheepskins and in goatskins, being destitute, afflicted, and ill-treated; of whom the world was not worthy, wandering in deserts, and mountains, and caves, and in the holes of the earth. And having obtained witness through the faith, these all did not obtain the promise, YAHWEH having foreseen something better concerning us, that they should not be perfected without us.

Who knows if in the coming days, if we may be in some of the very caves that these people were in I just read about. The Bible does say, there's a time, where if we are here in the land of Israel, we will flee city to city. We will not get through all the cities of Israel until the Son of man comes. And who knows if we will be blessed and accounted worthy to be in some of these very caves that these great men of faith were also in.

They all died awaiting the promise. Life comes and life goes; and as we're seeing as we get older, it moves very fast. We must understand that every place we're at, every situation we're in, Yahweh has provided for our good and we need to redeem the time. We need to embrace this fact and bear fruit for Him. Live for Him and Yahshua alone. Keep our focus on His timing. There's a time for everything. We just need to, in faith, believe this; and in faith, know whatever trial we may go through, that this too shall pass. And the Kingdom, really is, coming very quickly.

You are...I've said this before... one out of five million people. A number that's hard to grasp. Whenever I see something like the Rose Bowl and you see a hundred thousand people; if you've ever been to a sporting event, when it's over, it takes hours and hours and hours to get to the parking lot, to get out and all the traffic from a hundred thousand people. Think of five million, and you're one out of five million people to be a literal child of Yahweh; an heir of Yahshua of the universe. It really is a great time to be you.
